LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (5-8, 41-40) fell to the Arkansas Travelers (7-6, 48-34), 11-3, in 10 innings on Tuesday night at HODGETOWN. After a leadoff double, Charlie Pagliarini hit a two-run home run to put the Travs ahead just two batters into the game. The Sod Poodles would respond in their first turn to bat thanks to a **Jansel Luis** solo shot. **Ashton Izzi** settled in after the rocky first inning, allowing just one more hit for the rest of his start that gave time for Luis to knot the game up at 2-2 in the home half of the fifth with an RBI single. The stalemate remained until the bottom the eighth inning when an **Alberto Barriga** RBI single gave the Soddies their first lead of the night. **A** Jared Sundstrom sacrifice fly tied the game once more in the ninth. The Soddies went down in order in the ninth, bringing the game to extras. The Travs posted an eight-run 10th inning highlighted by a Sundstrom grand slam. Outside of a **Drew Jones** base hit in the Soddies last chance to bat, the hosts could not muster any other offense and dropped the series opener, 11-3.

IZZI THE ONE?: After giving up five hits in the first inning, matching a season-high for one frame of this current campaign, **Ashton Izzi** held Arkansas to just one hit over his next five innings pitched, coming in the top of the sixth after retiring the previous 12 Travs batters in a row...in all, Izzi turned in six full frames with just two runs allowed for his fourth quality start of the year and second in as many starts.

ENDURANCE TEST: **Alberto Barriga** pieced together a 12-pitch at-bat in the eighth inning that resulted in a go-ahead RBI single...it tied the longest at-bat by a Sod Poodles hitter this year, with the only other two instances resulting in strikeouts.

LUIS YOURSELF: **Jansel Luis** had the best week of any Sod Poodles hitter in the last road trip to San Antonio and carried that momentum into Tuesday's series opener, going 2-for-5 with a home run and driving in the Soddies first two runs of the night...he has an active six-game on-base streak entering play on Wednesday, where he's slashed .364/.462/.545, good for an 1.007 OPS.

I'M McLAUGHLIN IT: **Ben McLaughlin** hit the first triple of his professional career to start Amarillo's two-out rally in the eighth inning on Tuesday...McLaughlin owns the longest active on-base streak among active Sod Poodles hitters at 10 games...in his last 10 games, McLaughlin has a .364 on-base percentage and has drawn seven walks.

EXTRA WORK: The eight runs allowed by the Sod Poodles in the tenth inning of last night's game set a new franchise-worst for one frame in extras...the previous record was six, which happened on 4/19/24 vs. SPR...the last time Amarillo had given up eight runs or more in the ninth inning or later was on 8/3/2025 vs. WCH, who scored 10 in the ninth to walk away with a 16-8 win.

CATCH A COLD: Since scoring 18 runs in their series finale against Frisco on June 28, the Sod Poodles have scored just 12 runs in their last seven games...Since June 30, Amarillo has scored three runs or less in every game, tying a seven-game streak that the franchise went through only one other time from June 9-16 during the 2024 season...that year, the Soddies lost all seven of those games while the 2026 team was able to scratch two victories during the span.

HOW THE NORTH WAS WON: Amarillo suffered its 21st loss of the year against a Texas League North Division opponent, the most among the Soddies South Division contemporaries...Frisco has tallied the most wins in inter-division play this year, while Midland has posted the best winning percentage of .700...the Sod Poodles will have to turn around their fortunes against their Texas League counterparts if they want to secure a playoff spot, as 20 of their remaining 56 games will come against North Division foes.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Rio Britton turned in his fourth start of the year with 5.0+ innings pitched while allowing one run or less in High-A Hillsboro's 7-3 win over Tri-City on Tuesday.

NOTES

SUMMARY

- Selected in the D-backs in the 12th round (362nd overall) of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Southport High School in Indianapolis, IN...agreed to a \$922,500 signing bonus.
- Signed a one-year contract with Arizona in the 2025-26 offseason after fulfilling six years of minor league service.

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed 10 hits for the second straight start, matching a career high...Short had not allowed 10 hits in a game in three years on June 6, 2023 vs. Spokane while pitching for High-A Hillsboro before his two most recent outing.
- Held San Antonio to two runs over his first five innings of work before beginning the sixth inning on the bump...starting with a fielding error to open the frame, the next three batters reached base and he was pulled after a go-ahead two-run single by Ethan Salas.
- Reliever Alec Baker would let both inherited runners to score to give Short his final line of six runs, but only four of which were earned.

REVERSE SPLITS

- Even though he is a southpaw, Short has been more effective against right-handed batters this season...the .323 on-base percentage by righties is the second-lowest mark among left-handed starting pitchers in the Texas League who have made at least 15 starts this year.
- Short credits shifting to pitching on the third base side of the rubber and manipulating the depth of his sweeper for the success.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Short has enjoyed his time away from the hitter-friendly confines of HODGETOWN in 2026...his 2.03 ERA in eight road starts is the best mark in Double-A (min. 8 GS).

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Began 2025 in Amarillo and had a strong month of May, going 2-1 in five starts with a 1.17 WHIP, tallying three quality starts.
- Put together two more quality starts to begin June before his promotion to Triple-A Reno on June 15.
- Made one start with the Aces before being sent down to Amarillo and would be placed on the injured list shortly after.
- Threw a gem on July 18, shutting out the San Antonio Missions over seven frames on one hit, walking and hitting one batter each in his longest outing of the season.
- Eight of his 22 starts were quality starts.
- In 21 starts with the Soddies in 2025, he allowed one run or fewer in nine of them.

A-VERY NICE 2024

- Had a breakout campaign where he got off to a hot start at the beginning of the season with High-A Hillsboro...through his first nine appearances (eight starts), he went 2-3 with a 1.69 ERA (9 ER/48.0 IP), 1.15 WHIP and 31 strikeouts.
- Three of his final four starts in this stretch saw him tally seven or more innings pitched.
- Tossed 7.2 innings of one-hit shutout ball on May 23 against Vancouver (Toronto Blue Jays), fanning eight batters in the contest.
- Threw eight shutout innings in is next start on May 30 against Eugene (San Francisco Giants), setting a new career-long start that he has yet to surpass.
