YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels had a late rally held off and lost to the Baysox, 4-2, on Saturday night at The Diamond. The Baysox opened the scoring in the second inning with an RBI double by Doran Turchin and a run-scoring groundout by Chris Hudgins to take a 2-0 lead. Richmond threatened with base runners in each inning, but Bowie starter David Lebron (Win, 2-0) navigated through 5.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Richmond starter **Sam Long** departed after four innings of work, allowing two runs (two earned) on two hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. **Ronnie Williams** pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts for Richmond. Flying Squirrels pitchers hit four batters on the night, tying a single-game franchise record. After the RBI hit by Turchin in the second, the Baysox did not have another hit until the top of the ninth, when Chris Hudgins doubled the lead with a two-run homer. The Flying Squirrels broke up the shutout in the bottom of the ninth with a two-run single by **Heliot Ramos**, but Baysox reliever Nick Vespi worked a pair of infield pop-ups to close out the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game set against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams will face each other a total of 24 times this season, with two series in Bowie and two in Richmond. Today is the final match-up between the two teams until a series begins in Bowie on July 6.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped six of the last eight games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 2.5 games behind Bowie. Over the last eight games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .218 (57-for-261) as a team. Through the previous 10 games, the Flying Squirrels hit .264 (84-for-318), third-best in the league.

THE BAYSOX are in first in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game ahead of Erie. Patrick Dorrian was named the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week after hitting .333 with three homers and 11 RBIs last week against Reading. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Adley Rutschman (1), D.L. Hall (4), Terrin Vavra (11), Kyle Bradish (13) and Kevin Smith (17). The Baysox lead all of Double-A in runs scored (94) and second in home runs (22). The Baysox have won nine of their last 11 games. Patrick Dorrian is ranked tied for second in the Double-A Northeast with six homers, tied for first with 17 RBIs, fifth with a .448 OBP, second with a .706 SLG, second with a 1.154 OPS, third with 15 walks, tied for second with 10 extra-base hits, second with 36 total bases and tied for first with 17 runs scored.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his fourth start of the 2021 season and his second against the Baysox. Last time out, Hjelle allowed two runs in 3.0 innings in his start against the Baysox on Tuesday. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He enters the 2021 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander DL Hall makes his fourth start of the season. After coming for 9.1 scoreless innings in his first two starts of the season with 19 strikeouts, he was touched up for five runs over 2.2 innings in a no-decision against Reading in his last start last Sunday. Hall was selected by the Orioles in the first round (21st overall) in 2019 out of Valdosta High School in Georgia. He spent the 2019 season with the A-Adv. Frederick Keys, going 4-5 with a 3.46 ERA in 19 outings (17 starts). Hall was selected to pitch in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game. He currently holds the highest K/9 rate (17.25) of all Double-A Northeast pitchers. He is eighth in the league with 23 total strikeouts. Hall is rated by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 4 prospect.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth in all of Double-A in ERA (3.02). The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for third in shutouts (2), tied for first in saves (7), fifth in fewest runs allowed (60) and third in opponents' batting average (.199). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** is tied for fifth among qualified pitchers in ERA (0.56). He is second in Double-A in opponents' batting average (.093) and leads Double-A and sits second in all of the minors in WHIP (0.38).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 1.97 on the season. The bullpen is tied for sixth in the minors and tied for first in Double-A with seven saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the fourth-fewest earned runs (16), third-fewest runs (20) and fourth-fewest hits (40) in the minors and have the fourth-lowest opponents' batting average (.158).

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fifth in Double-A and tied for third in the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for third in the Double-A Northeast games pitched (7). Last Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise. **Norwith Gudino** is also tied for third in the circuit with three saves on the season.

TOP OF THE CLASS: Adley Rutschman is the fourth player selected No. 1 overall in the MLB Draft to play against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond. In 2011, Harrisburg's Bryce Harper (2010 Draft) played five games in Richmond, batting .278 (5-for-18) with a double from July 21-24. In 2019, Reading's Mickey Moniak (2016) played six games in Richmond, batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles and six RBIs. Also in 2019, Casey Mize (2018) pitched against the Flying Squirrels on July 21 and allowed six runs (five earned) while only recording two outs in his start. Two other top overall draft picks who played in the Eastern League/Double-A Northeast during the Flying Squirrels' existence, Gerrit Cole (2011 Draft) and Stephen Strasburg (2009 Draft), never pitched at The Diamond.

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** clubbed his third home run of the season on Friday night at The Diamond. For the season, he is ranked tied for sixth in the Double-A Northeast in doubles (6), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (9) and eighth in total bases (33). Of the balls he has put in play, Ramos has gone the opposite way 45.9 percent of the time, which is the tenth-highest rate in the league and the second-highest rate on the team (behind only **Kyle Mottice** at 52.3 percent, which is second-highest in the league). In the current series against the Baysox, Ramos is batting .368 (7-for-19), which is second on the team, while collecting two doubles, one homer and six RBIs.

ANGULO ADJUSTING: **Andres Angulo** is currently ranked ninth in the Double-A Northeast with a .319 batting average despite only 73 games of experience at the Low-A level and no games at High-A prior to this season. He is batting .333 (5-for-15) and has five RBIs in the current series against Bowie, both of which are ranked second on the team behind **Heliot Ramos**. In his work behind the plate, Angulo leads the Double-A Northeast with seven base runners caught attempting to steal out of 11 attempts against him.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 10-7 record is tied for the second-best start through 17 games in team history, even with their start in 2014 and trailing only an 12-5 start in 2018.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for nine of their 10 openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans on Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out the last four games.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
