LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox dropped a 3-1 decision to the Altoona Curve on Thursday night. Right-handed starter **Alex Pham** dominated to the tune of six shutout innings with just one hit allowed. Bowie took a 1-0 lead in the top of the seventh on an RBI single from **Matthew Etzel** but Altoona responded with three runs in the bottom of the seventh to take the lead for good.

HEID-AND-GO-SEEK

RHP **Dylan Heid** has emerged as one of the most lights-out relievers in all of Minor League Baseball. Heid's 1.11 ERA ranks as the best in MiLB among pitchers with more than 40 innings, while he has posted an ERA of just 0.70 since May 23 - second-best in MiLB among arms with more than 20 innings. Heid pitched collegiately at Pittsburgh-Johnstown, about 50 minutes away from Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season - ninth-most in Double-A. The O's No. 11 prospect homered in three of his first six Double-A games last season, joining the Baysox in Altoona on June 20, 2023.

TERRY TWO BAGS

1B/OF **TT Bowens** ranks fourth in the Eastern League with 18 doubles this season. Bowens has notched multiple hits in three of his last five games and is hitting .276 with a team-high .806 OPS in the month of July with three home runs since June 22. Bowens is tied with Jud Fabian for the team lead with 41 RBI on the season.

FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B **Matthew Etzel's** 39 stolen bags this season are tied for seventh most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 17 of his first 22 starts at the level.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 59 of 72 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect is tied for the team-lead in OBP (.339) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the 4th-most in the Eastern League. Wednesday night was the 19th multi-hit game of the season for Beavers, who is hitting a team-high .300 in the month of July.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff sports the fourth-best collective ERA in the Eastern League this season (3.85) and the best since June 1 (3.42). Bowie arms pace the league with 831 strikeouts. The Baysox bullpen has the most innings (406.1) at the Double-A level and the third-best WHIP (1.19) in Minor League Baseball. The Bowie rotation has also done it's part, with the second-best ERA (2.45) in Double-A in the month of July.

DON'T SWIPE ON SILAS!

C **Silas Ardoin** has set the standard when it comes to tossing out baserunners. Ardoin's 20 runners caught stealing are fourth-most in Double-A, while his 40.8 CS% is best in Minor League Baseball amongst qualifiers.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE?

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with a 36-47 record on the season - 7-7 in the second half. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve roster includes six of the Pirates' Top 30 prospects - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 1 PIT/No. 51 MLB), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 4 PIT), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7 PIT), OF Jase Bowen (No. 18 PIT), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 25 PIT), 3B/OF Charles MacAdoo (No. 29 PIT). After winning six of the first seven in the season series, Bowie has dropped eight straight games to Altoona.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Jaden Woods will start an anticipated bullpen game for Altoona. This will be the first professional start for Woods, in his second pro season after being drafted by the Pirates in the 7th round in 2023 out of the University of Georgia. Woods has faced Bowie in two of his four career Double-A appearances, allowing two runs in an inning and two-thirds of work.

2024: Threw 4.1 shutout innings with six strikeouts in season debut on 7/5 @ RIC after being activated off 60-day IL on 7/4. Holds a 6.75 ERA in 9.1 IP in three career outings against ALT. Began season on 60-day IL. Sent on a rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on 6/4 before continuing rehab assignment in High-A Aberdeen on 6/16. In three rehab starts with IronBirds, threw 10 IP and struck out 13 over 3 BB to a 6.30 ERA.

2023: Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Posted a 6.04 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over 53.2 innings with 70 strikeouts. Struck out sixth-most batters on the team. Punched out five or more batters eight times. Did give up 12 homers, tied for fourth-most. Was on the IL from 7/13 - 8/19. Returned from the IL on 8/19 and made five appearances to finish out season. Pitched in the Arizona Fall League for Mesa Solar Sox. Appeared in five games (two starts) and threw 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts over nine walks.

2022: Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen. Pitched in 24 games (14 starts) and threw 88.2 innings with 97 strikeouts to a 3.25 ERA. Recorded most wins (11) and 10th-most IP in O's system. Threw five scoreless innings as part of a combined no-hitter on 6/18. Started two postseason games and allowed just one run over nine innings, including four scoreless innings in South Atlantic League Championship Series.

2021: Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (two starts) and struck out 16 batters over 13 innings without allowing a walk.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 16th round of the 2021 Draft out of UC Irvine. Posted a career 4.03 ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings. Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College. Oldest of six siblings. Has worked as a baseball umpire. Native of Pleasanton, CA. Grew up rooting for Bay Area pro sports teams.

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years.
