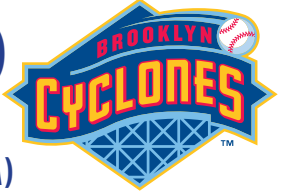

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn earned a series split with a doubleheader sweep of Hudson Valley on Sunday...The Cyclones rallied to win the lid-lifter, 4-2, and led wire-to-wire in the finale, 3-1...Down 2-0 entering the bottom of the fifth in Game 1, SS **William Lugo** powered a game-tying two-run home run...The Cyclones took the lead in the sixth on a wild pitch and a DH **D'Andre Smith** RBI single...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** tossed 5.2 innings of two-run ball in his first appearance back with Brooklyn, while LHP **Ryan Ammons** retired all four batters he faced to earn his second win...In Game 2, 3B **Junior Tilen** started the scoring with a two-run homer in the third...IB **Chris Suero** provided a multi-hit game and C **Christian Pregent** added an insurance run with a sixth-inning sacrifice fly...RHPs **Jordany Ventura** (2.1 IP) and **Alan Perdomo** (1.0) combined to toss 3.1 innings of perfect relief, collecting the win and save, respectively.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 13, 2009, the Cyclones erased a 1-0 eighth-inning deficit on LF **Alex Gregory's** Little League home run...He clubbed a game-tying double and then scored on a throwing error by the catcher...In 2011, RHPs **Randy Fontanez** (4.0 IP), **Steve Winnick** (2.0), and **Todd Weldon** (3.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 2-1 win at Mahoning Valley...In 2023, while making a Minor League rehab start, LHP **Joey Lucchesi** tossed 4.2 innings of one-hit shutout ball...He, RHP **Paul Gervase** (3.1 IP), and LHP **Eli Ankney** (1.0) combined to three-hit Aberdeen in a 6-0 victory.

**YOU SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY:** 2012 Brooklyn Cyclones alum RHP **Hansel Robles** celebrates his 34th birthday on Tuesday...In 12 starts with Brooklyn as a 21-year-old, Robles went 6-1 with a 1.11 ERA (9 ER in 72.2 IP), 47 hits, 10 walks, and 66 strikeouts...The right-hander led the New York-Penn League in ERA (1.11) and WHIP (0.78), as well as second in batting average against (.184) and fifth in strikeouts (66)...Robles became the 48th former Cyclone to appear in the Major Leagues when he debuted with the New York Mets on April 24, 2015.

**WENN IN BROOKLYN:** RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...Over his last four appearances (three starts) since July 14 at Wilmington, the 22-year-old has no record, but a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP) and one hold...Wenninger has surrendered 13 hits and nine walks while striking out 19 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native's 1.72 ERA ranks 10th in the South Atlantic League in that time among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings of work.

**LET'S PLAY TWO:** After Friday's rainout, Sunday marked the Cyclones' fourth doubleheader in 12 days...From Opening Day until July 28, Brooklyn played just two twinbills...Brooklyn swept their second double-dip of the season on Sunday, taking the opener, 4-2, and the finale, 3-1...On Wednesday, the 'Clones split their third-straight twinbill, walking off with a 3-2 win in Game 1 before dropping Game 2, 7-0...Brooklyn is 7-5 in doubleheader games this year and 2-1-3 in doubleheaders overall...In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders overall and 2-10 in games.

**NONE SHALL PASS:** The Cyclones' bullpen was quite literally perfect in Sunday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** combined to retire all 14 hitters faced in relief during the twinbill...Since SS **George Lombard Jr.**'s two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night, Brooklyn relief pitchers have not allowed a hit in 6.0 consecutive innings with nine strikeouts.

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) on Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (84), is second in stolen bases (38), tied for fourth in games played (74), tied for sixth in runs scored (49), seventh in batting average (.283)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38) and seventh in batting average (.283) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.307), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.400), and hits (115)...He is also third in runs scored (63) and total bases (144), tied for third in triples (4), fourth in OPS (.784), and tied for fifth in walks (50).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also good for ninth in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.14), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), seventh in strikeouts (129), and eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

**vs. WILMINGTON:** The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (11) and IF/OF **T.J. White** (30)...OF **Robert Hassell III** (9) is also with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 6-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 2-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 48-47 all-time against Wilmington (.505).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and has homered in six of his last 20 games since July 13 at Wilmington...Five of those six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for second in the league in triples (2), tied for third in home runs (5), tied for fifth in slugging (.557), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (8) and total bases (33), and tied for 10th in runs scored (12)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 35 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (72) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (72) and is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (144).

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of August 4's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winnfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 24 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .305/.374/.341 with a .715 OPS, nine runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, and three stolen bases over the 24 games...The Brandon, Miss. native is 10th in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.305) and on-base percentage (.374) in that time.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jefrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.75% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 239 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.55%)...The Cyclones have also earned 24 wins in their last at-bat.

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are three behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesus Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (23), and Wenninger (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision in Game 1 of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...Permitted one run on five hits over 3.2 innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and punched out eight...Threw 76 pitches and 47 strikes (61.84%)...Relieved by LHP **Ryan Ammons** with the bases loaded and two out in the top of the fourth and the game tied at one...All three bequeathed runners did not score...Renegades took the lead in the sixth, but the Cyclones rallied to win 3-2 on a walk-off two-run single by 3B **Jacob Reimer**...Hudson Valley would go on to capture the finale, 7-0.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Wenninger is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 27 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 28 by MLB Pipeline.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** After allowing five runs on eight hits in a loss at Wilmington in his High-A debut on July 9, Wenninger has settled into his spot in the Cyclones rotation. Since pitching in relief on July 14 at Wilmington, Wenninger has a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP) over his last four appearances (three starts), allowing 13 hits, nine walks, and striking out 19...The Barrington, Ill. native's 1.72 ERA ranks seventh in the South Atlantic League in that time among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings of work.

**FLORIDA STATE FIRE:** Wenninger was among the best pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on July 8...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)...Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strikeout rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

**2023:** Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

**ILLI-NOISE:** Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021...During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

**MLB DRAFT LEAGUE:** Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023...The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an 0-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

**FAMILY TREE:** Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
