## FRES-NOTES

**BEAR ATTACK:** The Fresno Grizzlies offense had the best week in the California League hitting .336 as a team with 51 runs and 71 hits while posting a winning homestand. Over the last eight games, the Grizzlies are 6-2 and have built a two game lead in the North Division with 27 games remaining in the first half.

**JACK'S JACKS:** Jack O'Dowd added two home runs to his season total last week, giving him seven for the season in just 21 games. O'Dowd has "jacked up" his batting average raising it .342, tied for the team lead with Roldy Brito. O'Dowd's big week help garner California League Player of the Week recognition as it included a Grand Slam and 7 total RBI.

**EMENER'S ELEVATION:** Left-hander Austin Emener earned a promotion to High-A Spokane, recovering from Tommy John over the last year, Emener returned to Fresno in 2026 and has been a reliable arm out of the bullpen. The southpaw struck out 38 in 23 innings while allowing just four total runs. While appearing in 12 games out of the Fresno bullpen, Emener was 1-0 with his first professional save.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Derek Bernard has already matched his home run total from 2025, blasting six in half the games this year. Bernard finished 2nd on the team in homers in 2025, he is currently fourth on the Grizzlies with the same home run total as Ethan Holliday leads the group with 9 while Tanner Thach and Jack O'Dowd has each added 7. The Grizzlies have 47 home runs in 39 games this season.
