Clean Slate

The Fightin Phils begin the season's second half with game one of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox at home. It is the fourth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and first-of-six in Reading. The teams saw each other the first weekend of the season from Apr. 5-7 in Bowie. Reading won the first game, then dropped the final two contests at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie leads the season-series 2-1 over Reading.

A Good Weekend

The Fightin Phils earned their first series win on the road, and fourth series victory of the season, with a 5-3 triumph over New Hampshire on Sunday. It was Reading's third-straight win and the R-Phils ultimately took three-of-five from the Fisher Cats. Carlos De La Cruz had a home run and Carson Taylor had two hits and two more RBI. Trevor Schewecke also drove in two runs with a double. Noah Skirrow started, and lasted just 2.1 innings, allowing two-earned runs on three hits. The bullpen combined to throw 6.2 innings, allowing no runs on five hits, with six strikeouts. Eury Ramos picked up his second win with Reading and Tommy McCollum stayed perfect in saves with his eighth of the season. The game was played in 3:01, which marked Reading's longest nine-inning road game of the season. Ultimately, the Fightin Phils finished the first half at 31-37, matching last season's second half record. It was an improvement over 2023's first half, as Reading was 28-40 in the first half of last season.

Carson Crushing It

Carson Taylor finished a strong week at New Hampshire with two hits, a run and two RBI in Sunday's win. For the week, Taylor slashed .389/.450/.444, with an .894 OPS. He added four runs, one double and four RBI. The week was highlighted by a four-hit performance on Friday night, which was the second four-hit game of Taylor's career, with the last coming on June 22, 2021, when he was with Great Lakes in the Dodgers' organization. Taylor's 50 RBI on the season lead the Eastern League. His other Eastern League ranks are: 5th AVG (.300), 4th OBP (.393), 4th SLG (.511) and 2nd OPS (.904).

Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz continued his mid-season turnaround with two hits and a go-ahead home run in Sunday afternoon's win. After hitting just a combined .213 through April and May, De La Cruz has been impressive in June. For the month, he is slashing .299/.386/.597, with a .983 OPS. De La Cruz has added 19 runs, five doubles, six home runs and 15 RBI on the month. He's struck out just 22 times in 88 plate appearances, after striking out 36 times in 89 plate appearances in May. He sits second on Reading in home runs at eight on the season.

Bombs Away

After hitting another home run on Sunday afternoon, Reading has set a season-high with home runs in nine games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 16-of-17 games. The nine-game home run streak is Reading's longest such streak since homering in 11-straight games from July 30-August 11 of last season.

Pitching Powers

Last week, was a strong week for Fightin Phils pitching, as they posted a 3.20 ERA for the week, which was tied for fourth in the Eastern League. Much of the success came via control, as Reading pitchers issued just seven walks on the week. That mark was not just the lowest in the Eastern League and Double-A, but in all of Minor League baseball for the week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 25, 2003: At Reading, Carlos Ruiz (Bob Boone) hits a solo home run in the 8th and Jorge Padilla (Bake McBride) triples home pinch-runner Nate Espy (Del Unser) with two outs in the 9th to lift Reading past Altoona, 2-1, on Retro World Championship Night. Reading wore the Phillies powder blue uniforms from 1980 and the Curve wore the Pirates uniforms from 1979.

The Book on Bowie

Bowie enters tonight after finishing in fifth place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 32-36 record. Bowie most recently dropped five-of-six at home against the Altoona Curve. Following this week, Bowie heads home for three against Richmond, then three at the Flying Squirrels. Bowie's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Baltimore Orioles' top-30 prospects: Samuel Basallo (2), Dylan Beavers (7), Seth Johnson (10), Jud Fabian (12), Max Wagner (14), Trace Bright (16), John Rhodes (23), Alex Pham (24) and Frederick Benscome (27).

On the Mound for Bowie

Righty, and Orioles' No. 16 Prospect, Trace Bright makes the start tonight for Bowie. This season, Bright is 0-7, with a 4.08 ERA over 13 starts (57.1 IP, 63 H, 23 BB, 65 SO). He suffered his fourth-straight loss June 19 against Altoona, allowing three-earned runs over 4.1 innings. In June he's 0-4, with a 6.48 ERA. Against Reading on Apr. 7, Bright allowed no runs over 3.2 innings, with six strikeouts in a no-decision. Bright split 2023 between High-A Aberdeen and Bowie, combining to go 3-6, with a 3.97 ERA over 26 games/21 starts. The Orioles drafted Bright in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of Auburn.

