Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on Thursday with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. It's the ninth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and the third of six in Reading. The season-series is tied 4-4, and the teams split a six-game series in Binghamton from Apr. 16-21. Reading went 4-14 against Binghamton last season, including a 2-10 record at home. Reading has already won the same amount of games against Binghamton as last season.

Offensive Explosion

Reading used an eight-run seventh inning to propel the Fightin Phils to a 12-7 win over Binghamton on Wednesday night to even the series at one. Eight members of the R-Phils' lineup had hits, runs and RBI. Marcus Lee Sang and Carson Taylor each had two hits. Bryce Ball scored three runs and Trevor Schwecke led the way with three RBI, on a home run. Kolby Allard allowed three runs over 1.2 innings to start, and Noah Skirrow held it down in the middle innings to earn his second win of the season. Cristian Hernandez finshed the game with 1.2-scoreless frames in relief.

Power Outage Restored

After not homering in seven-straight games, dating back to May 11, Reading has now hit six home runs across its last two games. The R-Phils matched season highs in home runs in a game with three the last two nights, while also matching a season-high with home runs in an inning with two the last two games. On Wednesday, Marcus Lee Sang and Kendall Simmons hit back-to-back home runs, which marked the second-straight game Reading hit back-to-back home runs, and Kendall Simmons was involved in each.

About Last Night

As a team, Reading set new season highs in runs in an inning (8), hits in a game (16) and hits in an inning (7)... they matched highs in homers in a game (3), homers in an inning (2), and extra-base hits in a game (6)... three hours and two minutes tied Apr. 9 vs Portland as the longest game of the season... Reading batted around for the third time this season, sending 13 men to the plate (most since 14 on 6/13/23 vs HFD)... Marcus Lee Sang matched a season-high in hits and runs... Kendall Simmons has homered in back-to-back games for the ninth time in his career (last: 7/23-26, 2023)... Carson Taylor matched a season-high with three hits (was previously one for his last 15)... Bryce Ball scored a season-high three runs... Trevor Schwecke had a season-high three RBI and his first home run since 9/14/23 with New Hampshire... Ethan Wilson had a season-high two doubles, which ties a career high for the fifth time... With eight runs in the seventh inning, Reading is now outscoring opponents 34-8 in the seventh frame this season... eight-of-nine R-Phils had hits and runs... eight-of-nine had RBI... three players had multiple runs... three had multiple RBI... six had multiple hits (two had three hits)... Marcus Lee Sang had two hits in the seventh, marking the first time a R-Phil had multiple hits in the same inning since 6/13/23 vs HFD.

Carlos De La Cruzin'

Over his last five games, Carlos De La Cruz is 8-20 (.400), with three runs, three doubles and five RBI. He had two hits and two RBI in Wednesday's win.

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been rolling as of late. After hitting just .176 in April, Rodriguez is slashing .315/.345/.556, with a .901 OPS. He's added 13 runs, five doubles, one triple, two home runs and 10 RBI in 14 games in May. Rodriguez has also only struck out four times in 58 May plate appearances. He has not struck out in nine-straight games, dating back to May 11, which is a total of 31 plate appearances.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 23, 2007: At Manchester, Jason Hill's solo home run in the 10th inning lifts the R-Phils to a 2-1 win over New Hampshire. Mike Zagurski goes 2.0 innings in relief, giving up one hit and fanning three in his final appearance before being called up to Philadelphia.

Ponies Rumbling Into Reading

Binghamton enters today with a 21-18 record, which is second in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Rumble Ponies hosted the Bowie Baysox at home and took two-of-six games in the series, winning Tuesday and Sunday, and dropping four-straight in the middle. After this week, Binghamton returns to Mirabito Stadium and hosts Harrisburg for a six-game series. Binghamton's roster features 10 of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (1), Ryan Clifford (4), Kevin Parada (9), Blade Tidwell (10), Brandon Sproat (13), Alex Ramirez (16), Tyler Stuart (18), Nolan McLean (19), Joander Suarez (28) and Rhylan Thomas (30).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Luis Moreno makes the start tonight for Binghamton. This season he is 1-1, with a 4.32 ERA over six games and three starts (16.2 IP, 19 H, 8 BB, 17 SO). On May 17 against Bowie, Moreno went 4.1 innings, allowing one run on four hits, with two walks and five strikeouts. Moreno has also made two starts for Triple-A Syracuse this season. He spent the majority of 2023 with Binghamton, but did make one start for Syracuse. Overall, Moreno went 9-6, with a 4.92 ERA over 26 games (22 starts) in 2023. Against Reading last season, Moreno made three appearances (two starts) and went 1-1, with a 2.12 ERA (17 IP, 16 H, 2 BB, 17 SO). The Mets signed Moreno in 2019 as an International Free Agent out of the Domincan Republic.
