Tonight's Game: The Sounds begin a six-game series against the Norfolk Tides, affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, tonight at First Horizon Park. Left-hander and Brewers prospect Robert Gasser gets the ball for his second start of the season. He'll face fellow southpaw Bruce Zimmermann. First pitch is at 6:35 p.m. on MiLB.TV, the Bally Live app and 93.3 Classic Hits.

Robert Gasser: The 23-year-old gets the start to begin the series vs. Norfolk. Gasser made his first start of the season last Wednesday at Louisville and took a no decision. He allowed a run in four innings of work while striking out five on 49 pitches (32 strikes). Gasser has a five pitch mix of 4-seam fastball, sweeper, sinker, cutter and changeup. He threw his fastball 39 percent of the time last Wednesday, reaching a max velocity of 95.9 mph. The reigning International League Pitcher of the Year is the No. 5 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. He also was honored as the Brewer Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Year, an MiLB.com Organization All-Star, *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star and Triple-A All-Star following last season. This will be his 60th start in Minor League Baseball and his 32nd at the Triple-A level. Gasser was originally selected by the Padres in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

Bruce Zimmermann: The 29-year-old makes his sixth appearance and fifth start with the Tides in 2024. He enters the day 1-2 with a 6.04 ERA (25.1 IP/17 ER). Like Gasser, Zimmermann's last action came on Wednesday. He took a no decision despite tossing a quality start vs. Gwinnett (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 2 K). Zimmermann threw five pitches in his last outing - 4-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball. His fastball averaged 88.6 mph, with the breaking pitches in the mid-to-low 80s. Zimmermann has faced the Sounds twice in the past two seasons, getting the win on August 5, 2022 in Norfolk (5.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K) and taking the loss on April 13, 2023 at Nashville (5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 5 K). He has made 38 appearances and 27 starts with Baltimore from 2020-2023, going 8-10 with a 5.57 ERA (158.1 IP/98 ER) in his Major League career. This is his 49th career start for the Tides.

Tyler Black to the Show: Today, Tyler Black had his contract selected by the Milwaukee Brewers. The No. 42 prospect in baseball and the No. 4 prospect in the Brewers system (MLB Pipeline) had a Sunday to remember in Louisville, having his first multi-home run game in affiliated baseball. At the time of his call-up, Black is tied for the International League lead in triples (3) and is tied for fifth with 30 hits. Black would become the 19th Sound to make his Major League debut with the Brewers since 2021 and the third this season, joining Jackson Chourio and Tobias Myers. Since 1998, the Sounds have sent 135 players from Triple-A to the Majors for their big-league debuts.

Recognizing Greatness: Isaac Collins was named International League Player of the Week yesterday after tearing up the Bats last week. The switch hitter hit .409 (9-for-22) with three doubles, three homers, five RBI, six walks and seven runs scored during the series. He reached base in 15 of 28 plate appearances (.536 OBP) and boasted a 1.491 OPS, the second highest mark in the league among players who appeared in all six games. It was his third weekly award (he won 2 Northwest League Player of the Week honors with High-A Spokane in 2021) and first at the Triple-A level. This season, he currently ranks among league leaders in doubles (T-2nd, 10), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 16), slugging percentage (3rd, .676) and OPS (4th, 1.095). He is the sixth different Sound to win a Player of the Week award since 2021 (including pitchers) and is the first position player since Abraham Toro for June 27-July 2, 2023.

On Holliday: The Sounds host both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline's top prospect in baseball, Jackson Holliday, this week. The son of former MLB star Matt Holliday, Jackson was optioned by the Orioles on Friday after starting his Major League career batting .059 (2-for-34). It's the first time the Sounds are hosting the top prospect in baseball since catcher Adley Rutschman played three games while with the Tides at First Horizon Park from May 6-8, 2022 (he was the *Baseball America* top prospect, MLB Pipeline had Bobby Witt Jr. at that time).

Sunday Best: The Sounds moved to 5-0 on the season in Sunday games / series finales with a 7-4 win at Louisville. They are joined by Buffalo (5-0) and Charlotte (4-0) as the only teams in the league that have yet to lose in Sunday games this season. Their 2.41 ERA (45.0 IP/12 ER) is the second lowest on this date in the league - only Omaha has a better mark at 2.31. Nashville has outscored opponents 42-12 for a +30 run differential on Sundays (they have a -11 run differential excluding series finales).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 696-597 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,288-2,117 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Gasser made his first appearance off of the injured list on April 24 at Louisville. He retired each of the first six batters faced, striking out the side in the second, before allowing a run in the third. Gasser threw 49 pitches and 32 strikes as the Sounds would go on to lose a close 2-1 matinee Wednesday contest.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Gasser faced the Tides three times last season, going 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP/5 ER). He worked 5.1 two-run innings with seven strikeouts on April 12 at First Horizon Park, which was also his second outing of last season. Gasser tied a then-season high on June 24 against the Tides with nine strikeouts over 6.1 one-run innings. His last start against Norfolk came at Harbor Park on July 27, with the southpaw working 5.0 two-run innings with five strikeouts.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Honored as the International League Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first Sounds pitcher to receive the award since Jimmy Nelson was named the PCL Pitcher of the Year in 2014
- Named the Brewers Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Year
- Named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star (Milwaukee) and International League Postseason All-Star
- Named a *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star and Triple-A All-Star
- Tabbed as the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for June (2-0, 2.84 ERA, 25.1 IP, 20 H, 8 R, 8 ER, 4 BB, 27 K, 0.95 WHIP) and August (4-0, 2.63 ERA, 24.0 IP, 18 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 5 BB, 33 K, 0.96 WHIP)
- Led all of Minor League Baseball in win percentage and ranked seventh in strikeouts
- His 166 strikeouts were the most by a Sounds pitcher since moving to Triple-A in 1985 and the fourth-most in a season in franchise history...also led the level in strikeouts
- His 11.04 K/9 was the highest at the Triple-A level among qualified pitchers and highest by a Triple-A starter since Michael Kopech's mark of 12.11 with Charlotte in 2018
- Struck out 10 batters on August 4 vs. Durham (6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and on August 18 vs. Charlotte (6.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB)...became first Sounds pitcher to have three-straight starts with 9+ strikeouts since Mike Fiers (4/18-4/30/14)
- Tossed a 7.0-inning complete game on June 7 at Jacksonville, his first as a pro
- Was ejected after throwing one pitch on July 7 vs. Columbus (HBP, Brayan Rocchio)...is only one-pitch start by a Sound since at least 2000...is just one of three pitchers in affiliated baseball since 2005 to throw one pitch and leave a game
- With 4-0 record in August, became first Sounds pitcher to win four starts in a month since Colin Rea in September 2021...is 31st time a Nashville pitcher has won four or more decisions in a month since 1998...is one of five streaks in IL this season of four or more wins (Worcester's Kyle Barraclough had five in a row)
- Put together fifth consecutive quality start on September 1 at Durham (6.0 IP, 1 ER)...was the longest such streak in the International League and tied for fifth-longest in minor leagues this season...his 10 quality starts during season were tied for third-most in Triple-A
- Did not allow a first-inning run through first 15 starts of season...finished year with 1.88 ERA (24.0 IP/5 ER) in the first inning, the fourth-lowest among 85 minor league starters with 25 appearances in the first inning in 2023
