Sacramento River Cats (17-14) vs. Reno Aces (17-16)

RHP Carson Seymour (1-1, 4.03) vs. LHP Yu-Min Lin (1-2, 5.40)

SPLIT BEES: Sacramento dropped Sunday's game in walkoff fashion, 7-8, after initially leading 7-2 after the sixth... marked their eighth-consecutive series split with Salt Lake, dating back to August 2024... Carson Whisenhunt was the starter but did not factor into the decision... he allowed two runs on three hits, with two walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work... Whiz leads the PCL in strikeouts at 35... Turner Hill went 2-for-3 and stole two bases, becoming the first River Cat this season to swipe multiple bases in a game... Sac stole four total bags, their most in a game this season... they stole four-or-more bases in four games last season, including an eight-steal game on June 27 vs. OKC... Jake Holton knocked his second home run of the season; a two-run, 402-foot shot to center field... marked the second-longest homer of his career (441 feet on August 4, 2021 with the Single-A Lakeland Flying Tigers).

THE BEES KNEES: The Cats won Saturday's game, 7-4, clinching at least a series tie... John Michael Bertrand was the starter and earned the win, his second consecutive... he allowed three runs on four hits, with three walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work... Michael Fulmer earned his third save of the year, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and two walks and fanning two batters... Osleivis Basabe and Grant McCray each had a home run, Basabe's a three-run shot, and McCray's a solo... five River Cats had multi-hit games, including Logan Porter's three-hit night... Porter had two three-hit games last season, his last being July 9 at Salt Lake... Bryce Eldridge knocked a single with an exit velocity of 113.1, the third hardest hit ball of his career... all of Eldridge's top four exit velocities have been singles... marked the Kitties' fourth game with 15-or-more hits... the Cats have won all seven games in which they have had multiple home runs on the night.

OH MY HECK: The River Cats lost Friday's game 8-18, their largest margin of defeat this season... they also allowed 22 total hits, their most this season... 3:27 marked their longest game of the season (not including delays), surpassing Wednesday's 3:21 game... Seth Lonsway was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing seven runs on six hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in 1.1 innings... seven ER tied his career high, done previously on September 6, 2022 with San Jose... it was also the sixth-shortest outing of his career... all nine River Cats batters hit safely, the second time doing so this season (also, April 23 vs. Albuquerque)... Grant McCray went 3-for-5 with a double, the only extra-base-hit for the Cats, and McCray's second three-hit game of the year... Logan Porter pitched the final inning, the first position player to pitch for the Kitties this year... it was his third career pitching appearance.

- ▶ Manager Dave Brundage was ejected in the in the seventh by 3B umpire Chandler Durham for arguing a fan interference home run call... was the first ejection for Sacramento this season... Brundage was ejected twice in 2025.
- ▶ Sac has allowed 18-or-more runs and 22-or-more hits in one other game in the Research Tool Era (since 2005), on August 26, 2006.

DARTH BADER: Outfielder Harrison Bader joins the River Cats on a rehab assignment... Bader was placed on the 10-day IL on April 12 due to a left hamstring strain... making his first Triple-A appearance since April of 2023 with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... through 10 games with the Giants this season, he was batting .091 (3-for-33) with two RBI, two walks, 11 strikeouts and a .230 OPS.

DOUBLE DOUBLES: The River Cats recorded their first and only multi-double play game on April 23... they were the last team at the Triple-A level to do so... through May 2 last year, they had already had nine multi-double play games, including one game with four DPs... every other Triple-A team has at least two multi-double play games... as of today, their total double plays sit at 20.

- ▶ They are ranked T-9th in the PCL and T-24th in Triple-A in DPs... in 2025, Sac ranked third in Triple-A in DPs with 145, behind Reno (151) and Albuquerque (149).
- ▶ Bryce Eldridge ranks first on the team with 17 double plays, followed by Osleivis Basabe (11), Nate Furman (10) and Thomas Gavello (6).

SPRING INTO ACTION: The River Cats batted .282 over 24 games in the month of April... they hit 42 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs, 136 RBI, drew 96 walks, and struck out 175 times... they had a .367 on-base percentage and a .434 slugging percentage, totaling an .801 OPS... last season, the Cats batted .241 in the month of April with a .338 OBP and .363 SLG for a total .701 OPS... below are players who batted particularly well last month:

READY TO SEE MORE: Southpaw Carson Seymour is set to start today's series opener against the Reno Aces... last pitched on April 29 at Salt Lake where he earned his first win of the season... allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) with no walks and a season-high-tying five strikeouts in a season-high-tying 5.0 innings... through six starts this season, Seymour has posted a 4.03 ERA (20.1 IP, 10 ER) with five walks, 19 strikeouts and a .235 opponent batting average... ranks sixth in ERA and seventh in opponent batting average among PCL starters with at least 20 innings... split last season between Sacramento and San Francisco... in 16 games (15 starts) with the River Cats, he posted a 3.86 ERA (77.0 IP, 33 ER) with 39 walks, seven home runs, 26 strikeouts and a .225 opponent batting average.

BOYS IN THE BIGS: Three River Cats were called up yesterday afternoon and started for the Giants last night... Bryce Eldridge made his return to the bigs, playing as the DH but went 0-for-2 with one walk and one strikeout... Jesús Rodríguez made his major league debut as catcher but went 0-for-3... Trevor McDonald also made his return to the majors after seeing three games in 2025 and one in 2024... he earned his second major league win, allowing just one run on two hits (a solo home run to Jackson Merrill) with no walks and eight strikeouts... four River Cats batters are currently on the Giants roster... here is a look at their stats:

LAST GAME: Carson earned the win in his last start at Salt Lake on April 29, his first of the season...he allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) with no walks and a season-high-tying five strikeouts in a season-high-tying 5.0 innings of work...he allowed a homer on the first pitch Donovan Walton...Seymour has now allowed a longball on the first pitch of an at-bat 10 times in his career, including once in 2025 with San Francisco...recorded a 93.5 average pitch velocity, and topped out at 97.8 with his fastball.

THREE-PEAT: Has allowed a home run in three consecutive games...marked the first time allowing at least on home run in three-straight games since July 14-August 6, 2024 when he allowed a homer in four-straight games.
