RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (19-23, 60-48)

Visalia Rawhide (20-22, 55-53)





RHP Aidan Foeller (4-3, 4.27 ERA) vs. RHP Junior Ciprian (0-0, 0.00 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Rancho Cucamonga Quakes open their penultimate regular-season road trip, with game one of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (Diamondbacks) at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes will return home on Tuesday, August 19 to host the Modesto Nuts. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 18th of 24 head-to-head meetings and the last of nine here at LoanMart Field. Last night's win gives Rancho a 6-2 record against Visalia at home this year and 11-6 overall. Last year, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes let one slip away on Sunday evening at LoanMart Field, as the Lake Elsinore scored five times in the ninth for a 7-6 win over Rancho. Alex McCoy's two-out, two-strike, two-run single off Dilan Figueredo capped the five-run rally, giving the Storm their first lead of the game. Marco Corcho (4-5) opened the ninth inning and struggled, as he was charged with all five runs. Trailing 7-6 in the ninth, Eduardo Guerrero, who hit his third home run of the year earlier in the game, singled to give Rancho a chance against Storm reliever Adam Conrad (5-1). Emil Morales and Jaron Elkins were retired though, as the Quakes left the tying run at first base. The loss ended Rancho's three-game win streak, but they still earned a series win with four of six, giving them a series record of 12-7-1.

THE CLOSE ONES: The Quakes have not played well in one-run games this year, sporting a record of 8-13 in onerun games after Sunday's loss to the Storm. They've also lost four of their last five one-run games.

ROAD WOES: After first-half success on the road, Rancho has struggled mightily away from LoanMart Field in the second half, going just 6-12 in the second half for an overall road record of 27-27.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS: Infielder Nico Perez, who'd been on the Injured List since July 27, was activated prior to Sunday's game. Starting pitcher Logan Tabeling was promoted to High-A Great Lakes.

WELCOME BACK TO JOENDRY VARGAS: 19-year-old infielder Joendry Vargas has spent a significant amount of time on the Injured List this year, with two different stints. Vargas homered on Wednesday night, giving him his first hit since being activated from his latest injury stint. He homered again on Saturday, tying the game at 1-1 with his fourth long-ball of the year. Vargas is hitting .237 in 27 total games, with four homers, 22 RBIs and 17 steals in 19 attempts. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect overall.

AIDAN FOELLER: 23-year-old right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his 20th start and 22nd appearance, his fourth against the Rawhide. In three games against the Rawhide, he's 0-0 with an ERA of 4.22, allowing seven runs (five earned) on six hits over 10.2 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed just two hits over six scoreless innings in a no-decision vs Lake Elsinore on August 6. His July ERA of 1.59 was his best month this season. Foeller continues to lead the league in strikeouts, racking up 121 punches in just 84.1 innings. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

JUNIOR CIPRIAN: Right-hander Junior Ciprian makes just his second start of the year for the Rawhide and his first against the Quakes. In his lone Cal League outing, he retired all nine batters he faced, striking out three over three perfect innings in a no-decision at San Jose on August 5. Ciprian joined the Rawhide just over a week ago, after being promoted from the ACL, where he was 2-1 with an ERA of 4.62 over 12 games (eight starts) and 39 innings of work. Ciprian signed with Arizona in August of 2023 out of the Dominican Republic.
