### JUMBO SHRIMP SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER AT DURHAM

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Durham Bulls split a doubleheader at Durham Bulls Athletic Park yesterday, with the Jumbo Shrimp taking game one, 7-2, and the Bulls winning game two, 6-0. **Brian Miller** was outstanding in game one, reaching base all four times, on two walks, a double, and a hit by pitch. Not only did Miller score three times, but he also stole four bases, setting not only a career high, but also setting the record for most steals by one player in a game in Jumbo Shrimp history (2017-present). **Lewin Diaz** belted his fourth home run of the season, while **Nick Neidert** won his first game of the season striking out five in five innings. In game two, Jacksonville was shut out for the first time this season, tallying just four hits, and failing to advance a runner past second base. The Bulls also blasted three home runs in the contest, the most allowed in one game by Jacksonville pitching this season.

### IT'S MILLER TIME

In game one of Wednesday's doubleheader in Durham, **Brian Miller** reached base in all four plate appearances, scoring three times, and stealing a career-high four bases. Entering play on Wednesday, the Shrimp had stolen just two bases as a team, while being caught three times. Miller has stolen 87 bases in his career in 116 attempts (75%). He has stolen at least 20 bases in each of his three full seasons in the minor leagues. In 2016 he was one of just 16 players across all of Minor League Baseball to swipe 40 bags.

### EVEN STEVEN

Jacksonville pitchers have worked an even 77.0 innings on the season, with starters accounting for 41.0 and relievers tossing 36.0. Jumbo Shrimp starters are 3-1 with a 4.39 ERA, yielding 38 hits (8.3 H/9) and 20 walks (4.4 BB/9) to go along with 44 strikeouts (9.7 K/9) in 32.0 innings. Meanwhile the bullpen has posted a 3-2 record and a 4.00 ERA. Relievers have posted 46 strikeouts (11.5 K/9) against only seven walks (1.8 BB/9) and 33 hits (8.3 H/9) ceded in their 36.0 innings. Perhaps the other biggest difference is that Jumbo Shrimp starters are recording more ground ball outs; Jacksonville starters have recorded 1.78 ground-outs-per-air-out, with the bullpen posting a 0.61 mark. In 2019, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers worked 730.2 of the club's 1,192.2 innings, or 61.3 percent.

### ROLLERCOASTER TYCOON

Jacksonville has scored first in seven of its first nine games of the season. However, the club has faced some dicey situations late in games trying to hold on to that lead. Of the 41 runs the club has surrendered, 14 (34.1 percent) have come in either the seventh, eighth or ninth inning. In particular, the ninth inning has given Jumbo Shrimp pitching trouble; Jacksonville has ceded seven runs,

all earned, on 13 hits in the ninth innings this season. Interestingly, Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have combined to fan 13 batters without a walk in the ninth frame.

### BASH BROTHERS

Jacksonville first baseman **Lewin Diaz** and outfielder **Jesús Sánchez** have each gotten off to a pair of scorching starts to begin the season. In fact, Diaz and Sánchez have driven in 26 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 53 runs on the season (49.1 percent). Sánchez is 16-for-28 (.571) on the season with two triples, four home runs and a Triple-A-leading 14 RBIs. His batting average along with 16 hits, 1.179 slugging percentage and 1.779 OPS also lead Triple-A. Sánchez places second in on-base percentage (.600). Meanwhile, Diaz's ranks in a tie for second in home runs (4) and RBI (12), while also placing tied for third in doubles (4) and tied for fifth in runs (9). The Santiago, D.R., native is 12-for-36 (.333/.400/.778).

### YOU'LL NEVER WALK ALONE

The Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff has forced opposing batters to hit their way on base through nine games. Jacksonville's 27 walks are tied for the fewest total in Triple-A East. The staff has allowed three walks or fewer in five of the nine contests this season, while the five walks issued in game two of the doubleheader in Durham on Wednesday was the most allowed in a game this year.

### POTEET EARNS WIN IN MLB DEBUT

Former Jacksonville right-hander **Cody Poteet** earned the win in his major league debut in a start for the Miami Marlins on Wednesday against the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field. He is the 69th player of the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present) to debut in the big leagues, including the second this week. The 26-year-old struck out six in five innings, ceding two runs on four hits. He did not walk a batter. He becomes the third starting pitcher in Marlins' history to pitch at least 5.0 innings and not allow a walk in his Major League debut. Additionally, Poteet is the first right-hander drafted by the Marlins to win his major league debut since **Ryan Tucker** won his debut on June 8, 2008.

### SHRIMP SKEWERS

**Jazz Chisholm** has gone 2-for-6 with a double and a walk in two rehab appearances this series...**Jorge Alfaro** was 0-for-3 Tuesday in his rehab assignment, but was scratched from the lineup on Thursday... **Eddy Alvarez** has reached base multiple times in eight of his first 10 games on the season, for a .525 on-base percentage that ranks 6th in Triple-A East...The Jumbo Shrimp have everyone in their lineup reach base in four of the nine games this season, with at least seven different batters reaching base in all but two contests.
