TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona wraps a 6-game series with Akron, the Curve and Ducks will play 12 times over the final 36 games of the season.

Rafe Schlesinger is back for more on Sunday night, he threw 5.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday. A 23-year-old from Long Island, NY, Schlesinger was Cleveland's 4th round pick in 2024 out of the University of Miami. Ranked as the No. 26 prospect in the system by MLB Pipeline, Schlesinger was a reliever in college but jumped into the rotation as a junior and took off. He struck out 112 with a 3.56 ERA in 103.2 IP at 2 levels of A-ball last year.

NEED A KNOCK: Altoona broke an 0-for-39 with runners in scoring position at the plate on Saturday night. The team scored 27 runs in the first 3 games of last week's series with Erie and scored just 18 in the last 7 games (2.6) until the breakout for 12 runs last night.

NO HASSELL: Outfielder **Robert Hassell III** has reached base safely in all 5 games played since joining the Curve on Sunday, August 9 at Erie, recording a .417 on-base percentage. Hassell III is the first Curve player this season to join the team as a minor leaguer after accruing major league service time; he played 70 games for the Nationals in 2025, batting .223 with 9 2B, 3 HR, and 18 RBI.

CRUZIN': Pirates outfielder **Oneil Cruz** went 3-for-17 with, 1 RBI, 1 BB, 4 K and 1-1 SB in 4 games with the Curve this week.

LONNIE LONGBALLS: Outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** has emerged as one of the top hitters in Double-A baseball since the All-Star Break. White Jr. is third among Pirates minor leaguers in homers this season with 24 and has set his career-high with 60 RBI this season. White Jr. is 1st in the Eastern League (9th-among Double-A players) in OPS (.969) since his Double-A debut on May 1.

Lonnie had a 12-game hit streak end on Thursday, in his last 23 games since the All-Star break, he's batting .390 (32-for-82) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 8 HR, 16 RBI and a 1.256 OPS.

MOSS IS BOSS: 1B **Callan Moss** ranks 4th in the Eastern League in hits (108) and 3rd in doubles (23) entering play on August 15. Moss has started off August on fire by going 16-for-45 (.356) with 1 3B, 2 HR and 5 RBI, recording a .941 OPS, he has a hit in 16-of-20 games.

EASTON BATS ON SALE IN CURVE, PA: Catcher **Easton Carmichael** ranks 3rd among Pirates Minor Leaguers in hits with 108. Among MiLB catchers, Carmichael ranks 3rd in hits (108), 9th in HR (18), and 3rd in RBI (73).

GRAY ZONE: Infielder **Murf Gray** has reached base safely in 22-of-23 games with the Curve, picking up 4 hits on August 15. Entering play on August 16, Gray is T-1st in hits (120), 2nd in HR (27), 2nd in RBI (81) and 6th in 2B (21) across 102 games among Pirates minor leaguers.

KRISTHIAN TORTOSA: Lefty **Cristhian Tortosa** has punched out 25 hitters over 14.0 innings over his last 8 outings since July 9, allowing just 1 earned run in that time. Tortosa has struck out at least 3 batters in 9-of-12 outings with Altoona.

PUPPIES: Among the 23 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 12 have made their Double-A debut this season. Only 6 pitchers (24 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut.

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 27 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 119 home runs in 113 games, they're on pace to hit 147 homers which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022. Eastern League clubs surpassed the league total of 1,223 home runs in 2025 on July 19 this season.

Over the last 8 games, the Curve have allowed 19 home runs - the most by a Double-A club. That includes 3-homer games to Erie's Isaac Pacheco and Akron's Ryan Cesarini (6 total in 3G this week). In all, Curve pitchers have allowed 128 homers this season, the franchise record is 140 homers allowed in a season (2004).

Peyton Jacob Stumbo... Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$150,000... Attended Placer HS (Auburn, CA) where he played both baseball and basketball... Born in Sacramento, raised in Auburn, CA... During his sophomore year of high school began getting recruited and talked to UC Irvine, Arizona and Nevada before committing to Nevada as a Junior... Son of Forrest and Danelle Stumbo... Has a younger sister, Allyson... Chose Nevada because of its proximity to home and for the connection to the coaching staff and program... Was a shortstop growing up and was talked into playing the sport at age 4 by his mother... As a freshman at Nevada was asked to fill-in in the bullpen and made his college debut at the end of the season and played in the West Collegiate Baseball League after the season... Became a serious pitcher as a sophomore in college... Grew up a San Francisco Giants fan and enjoyed Brandon Crawford, Hunter Pence, Brandon Belt and Madison Bumgarner as his most inspirational baseball players... Enjoys mountain biking, fly fishing, hunting and spending time with family in his free time... Is also an avid golfer and is regularly on the course on off-days during baseball season... In 2026... 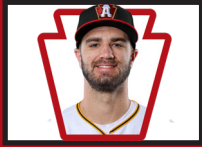
