FOUR-RUN SECOND NOT ENOUGH FOR SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp scored four runs in the second, but were edged 6-5 on Thursday by the Storm Chasers. After Omaha scored in their first at-bats, **Troy Johnston's** two-run double highlighted a four-run second that gave Jacksonville the lead. The Storm Chasers chipped away from there, plating a run in both the fourth and fifth innings before grabbing the lead with two in the seventh. A **Griffin Conine** sacrifice fly equalized things in the eighth. In the bottom of the eighth, **Drew Waters** stole home to put Omaha ahead 6-5, a lead they would not relinquish.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 31-for-95 (.326/.458/.674/1.132) with seven doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 RBIs, 20 walks and 15 runs scored in 27 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in both slugging percentage and OPS, fourth in on-base percentage, ninth in batting average, tied for ninth in home runs and tied for 13th in extra-base hits (16).

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 27 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 32-for-108, slashing .296/.364/.519/.883 with six doubles, six home runs, 24 RBIs, 12 walks and 21 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 14.9 percent this season with Jacksonville.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 23 of Jacksonville's 36 games (63.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. After beginning the season 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs. Jacksonville has lost seven of its last eight games decided by three runs or fewer. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests.

TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last six games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 41 runs (6.8 per game), the seventh-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 41 runs, a whopping 26, or 63.4 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 108 hits in 100.2 innings pitched with two outs, the fourth-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .265 with an .809 against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, both of which respectively represent the fifth-highest marks at the level.

WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 129 walks issued are the third-fewest in the International League entering play on Friday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in five of the last six games, including four in a row. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 20 out of 36 contests (55.6 percent).

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 20 games, however, Johnston is 26-for-83 at the plate, hitting .313/.345/.458/.803 with nine doubles, one home run, 10 RBIs, three walks and 13 runs scored. He has reached base at least once in 17 of the 20 games during this hot stretch, recording multiple times on base nine times.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has made an error in four consecutive games entering play on Friday, a season-worst stretch... After an O-for-19 stretch from May 1-5, Jumbo Shrimp outfielder **Griffin Conine** has reached base in seven of his last 11 plate appearances over the last three games. He is 3-for-7 with a home run, two RBIs and four walks... **Max Meyer** threw 74 pitches in his last start on May 3 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He went 54 and 55 pitches, respectively, in his first two Triple-A starts.

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loadDepot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
