LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones tossed their 8th shutout of the season with a $3-0$ win vs.
Wilmington on Wednesday afternoon... Brooklyn jumped in front in the 1st on a solo home run by 3B William Lugo...Added 2 in the 5th on RBI singles from CF Alex Ramirez and LF Rhylan Thomas...Ramírez and 1B Chase Estep each collected two hits, while Estep reached 3 times on a walk... Blue Rocks were limited to just 3 hits...RHP Blade Tidwell posted 5.0 spotless innings to earn a win for his 8th-straight decision...RHP Jace Beck ( 1.0 IP), RHP Brendan Hardy (1.0), RHP Dylan Hall (1.0), and LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0) combined to tos 4.0 innings of 1 -hit, shutout relief to close out the win...Ankeney collected his 2 nd save.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 8th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Wilmington on Wednesday... 5 different pitchers combined on the
3-hit shutout...RHPs Blade Tidwell (5.0 IP) Jace Beck (1.0), Brendan Hardy (10), Dylan Hall (1.0), and LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0)...I was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 3 -0 victor vs. Greensboro on July $15 \ldots .$. Brooklyn has surpassed their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 8 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in
76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014 .

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17 the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League
Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.87 ERA (167 ER in 524.0 IP) over their last 60 games, holding a $35-25$ record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.14) is 2 nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts - which rate of $11.4 \%$...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2 nd lowest opposing OPS (.619), in raddition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.84) in that time period...RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.56) and Tyler Stuart (1.71) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min.

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.25) in the entire South Atlantic East (3.13) leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.41) is 2 nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' bull
pen is also 5 th in batting average against (.213) and 6 th in hits-per-9 innings (7.03).
CUTTING 'EM DOWN: With 4 strikeouts on July 20 at Hudson Valley, RHP Blade Tidwell set the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record (107)...The 22-year-old surpassed RHP is 1 behind RHP Alec Kisena (113) for 3rd...Tidwell has earned the win in 6 of his last 7 outings with Brooklyn winning all 7 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 27 hits over 43.0 innings... He has walked only 13 (7.8 BB\%) and struck out 52 ( $31.3 \mathrm{~K} \%$ ) in those contests... Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-Career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 12 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is
8-0 with a 1.56 ERA (11 ER in 63.1 IP) with just 37 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 33 and struck out 85 ( $33.2 \mathrm{~K} \mathrm{\%}$ )...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .167 batting average (37-221) against him...In that time, Tidwell is 2 nd in the South Atlantic League and is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (85)... He is also 2nd in ERA (1.56) and batting average against ( 1.167 ) since that date (min. 60.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.190), 2nd in wins (8), 3rd in

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF Rhylan Thomas picked up a career-high 4 hits and scored a run on Tuesday, added an RBI on Wednesday, and enters Thursday on a 9-game hitting streak since July $8 \ldots$..Thomas is 15 -for- 32 (.469) at the plate with a 1.063 OPS, 6 runs scored, a home run, 5 RBI, 2 walks and a $195 \mathrm{wRC}+\ldots$ In 12 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 18 -for- 43 (.419) at the dish with a . 935 OPS and 158 wRC+, 6 runs
scored, a home run, 7 RBI, and 3 walks to only 3 strikeouts...Among players with 50 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.391).

compose a 6 -hit game in 2023 ...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record $6+$ hits and $3+$ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, $7 / 7 / 22$ vs. New York-NL)... Since the start of June, Alex is 3rd in the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32) and pitches-per-plate appearance (4.016), and tied for 7th in walks
(24) (min. 180 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July $4 \ldots$...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 3 rd in franchise history in RBI (76) and is 15 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark and 4 behind INF Luke Ritter (80) for 2nd....He is 2nd in doubles (32) and total bases (204), 3rd in hits (140), and 4th in runs scored (72).

White (12), and RHP Andry Lara (15)...C Israel Pineda (19) is with the squad on a Minor League rehab assignment...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2 nd time in 2023...The Cyclones dropped 3 -of-5 to the 'Rocks from April 18-23...The final game was postponed due to wet grounds...In the last meeting in Wilmington, Brooklyn won 5-of-6 contests from July 4-9...The Cyclones are 10-10 (.500) in 20 meetings against Wilmington in 2023...Overall, the 'Clones are 36-34 (.514) all-time against the Blue Rocks since their first meeting in 2021
