JUMBO SHRIMP RALLY STYMIED IN 9-8 LOSS

The Jumbo Shrimp brought the winning run to the plate in the ninth inning Sunday, but were unable to overcome the Worcester Red Sox in a 9-8 defeat. After the WooSox plated a pair in the first, Jacob Amaya smashed a two-run shot to highlight a three-run first inning to grab lead. However, Worcester gained the advantage for good with a four-run second. After another Red Sox run in the third, Jacksonville scored three times in their half of the third. Two Worcester runs in the fifth made it 9-6. The Jumbo Shrimp scored one run in both the sixth and ninth frames, but could not get any closer.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 33 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 53-for-139 at the plate. slashing .381/.427/.489/.916 with six doubles, three home runs, 21 RBIs and 30 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.355) and sixth in OBP (.429). Among the 272 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (4.0 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 43 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 44-for-149 (.295/.382/.711/1.093) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 43 RBIs and 29 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 19.2 percent of the time in 2023.

STOCKING STUFFED

Jacksonville's 9-8 loss on Sunday to Worcester capped a sweep for the Red Sox. The brooming marked the first time since losing all five games of a series from May 1-5, 2019 at Mississippi. The Jumbo Shrimp had not been broomed at home since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Meanwhile, Worcester has won eight of the nine games they've played at 121 Financial Ballpark over the last two years.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Including a 9-8 loss to Worcester on Sunday, 10 of Jacksonville's last 10 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 89 games played thus far in 2023, 48 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-26 (.458) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer

ODDS & FNDS

Jacksonville looked like world heaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other nine games of the second half of the season. Jacksonville is just 3-6, with all three victories coming by one run. In the other six games, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 31 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are -28 against their other second-half opponents (Durham & Worcester).

MINIMUM EFFICIENCY

Over the entirety of their six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9, the Jumbo Shrimp walked just 20 Knights. Jacksonville followed that up with a whopping 28 walks during their three-game set from July 14-16 against Worcester, including 11 on Saturday, which matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp threw 598 pitches during the 27 innings of the series (22.1 per inning). In comparison. the WooSox tossed 457 in 27 innings over the three games, an average of 16.9 per inning.

SHRIMP BITES

Three Jumbo Shrimp rank in the top 10 of the International League in home runs (Austin Allen, 7th, 19; Peyton Burdick and Jerar Encarnacion, T-8th, 18). Burdick ranks 17th in the circuit in slugging percentage (.514)... Xavier Edwards is tied for seventh in the league in stolen bases with 23. He has not been caught stealing since April 23, swiping 19 consecutive bags successfully... Jacksonville is 6-5 against Nashville in 2023, but the Sounds have outscored the Shrimp 57-45.
