## RIDERS COMEBACK TO WIN 6-4 OVER MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders overcame a 4-0 deficit with six unanswered runs Thursday night, defeating the Midland RockHounds 6-4 at Riders Field. **Blaine Crim** knocked his team-best 12th home run of the year in the Thursday win, putting an end to a three-game skid. Riders reliever **Fer Ozuna** stranded the go-ahead run at the plate in the ninth with a strikeout to end the game to pick up his fifth save of the year. Frisco (30-30) starter **Avery Weems** gave up four runs on eight hits in his four innings with a pair of walks and seven strikeouts, his most since May 11th. The RoughRiders bullpen arms of **Tyler Thomas** (1-0), **Grant Anderson** and **Ozuna** held Midland off the scoreboard in the final innings and gave up just one hit and a pair of walks behind seven strikeouts. Midland (28-32) starter Colin Peluse (5-2) tossed 5.1 innings and gave up six runs on eight hits. The RockHounds defense committed four errors Thursday night. The Hounds threatened early with three hits in the first inning to take a 1-0 lead. Midland plated one run in the second inning behind an Austin Beck double and a two-run home run from Jordan Diaz in the third to pace an early 4-0 lead. Frisco began the climb back with an error-filled inning by Midland in the third. **J.P. Martinez** singled with two outs and stole second base for his team-best 22nd swiped bag of the year. **Justin Foscue** advanced Martinez to third and reached on a throwing error by shortstop Marty Bechina to keep the inning alive. Midland catcher William Simoneit attempted a back-pick on Martinez at third and sailed his throw off the glove of third baseman Logan Davidson, allowing Martinez to score and make it a 4-1 deficit. In the following frame, Crim cut the Riders another run closer and led the inning off with his 12th homer of the season. Later in the inning, Jax Biggers singled before **Josh Stowers** doubled him in in the following at-bat to move the score to 4-3. Riders left fielder **Sandro Fabian** continued the comeback by leading off the sixth inning with a single. In the following at-bat, Biggers singled a ball past the glove of Midland center fielder Max Schuemann and plated Fabian from first to tie Thursday's game at 4-4. Frisco catcher **Matt Whatley** singled and Martinez walked to load the bases, and with two outs, shortstop **Jonathan Ornelas** pushed the Riders to a 6-4 lead with a two-run single. Fabian and Biggers led the way offensively for the Riders with multi-hit nights, combining for five of the ten team hits totaled in the Thursday win.

## BEING THE BIGGER(S) MAN:

Since coming back from the Injured List, **Jax Biggers** has been on fire for Frisco. While reaching safely in all 12 games that he has played in, Biggers has also hit safely in his last 10 games, batting .381 (16-for-42)/.409/.524 with three doubles, a home run, four RBIs, four runs, one walk and two stolen bases. Biggers played 91 games with Frisco in 2021, hitting .224/.287/.321 with 12 doubles, four home runs and 14 steals.

## GOT IT BY MORE THAN JUST A HAIR:

**Trey Hair** has been crushing the baseball in June. He has homered in five-straight games in Amarillo, a franchise record for consecutive games with a home run. Hitting home runs in four straight being done five times, most recently by **J.T. Wise** from August 28-31, 2014 prior to Hair. Hair snapped a nine-game hitting streak on Sunday, but he hit .343 (12-for-35) with two doubles, six home runs and 13 RBIs over the streak. On Monday, Hair won the Texas League Player of the Week award.

## SENDIN' IN BRENNAN:

Riders pitcher **Tim Brennan** has been lights out since coming to the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training. After joining the team in mid-May, Brennan is 1-1 with a 1.20 ERA over 15.0 innings. In his six outings, including a start on Tuesday, Brennan has allowed just two runs on 10 hits with 16 strikeouts and just one walk. Opponents are hitting just .189 against him while a ridiculously high 65.8 percent of balls put in play against him have been on the ground, leading to a .243 BABIP.

## IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Over his last 15 games, Strahm is hitting .400 (18-for-45)/.509/.600 with three doubles, two home runs, 10 walks, 10 runs and five RBIs. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .238 and his OPS from .528 to .732. In his last 21 games, he is batting .328/.438/.463/.901. Among those with at least 160 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is fourth in walk rate (17.2 percent).

## THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 2-19 when scoring three runs or fewer and 15-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

## NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 60 games, Frisco has hit 87 long balls (1.5 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and ninth in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 200 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 60 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 43 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.1 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 17 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-10. **Blaine Crim** hit his 12th home run of the season on Thursday, giving him the team lead while being tied for sixth in the league. The power surge has ballooned the Riders team OPS to .812, the seventh-best mark in the minors.

### ABOUT CODY

-Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-SA MVP Pitcher award.

-Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

-At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.

-After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.

-Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

### 2022 SEASON

-Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.

-Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

-Allowed career-highs in runs (10) and walks (4) in start on April 22nd against Northwest Arkansas. Gave up a grand slam to former Baylor teammate Nick Loftin in loss.

-Start at Wichita on 5/31 was cut short due to rain that suspended the game with one out in the top of the second inning. Started and went 4.0 IP on Sunday of the series.

### 2021 SEASON

-The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.

-Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).

-Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.

-On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Ashville in a win.

-Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.

-Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.

-Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.
