Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds picked up their second straight win over the Salem RidgeYaks on Thursday, 6-2. After a **Skyler King** RBI single gave Salem a 1-0 lead in the first, Delmarva tied the game in the second with a run-scoring double by **Felix Amparo** to make it 1-1. The Shorebirds struck for four runs in the fourth, starting with a **Raylin Ramos** home run to put Delmarva ahead 2-1. Two more runs scored on a two-out error off the bat of **Junior Aybar**. **Braylon Whitaker** concluded the inning with an RBI single to give Delmarva a 5-1 advantage. It remained 5-1 into the eighth until the RidgeYaks scored on a two-out error to make it 5-2, but **Jason Shockley** retired the next batter to strand the bases loaded with Delmarva still up three. **DJ Layton** quickly got that run back for the Shorebirds with an RBI double in the ninth to put them ahead 6-2, and they'd hold on from there to take the series lead with their second consecutive victory.

Play the Hits, DJ: It's been a strong start to the season for **DJ Layton** in his first stint with the Shorebirds. The 19-year-old utility man has reached base in 22 of 27 games, collecting a hit in 16, including a team-best seven multi-hit games. He leads the team with a .443 on-base percentage and a .489 batting average on balls in play. Layton's 22 walks this season are the seventh-most in the Carolina League, and he currently has a 21% walk rate, the best mark on the team.

Steady Stiven: After a tough first stint with the Shorebirds to end 2025, 18-year-old **Stiven Martinez** is starting to find his rhythm at the plate. He has recorded a hit in 12 of his first 17 games and has five extra-base hits. He produced his first three-hit game as a Shorebird on May 1 against the Hill City Howlers.

Triples Galore: The Delmarva Shorebirds lead the league in triples with 14. They put together back-to-back games with three triples on May 2 and May 3 against the Hill City Howlers. **Jose Perez** had three in those two games combined, including two in the May 3 contest, while also hitting a home run.

C-Rod in Control: In his debut season, **Christian Rodriguez** has become one of Delmarva's dependable starting pitchers. Rodriguez pitched a career-high 5.2 innings in his latest start on May 1 against Hill City and struck out a personal-best 8 batters. Over his last two starts, Rodriguez has struck out 15 in 9.1 innings, and his 26 strikeouts are the most among active pitchers on the team.

Quick Whit: **Braylon Whitaker** has quietly been one of Delmarva's most consistent bats, recording a hit in 16 of his last 22 games. He has also reached base safely in 20 of his first 25 games this season. He is the team-leader batting average (.299) and hits (23). Whitaker excels at making contact. Among qualified Shorebirds hitters, he has the team's lowest strikeout rate at 15% and puts the ball in play in 70% of his plate appearances. He owns a .348 batting average on balls in play.

About the RidgeYaks: The Shorebirds make their second trip to Salem after starting the 2026 campaign against them at Carilion Clinic field where the RidgeYaks won the series by taking two of the three games. The franchise rebranded in the offseason to the "RidgeYaks" after being called the Red Sox since 2009. The RidgeYaks nickname comes from the Blue Ridge Mountains beyond the ballpark, and "yak" is short for kayak, a popular outdoor activity in the Salem area
