

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones tossed their 8th shutout of the season with a 3-0 win vs. Wilmington on Wednesday afternoon...Brooklyn jumped in front in the 1st on a solo home run by 3B William Lugo...Added 2 in the 5th on RBI singles from CF Alex Ramírez and LF Rhylan Thomas...Ramírez and 1B Chase Estep each collected two hits, while Estep reached 3 times on a walk...Blue Rocks were limited to just 3 hits...RHP Blade Tidwell post-ed 5.0 spotless innings to earn a win for his 8th-straight decision...RHP Jace Beck (1.0 IP), RHP Brendan Hardy (1.0), RHP Dylan Hall (1.0), and LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0) combined to toss 4.0 innings of 1-hit, shutout relief to close out the win...Ankeney collected his 2nd save.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 8th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Wilmington on Wednesday...5 different pitchers combined on the 3-hit shutout...RHPs Blade Tidwell (5.0 IP), Jace Beck (1.0), Brendan Hardy (1.0), Dylan Hall (1.0), and LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0)...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 3-0 victory vs. Greensboro on July 15...Brooklyn has surpassed their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 8 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.

**SUPER STAFF:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.87 ERA (167 ER in 524.0 IP) over their last 60 games, holding a 35-25 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.14) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts — which tied for 2nd-most in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 11.4%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opering OPS (6.619), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.84) in that time period...RHPS **Blade Tidwell** (1.56) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.71) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 55.0 IP).

**RED HOT RELIEF:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023.. Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.25) in the entire South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Dowr East (3.13) leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.41) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' bull-pen is also 5th in batting average against (.213) and 6th in hits-per-9 innings (7.03).

pen is also 5th in batting average against (.213) and 6th in hits-per-9 innings (7.03). **CUTTING 'EM DOWN:** With 4 strikeouts on July 20 at Hudson Valley, RHP **Blade Tidwell** set the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record (107)...The 22-year-old surpassed RHP **Junior Santos'** mark of 105 set in 2022...His 112 K's sit 4th overall in franchise history and is 1 behind RHP **Alec Kisena** (113) for 3rd...Tidwell has earned the win in 6 of his last 7 out-ings with Brooklyn winning all 7 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 27 hits over 43.0 innings...He has walked only 13 (7.8 BB%) and struck out 52 (31.3 K%) in those contests... Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whifed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 12 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 8-0 with a 1.56 ERA (11 ER in 63.1 IP) with just 37 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 33 and struck out 85 (33.2 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .167 bat-ting average (37-221) against him...In that time, Tidwell is 2nd in the South Atlantic League and is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (85)...He is also 2nd in ERA (156) and batting average against (.167) since that date (min. 60.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.190), 2nd in wins (8), 3rd in strikeouts (112), 4th in ERA (3.09), and 6th in innings pitched (81.2).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn has won 13-of-18 (.722) and 19-of-27 (.704) going into Thursday night...The Cyclones have won 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley and have not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 18-8 in the second half and hold a half-game lead in the North Division of the SAL with Aberdeen (17-8)...Brooklyn is a half-game ahead of Hickory (17-8) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF Rhylan Thomas picked up a career-high 4 hits and scored a run on Tuesday, added an RBI on Wednesday, and enters Thursday on a 9-game hitting streak since July 8...Thomas is 15-for-32 (469) at the plate with a 1.063 OPS, 6 runs scored, a home run, 5 RBI, 2 walks and a 195 wRC+...In 12 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 18-for-43 (419) at the dish with a ...935 OPS and 158 wRC+, 6 runs scored, a home run, 7 RBI, and 3 walks to only 3 strikeouts...Among players with 50 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (391) League in batting average (.391).

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on Friday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005. In cecord 64 hits and 34 stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL)... Since the start of June, Alex is 37d in the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32) and pitches-per-plate appearance (4.016), and tied for 7th in walks (24) (min. 180 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 37d in franchise history in RBI (76) and is 15 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark and 4 behind INF Luke Ritter (80) for 2nd...He is 2nd in doubles (32) and total bases (204), 3rd in hits (140), and 4th in runs scored (72).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks... Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .286/.352/.538 with an .891 OPS and a 134 wRC+...In 24 games, Lugo is hitting .286 (26-91) with 10 runs scored,

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game homestand against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks posses 6 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: LHP Jake Bennett (8), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (10), OF Daylen Lile (11), INF T.J. White (12), and RHP Andry Lara (15)...C Israel Pineda (19) is with the squad on a Minor League rehab as-Israel Pineda (19) is with the squad on a Minor League renab as-signment...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd time in 2023...The Cyclones dropped 3-of-5 to the 'Rocks from April 18-23...The final game was postponed due to wet grounds...In the last meeting in Wilmington, Brook-lyn won 5-of-6 contests from July 4-9...The Cyclones are 10-10 (.500) in 20 meetings against Wilmington in 2023...Overall, the 'Clones are 36-34 (.514) all-time against the Blue Rocks since their first meeting in 2021 their first meeting in 2021.

PARADA POWER: C Kevin Parada registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on July 15 vs. Greensboro, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-homer games in the same season...INF Nick Evans powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport... Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .296/.357/.521 with an .878 OPS and 135 wRC+ in 36 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Thursday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33), 6th in total bases (141), tied for 6th in doubles (19), and tied for 7th in hits (84)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), 6th in hits (42), tied for 7th in total bases (74), and tied for 10th in home runs (7). home runs (7).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base last Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Domin-ican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 5th most in MiLB...Only Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (109), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (109), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (108), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (106) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 60 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 44.

**TRADE BAIT:** On Wednesday night, the Cleveland Guardians and Los Angeles Dodgers completed a 1-for-1 trade that featured former Cyclones going to each side...Cleveland traded SS **Amed Rosario** to Los Angeles-NL in exchange for RHP **Noah Syndergaard** and cash... Rosario slashed .289/.337/.380 with a .717 OPS in 68 games for the 'Clones in 2014, adding 17 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 23 RBI, and 7 stolen bases...Syndergaard made 4 rehab starts for Brooklyn between 2017 and 2021...The right-hander held a 1-1 record with a 5.54 ERA (8 ER in 13.0 IP) with 3 walks and 19 strikeouts in his Coney Island career.

**YO-JOANDER:** Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on Saturday at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 7 appearances (6 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-3 record, but a 3.82 ERA (13 ER in 30.2 IP), 12 walks (9.8 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (35.0 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native holds a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with 5 walks (7.7 BB%) and 24 strikeouts (36.9 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

**THE .500 CLUB:** With Brooklyn's victory on Friday night, the Cyclones jumped over .500 on the season at 44-43...Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season... The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

**COMEBACK 'CLONES:** Brooklyn earned their 18th come-from-behind victory with a 7-4 win at Hudson Valley on Sunday...The Cyclones matched their largest comeback of the year, erasing a 4-run, 4-0 deficit entering the 4th inning... The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4 vs. Wilimington and on Opening Day, April 7, vs. Jersey Shore... Friday marked the 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley...It was also Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings.


