**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones captured a low-scoring affair on Wednesday night for their 3rd straight win, 2-1, over Jersey Shore...Brooklyn was held to just 2 hits on the night, both of which were solo home runs... 2B **Jesús Báez** and 3B **Boston Baro** hit game-tying and go-ahead solo home runs in the 6th and 7th innings... RHP **Will Watson** continued to excel since joining High-A Brooklyn...The 22-year-old tossed 5.0 innings of 1-run ball, allowing just 4 hits, while walking 1 and striking out 4...The bullpen took the baton the rest of the way, providing 4.0 scoreless innings of 2-hit ball thanks to the efforts from LHP **Ry Armons**, RHP **Jace Beck**, RHP **Chandler Marsh**, and RHP **Ben Simon**...It's the 2nd-straight night that Cyclones relievers kept Jersey Shore off the board, as Brooklyn has limited the BlueClaws to just 3 runs through the first 2 games of the series.

**WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS:** Brooklyn clinched its first postseason berth since 2022 by winning the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown with a 6-4 win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The playoff berth is the Cyclones' second since moving to the full-season level, winning the Second Half North Division title in 2022...With the win, 3 New York Mets affiliates that play half-based seasons won First Half titles in 2025...Double-A Binghamton and Single-A St. Lucie clinched the first half crowns in the Eastern League Northeast and Florida State League Eastern Divisions, respectively...Brooklyn's 46-20 (.697) record is the best first-half record in the South Atlantic League since Minor League Baseball reorganized prior to the 2021 season...It is also the best first half record in the SAL since Augusta (50-20, .714) and West Virginia (48-20, .706) in 2007...Brooklyn will have home-field advantage in the SAL North Division playoffs, hosting Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3...The 'Clones .704 winning percentage is the best in Minor League Baseball...The 50 wins are tied with the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas for the MiLB lead.

**ALL BÁEZ ON ME:** After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez has led the South Atlantic League in RBI (36)...He is also 4th in on-base percentage (.403), 5th in OPS (.890), tied for 3rd in batting average (.303), 7th in total bases (74), and tied for 6th in hits (46)...On the year, Báez is 6th in RBI (40)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate as May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 7 RBI, on route to win...Souh Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (.8059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF **A.J. Ewing** won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Cyclones hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history.

**LATE-INNING MAGIC:** Brooklyn has dominated the latter stages of games in 2025...The Cyclones pulled off their 12th come-from-behind win of the year on Wednesday night over Jersey Shore, with solo home runs in the 6th and 7th to negate a 1-0 deficit...Last week, despite trailing 2-1 through 7 innings on Tuesday and 4-2 through 7 on Thursday, the Cyclones came from behind to win both games en route to a South Atlantic League First Half North Division title...In 2025, Brooklyn has outscored opponents 75-24 (+51) from the 8th inning on...The Cyclones have outdueled their foes, 39-11, in the 8th, 32-11, in the 9th, and 4-2, in the 10th inning and beyond.

**MODEL OF CONSISTENCY:** The 'Clones roll into Thursday's contest having won 9 of their last 10 games...During the span, dating back to June 14th, Brooklyn pitching has been especially dominant...The Cyclones hold a 190 ERA in that span, 2nd in the South Atlantic League behind only Hudson Valley (1.85)...That ERA is also 2nd best in all of High-A during the stretch...Brooklyn's arms boast an impressive K-to-BB ratio of 107-to-37 during the stretch as well.

**HOME COOKING:** Brooklyn has been tough to beat at Maimonides Park this year...June 12's defeat vs. Asheville marked the Cyclones' 15-game losing streak...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 28-7 (.800)...Greensboro is second best (21-13)...The 28 home wins are tied for the 2nd most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas leads the minors (29)...Brooklyn's .800 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...Pittsburgh's Triple-A Indianapolis (.737) is 2nd.

**SUPER SUERO:** C **Chris Suero** provided the go-ahead 3-run home run in the 8th inning of Brooklyn's First Half North Division crown at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The 21-year-old also provided the go-ahead 2-run double in the 8th inning on Tuesday...For his efforts, Suero was named the South Atlantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games against the IronBirds last week, he went 9-for-19 (.474) at the plate with 5 runs scored, a double, a triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, and a stolen base...During the week, Suero paced the circuit in batting average (.474), RBI (8), slugging percentage (.947), OPS (1.492), and was tied for the lead in hits (9)...He is the 3rd Cyclone to win Player of the Week honors in 2025, joining OF **A.J. Ewing** (May 13-18) and INF **Jesús Báez** (May 20-25)...The Bronx native saw his on-base streak of nine games come to an end on Wednesday...During the span, Suero went 13-for-33 (.394) with 10 runs scored, 11 hits, 5 RBI, hitting .288/.392/.485/.877 with 11 runs scored, 6 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 15 RBI...Entered Tuesday on Thursday, the catcher is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (14), 4th in RBI (44), 9th in slugging percentage (.460) and OPS (.845), tied for 8th in home runs (10), and 10th in stolen bases (22), and on-base percentage (.385).

**BINGO SOUND:** The Cyclones made a series of roster moves since Sunday's series finale in Aberdeen...Brooklyn sent 3 players to Double-A Binghamton: OF **Jason Bengé**, RHP **Brian Metoyer**, and INF **Jacob Reimer**...In 60 games with the Cyclones, Bengé hit .302/.417/.480/.897 with 27 extra-base hits, 4 home runs, 37 RBI, and 15 stolen bases...At the time of his promotion, the Yukon, Okla. native was tied for the South Atlantic League lead in doubles (18) and triples (5)...Benge was also 2nd in runs scored (.47), batting average (.302), on-base percentage (.417), and OPS (.897), 3rd in hits (68), 4th in slugging percentage (.480) and extra-base hits (27), 5th in total bases (108) and walks (41), and 9th in RBI (37)...Metoyer made 14 relief appearances with Brooklyn, recording 2 saves and a .093 ERA (2 ER in 191 IP), allowing 7 hits and 10 walks, while striking out 25...The 28-year-old allowed only 1 earned run and 6 hits over his final 181 innings with the Cyclones (.049 ERA)...Reimer hit .284/.384/.502/.886 in 61 games for Brooklyn, posting 30 extra-base hits, 8 home runs, 39 RBI, and 11 steals...At the time of his promotion, the Yucucpa, Calif. native led the SAL in runs scored (52) and was tied for the league lead in doubles (18)...Reimer was also tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (30), 3rd in slugging percentage (.502) and OPS (.886), tied for 3rd in triples (4), 4th in total bases (115) and hits (65), 6th in RBI (39), 7th in batting average (.284), and 9th in on-base percentage (.384).
