GRAVY TRAIN

♦ Following a competitive series, the Reno Aces split their six-game set against the Salt Lake Bees this past week at The Ballpark at America First Square... Reno secured its first win of the series in comeback fashion on Wednesday night, plating six runs in the eighth inning to defeat the Bees, 6-2. **Jorge Barrosa**, **Ildemaro Vargas**, and **Tristin English** powered the rally, each going deep in the victory. After being held scoreless through seven frames, Barrosa sparked the comeback with his second home run in as many days—a two-run shot to tie the game... The BLC-Nine returned to the win column on Saturday with a dominant offensive outburst, erupting for 20 runs in a commanding victory over Salt Lake. Vargas went 2-for-4 with five RBI, including a bases-clearing triple. **Rene Pinto** enjoyed his best performance at the plate this season, collecting three hits—two doubles and a solo home run. **Connor Kaiser** added four hits, including a double and three RBI, while **Jordan Lawlar** reached base six times, going 3-for-4 with three walks, a double, and an RBI... Reno carried that momentum into Sunday's series finale, where **A.J. Vukovich** and Lawlar each went yard to power the Aces to a 6-1 win. Vukovich opened the scoring in the second inning with a solo shot to right-center—his first home run of the season. On the mound, **Billy Corcoran** delivered his best performance yet, tossing five shutout innings with six strikeouts and one walk... The Aces now return to Greater Nevada Field to host the Round Rock Express, the Triple-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, for a six-game series. First pitch is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. PT.

ACES vs BUCHANAN
♦ The Aces will face right-hander David Buchanan in Tuesday's series opener... Buchanan currently ranks sixth in the PCL in ERA (1.80), and seventh in IP (15.0). He has so far struck out 10 batters with four walks in three starts this season... The 35-year-old was great in his last outing, allowing three runs (one earned) with four strikeouts and one walk in 5 2/3 innings against the Oklahoma City Comets... He spent the 2024 season with the Lehigh Valley Iron Pigs (AAA-PHI) and the Louisville Bats (AAA-CIN) as he was traded from PHI to CIN for cash in August. Posted a 5.15 ERA with 88 strikeouts and 37 walks in 117 total innings in Triple-A last season... Made one appearance out of the bullpen for the Reds in 2024, allowing one run with one punchout in 3 1/3 frames against the Milwaukee Brewers on August 31... Buchanan will look to extend his solid start on the mound against the Aces on Tuesday.

SERIES WATCH LIST

♥ **Ildemaro Vargas**: Riding a nine-game hitting streak: 15-for-36 (.417) with 3 HR, and 17 RBI over that stretch... Led the Aces offense against the Bees last week in Salt Lake, going 10-for-23 (.435) with 1 HR, and 10 RBI... Currently tied for second in the PCL in RBI (17)... Slashing .378/.463/.644 with 5 XBH (3 HR), 17 RBI, and 8 BB in April... Hitting .364/.431/.591 with 5 XBH (2 HR), 13 RBI, and 6 BB vs RHP this season.
♦ **Blaine Crim**: Leads the Pacific Coast League in hits (293), 2nd in AVG (.397), T-3rd in total-bases (37)... Also leads his team in XBH (9) which include 6 2B, 1 3B, and 2 HR... Went 6-for-21 (.286) with 1 2B, and 1 HR against Oklahoma City in Round Rock's most recent series... Went 10-for-36 with 3 2B, 1 HR, and a team-leading 9 RBI vs the Aces last season.

♦ **NEXT STARTER: LHP TOMMY HENRY (0-2, 10.93 ERA) ♦**
Tommy Henry is set to make his fourth outing of the campaign in Wednesday's matchup against the Round Rock Express. The lefty has struggled so far in 2025 but showed signs of progress in his most recent start. He allowed six runs—three of which came in the sixth inning—over 5 1/3 innings against the Salt Lake Bees, walking three and striking out three... The 27-year-old faced Round Rock twice in 2024, posting a 6.97 ERA with eight strikeouts and five walks across 10 1/3 total innings. On July 12, 2024, he gave up four runs on five hits and two walks, while striking out three over 5 1/3 innings... Henry recorded a season-high 12 strikeouts on August 8, 2024, against Tacoma, allowing four runs on nine hits and two walks in seven innings... He'll look to turn a corner in Wednesday's matchup against the Express.

THIS DAY IN BASEBALL

♦ **April 15, 1947** - 28-year-old Jackie Robinson makes a historic debut for the Brooklyn Dodgers, becoming the first African-American to play major league baseball in the 20th century. Robinson goes 0 for 3 in his debut, but scores the deciding run in a 5 – 3 victory over the Boston Braves at Ebbets Field. He handles 11 chances at first base, a new position for him. Coach Clyde Sukeforth, interim manager and the man credited with first scouting Robinson, guides the Dodgers to two victories before stepping down. Robinson is the first black player to appear in the majors since 1884.

#45 YILBER DIAZ ♦ R/R ♦ 6-0/190 ♥ AGE: 24 (AUGUST 19, 2000)

SETTING THE STAGE

♦ **Yilber Diaz** will take the mound for his fourth start of the year in Tuesday's series opener vs Round Rock... Diaz struggled in his last outing, reaching just 1 2/3 innings against the Salt Lake Bees, allowing two runs on two hits and two walks with three strikeouts... The 24-year-old has yet to make an appearance against Round Rock in his career... His best performance in 2024 came on 7/1 when he struck out 13 without surrendering a hit against the Sacramento River Cats... Diaz has yet to reach 5+ innings in 2025 but will hope for a breakthrough outing against the Express in Tuesday's series opener.

PREMIER PROSPECT

♦ Currently ranked as the #4 prospect in the D-Backs System... Scouting grades: Fastball: 60 | Curveball: 60 | Slider: 65 | Changeup: 40 | Control: 45 | Overall: 50

BECOMING A SNAKE

♦ After going unsigned at 16 out of Venezuela, Diaz quit baseball for a year or so before giving it another try. The D-backs saw him throwing 92 MPH and brought him to work out at their facility in the Dominican Republic, where he got stranded due to the coronavirus pandemic. He continued to improve at the D-backs facility and eventually signed for just \$10,000 as a 20 year old. ♦ Diaz broke out in his first full season stateside and reached Double-A in 2023. He showed flashes of potential but went 3-10 with a 4.82 ERA and an overly high walk rate to amplify lingering questions about his future role.

♥ The right-hander tapped into his potential in 2024, posting a 3.80 ERA with 140 strikeouts (12.08 K/9) and 47 strikeouts across 21 games (19 starts) between AA Amarillo and AAA Reno, eventually earning himself a debut in the big leagues. Diaz entered Major League Baseball on fire, limiting the Atlanta Braves to one run in six frames with five punchouts and one walk. He followed the dominant performance with another quality start against the Toronto Blue Jays... In seven total games (four starts) with the Diamondbacks, the top prospect posted a 3.81 ERA with 19 punchouts and 12 walks in 28.1 innings of work.

GUATIRE, VENEZUELA

♦ Born in Guatire, Venezuela which is where former #1 overall prospect and New York Mets catcher Francisco Alvarez reigns from.

THROW 'EM A CHAIR

♦ Diaz's best offering in terms of avoiding contact has been his 83-86 mph gyro slider, a pitch with sharp 12-to-6 action that he lands like a dart. It had a 51 percent whiff rate across all levels and was a force against batters from both sides. His 78-81 mph knuckle curve offered another breaker with even steeper drop and a little more glove-side action. Diaz threw all of two changeups between Triple-A and the Majors, in part because his breaking stuff played so well against lefties.
