CARDS SNAP SKID THANKS TO MENDLINGER'S WALK-OFF: Noah

Mendlinger's walk-off single with one out in the bottom of the 9th inning to score **RJ Yeager** broke a 2-2 tie lifting the Cardinals to a 3-2 win on Saturday night at Hammons Field. **Mike Antico** extended his hitting streak to 7 games with his third straight two-hit game and **Jimmy Crooks** added two hits of his own. Springfield starter **Tink Hence** struck out 9 while allowing just two hits over 7.0 IP, and the bullpen duo of **Leonardo Taveras** and **Andre Granillo** combined to fire 3 shutout innings to set the stage for **Mendlinger's** heroics.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Blake Beers** makes his 4th start (7th appearance) of the season for the RockHounds...Last pitched in the series opener and did not factor in the decision allowing 2 ER on 3 H with 2 BB and 2 K over 4.2 IP...The RockHounds won the game 6-4...Over two starts in the month of May has allowed 17 H in 11.1 IP with a .362 opponents average while going 0-1 with a 6.35 ERA...Spent most of the 2023 season with Midland going 3-10 with a 7.81 ERA in 18 appearances (17 starts)...Did not pitch against Springfield last season...Began the year with High-A Lansing going 4-1 with a 2.91 ERA in 7 appearance (4 starts)...Split his first full season in 2022 between Low-A Stockton and Lansing going a combined 2-6 with a 4.08 ERA...Selected by the A's in the 19th round of the 2021 draft out of Michigan... CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FRANCHISE-RECORD TYING SKID HALTED: Noah Mendlinger's walkoff single in teh bottom of the 9th inning on Saturday night brought the Cardinals' 8-game losing streak at Hammons Field to an end, ensuring the Cardinals would not set the new franchise record for longest home losing streak. The Cards' skid matched the 8-game losing streak from May 23-JUne 6, 2013..

SKID SENDS BIRDS INTO RED NUMBERS: During their six-game losing streak that came to and end on Saturday night, the Cardinals were outscored by 21 runs sending their overall run differential to -4, the first time Springfield has been in the negatives in 2024. The Cardinals have reached +33 twice this season, last on April 24 when the Birds were 14-3. Since that time, the Cardinals have gone 7-13 and have been outscored by 36 runs. The Cards' current run differential sits at -3.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 274 times in 37 games, the 4th-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (260 K's in 37 games, fewest in the Minor Leagues) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.4 K's per game.

BEDELI, HENCE REBOUND FROM ROUGH GO-AROUND: Com-

binding to allow just 3 ER over 13.0 IP, Ian Bedell and Tink Hence put an end to what had been a tough go-around for the Springfield rotation over the past week. Before Bedell's outing Friday night, the Cardinals' starting rotation had struggled during their last turn through the 5-man group. In their previous 5 outings. Cardinals starters had combined for just 18 IP (3.2 IP on average) allowing 32 H, 31 R with 13 walks and 13 K's. Of the 31 runs scored, 22 were earned, giving the Birds' rotation an ERA of 18.00 during the five-game stretch. The Cardinals' bullpen, meanwhile, sported a 3.08 ERA (9 ER in 26.1 IP) during that same stretch.

Over the Cards' last two games, however, Bedell and Hence combined for a 2.08 ERA.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 29 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 29 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 113 of the 204 total runs scored by the opposition. In summation, the Cards have allowed 55.3% of the runs scored against them in 2024 in just 9.1% of their innings pitched. In the other 289.2 IP Springfield has allowed 91 runs, which comes out to 2.82 runs per 9 innings.

WELCOME BACK TO SPRINGY: Since returning to Springfield on April 25 after beginning the season with Triple-A Memphis, Cardinals OF Mike Antico has picked up where he left off in 2023. In 14 games in the month of May since returning to the Springfield regular lineup, Antico is batting a team-high .365 (19-for-52) with 2 2B, 2 HR and 11 RBIs, most on the club during that time, and has hit safely in 7 straight games. Among gualified hitters in the Texas League, Antico is 3rd in the Texas League in hitting in May.

The former Texas Longhorn led the Cardinals in hits (126) and stolen bases (52) last season

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, Bryan Torres and Nathan Church, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, Torres and Church are batting .306 (82-for-268) with 43 R, 14 2B, 22 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 37 times compared to 29 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .288 which is tied for 2nd in the Texas League, and .293 out of the 2-hole, tied for the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals are tops in the league batting .290 between the two spots in the lineup

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