CAREER NOTES

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start of season Apr. 10 vs Portland and earned win over five-innings pitched. It was his first affiliated win since Aug. 11, 2019, while with Fort Myers. Lone run came on a solo home run. Placed on 7-day IL Apr. 16 and activated prior to start on Apr. 23. In first start off IL, went 4.2 IP and earned no decision. Struck out season-best to date six hitters, and allowed three runs on four hits, with 72 pitches. Matched season-best to date with five-innings pitched Apr. 28 vs SOM. Struck out a season-high eight batters. Both runs allowed were on solo home runs. Best start of season May 5 at Portland (first road start), where he threw six-shutout innings, but did not factor into the decision. Suffered first loss of season May 11 vs Hartford. Allowed season-high seven hits and matched season-high with three runs allowed. Suffered second-straight loss with three runs allowed May 16 at RIC. Struck out six and walked none in loss. Matched season-high with six innings pitched in no-decision vs BNG on May 24. Allowed one run on three hits and five strikeouts. Was second straight start with no walks and sixth-straight with one-or-fewer walks issued. Allowed season-high nine hits and career-high seven runs in loss at HFD on May 30. Second win with six innings of one-run ball June 12 vs HBG. Took perfect game into the six innings and retired 18/19 batters he faced, with lone blemish solo home run to CJ Stubbs in sixth. Suffered loss June 12 vs Portland, while allowing four runs over six innings, which matched a season-high in innings pitched. Did not allow a walk for second-straight outing. Took loss June 18 at New Hampshire, surrendering season-high 10 hits and also season-high three home runs in game.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by Minnesota Twins as International Free Agent on November 21, 2014. Released by Minnesota Twins on February 9, 2022. Signed by Philadelphia Phillies as Minor League Free Agent on January 7, 2024.

2023: Made return to competitive baseball during winter of 2023-24 with Adelaide Giants of the Australian Baseball League. Made nine starts and was lockdown in the Giants rotation. Went 6-0 with a 0.94 ERA. Struck out 63 hitters across 47.2 innings pitched. Posted 11.9 strikeouts per nine innings and a 9.0 strikeout to walk ratio (63 SO, 7 BB). Collected multiple accolades for Adelaide and helped Giants to Australian Baseball League Championship. Strong season led him to sign with Phillies during the winter.

2021-22: Did not pitch.

2020: Spent 2020-21 season with Sydney Blue Sox of Australian Baseball League. Made just three appearances and went 1-0 with 1.08 ERA. Struck out 15 across 8.1 innings pitched, which was good for 16.2 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.

2019: Split 2019 between Gulf Coast Twins (Rookie) and High-A Fort Myers. Began season on 7-day Injured List and remained on until June 30. Made one rehab appearance for Rookie-Level GCL Twins on June 24. After activation from IL on June 30, remained with Fort Myers for the remainder of the season. Posted 4.09 ERA over nine appearances and eight starts and went 2-5. Struck out 7.2 batters per nine innings and posted a 3.25 strikeout per walk ratio.

2018: Did not pitch as he remained on the injured list for the duration of the season.

2017: Split the season between GCL Twins (Rookie) and High-A Fort Myers. Began season with Fort Myers and was placed on the 7-day injured list on July 1. Was sent on rehab assignment to GCL Twins on August 19. Was assigned to Single-A Cedar Rapids on August 23 and assigned back to Fort Myers on August 27, where he finished season. Did not appear in any games for Cedar Rapids during short stint with Kernels. Was efficient with Fort Myers, posting a 3.58 strikeout to walk ratio and 7.5 strikeouts per nine innings pitched. Had impressive 3.98 ERA, but a 4-10 record.

2016: Spent entire season with Single-A Cedar Rapids. Did not make debut with Cedar Rapids until he was assigned to Kernels on June 24. Shined with Cedar Rapids, posting a 1.77 ERA and 6-4 record. Struck out 63 hitters over 71.1 innings pitched and walked just 16 hitters, good for 3.94 strikeout to walk ratio.

2015: Made professional debut with GCL Twins (Rookie). Was strong in rookie campaign, posting a 2.09 ERA over 10 games and nine starts. Pitched for Sydney in ABL after the season, going 1-1 with a 3.65 ERA over five starts.

2013-15: Pitched two seasons with Sydney in ABL in winter of 2013-14 and 2014-15. Made his ABL debut at just 16-years old in 2013. Made just three appearances in 2013-14 and four starts in 2014-15, prior to signing with the Twins in the fall of 2014.
