PAYBACK IS A... The Greenville Drive offense erupted to the tune of an 11-1 victory over Bowling Green on Saturday in the penultimate game of the six-game series. The Drive, powered by five home runs, outhit the Hot Rods 13-4 while two of those hits came off the bat of Jonathan Aranda, who also scored BG's lone run of the ballgame. Despite the rough start, reliever Chris Gau and Ezekiel Zabaleta tossed a combined 4.1 innings of one-hit relief, but the offense came up empty in the route.

BEST IN TEAM HISTORY... Despite the loss, Bowling Green is off to a historic start. At 4-1, the team has the best record to start a season dating back to the team's inception in 2009. The previous high, 3-2, had been achieved six times in the club's 11 seasons and four of those came between 2016-2019.

FOUR GAMES FOR ARANDA... Jonathan Aranda is off to a hot start in 2021. The infielder has a four-game hit streak and has scored at least one run in each contest. He's also had three multi-hit games over that stretch, including a team-high four hit night in the second game of Thursday's double header while scoring three runs and five total that night.

HOLLIS ON FIRE... Connor Hollis has been a starter for the Hot Rods offense to start the season. Playing both third base and left field, he's on a four-game on-base streak and is 5-for-16 this season. He's been on-base 50% of the time and has three stolen bases without being caught.

WHERE THEY RANK... Even with Saturday's 1-run effort, the Hot Rods compare favorably to other High-A teams. They're tied for second in homers (8) while tying for second in runs score (39). The club has also left 27 runners on base this season, which is tied for the second-least in A+, despite having the second-most hits.

LAST NIGHT'S NOTES... Bowling Green's 4-1 record is the best start to a season in team history... The second-best start is 3-2, completed six times including each of the last four seasons... Mercado made his first start since 2018 after missing 2019 due to injury... The eight hits he allowed ties a career-high... He also tied a career-high in allowing three homers... Bowling Green's four hits and one run are both season lows... The Hot Rods hadn't scored less than seven runs in any game prior... Saturday marks the first game of the season BG didn't hit a home run... The last time Bowling Green pitching allowed 10 or more runs in a game was July 11, 2019 in a 13-9 loss to the Beloit Snappers in the Midwest League...

NOW PITCHING: MILLER HOGAN... Miller Hogan takes the mound for his second appearance and first start of the 2021 season. Hogan pitched for Bowling Green during the 2019 season when he finished 7-3 with a 3.08 ERA and 1.04 WHIP. The righty worked on a new pitch during 2020's lost season, adding a screwball to his repertoire that brought his pitch count to seven. In his lone relief appearance against Greenville this season, Hogan threw 2.1 shutout innings while holding the Drive to two hits and a walk with two strikeouts.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT: CHASE SHUGART... Shugart, a righty, is coming off a great 2019 season with Greenville, then the Low-A affiliate of Boston. He pitched in 16 games for the Drive while going 6-4 with a 2.81 ERA over 16 starts. He had a four-game win streak to win that season, a year highlighted by a 7.0 inning complete-game against the Kannapolis Intimidators. Shugart faced a Rays affiliate in 2018, striking out the side in a one-inning start against the GCL Rays, including former Hot Rods Russ Olive and Joe McCarthy.

TODAY IN HOT RODS HISTORY

May 9, 2010

On this day in Hot Rods history Bowling Green brought home a win 10-7 over the West Michigan Whitecaps. The Hot Rods used a five run top of the first inning to gain a lead for starter, and future big leaguer, Tyler Lobstein. He tossed five innings, giving up five runs on nine hits while striking out five. Bowling Green's lineup recorded 20 hits, including four doubles, to secure a win. Two of those doubles came from Tyler Bortnik, who knocked in one run while scoring three himself in a 3-for-5 effort. Scott Shuman came in to close and picked up his third save on the season.
