- The Marauders handed the Blue Jays a third straight loss, using a three-run, go-ahead homer from Esmerlyn Valdez in the bottom of the eighth to win 4-3.
- All seven runs in the contest were scored on home runs.
- Dunedin struck first in the second inning, as Alexis Hernandez belted a two-run shot to left field. Bryce Arnold grew the lead to 3-0 with a solo homer in the fourth.
- Jays starter Fernando Perez took a shutout through six innings, and came out for the seventh, but allowed a solo homer to Shalin Polanco that made it 3-1. Perez finished with a final line of 6.1 innings, 4 hits, 1 earned run, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.
- Keiner Leon stranded two runners on in the bottom of the seventh, but allowed Valdez's three-run homer in the eighth that decided the game.

### FEELING STREAKY

After six straight wins, the Blue Jays have lost three straight to Bradenton this week. The skid marks Dunedin's third losing streak of three games or more - including a nine game losing streak. On the other hand, the Jays own two six-game win streaks.

### JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays have homered in 10 of their last 12 games. Across that stretch, eight different players have gone deep. Dunedin is tied for second in the Florida State League with 29 homers. Dunedin's 18 homers this month are the most in the FSL in May.

### A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his fourth start with the Blue Jays this evening. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot his the Cavemen.

### **TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT**

30 of the Blue Jays 43 games this season (70%) have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 13-16 record in those games. Including last night's loss, Dunedin has played 14 one-run games (6-8). Each of the Blue Jays' last four wins have required saves

### **RELYING ON RELIEF**

The Blue Jays success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 2.81 ERA with a 1.17 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP.

### FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz hit his team-leading eighth homer of the season Thursday. After a slow April, Feliz is batting .229 with a .833 OPS. The 6-foot, 4-inch first baseman's eight longballs are second in the Florida State League, two behind Daytona's Ariel Almonte.

### K COUNTER

The Blue Jays pitching staff tied a season-high with 15 strikeouts Wednesday night. Dunedin is third in the FSL in punchouts with 449 this season (10.4 per game). On the flip side, the Jays lead the league with 218 walks issued (over 5 per game).

### LATE MAGIC

For the first time in 14 games, the Blue Jays did not score in the 7th inning or later last night. The Blue Jays hold a +11 run differential in the final three innings this season (74 runs scored, 63 runs allowed).

### **BIG TIME BELTRE**

Blue Jays No. 27 prospect Manuel Beltre has turned red-hot at the plate, hitting .350 over his last 10 games (14-40). After hitting .236 in the opening month of the year, Beltre is hitting .284 this month - a team best in May.
