FISHER CATS WIN IN SIX INNINGS, 3-0: The Fisher Cats recorded their second shutout of the season yesterday, blanking the Sea Dogs 3-0 in a game which was called in the bottom of the sixth inning. Maximo Castillo picked up his league-leading sixth win of the campaign, going five strong innings and striking out six, while Marcus Reyes picked up his first Double-A save. Chavez Young delivered a two-run double, and Jordan Groshans singled home Austin Martin to provide the scoring.

SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON TO THE OLYMPICS: Simeon Woods Richardson has been named to Team USA for the upcoming Olympics. Woods Richardson helped Team USA qualify earlier this season. Woods Richardson will join other top prospects and experienced players later this July in the pursuit of Olympic gold.

SEA YOU LATER: The Fisher Cats and Portland Sea Dogs are now scheduled to make-up the postponed game from Wednesday night on September 1. The teams will meet a whopping 36 times over the course of this season, accounting for 30% of the games each team will play on the year. Earlier this year, the Fisher Cats won five straight against Portland, one short of the franchise record of six (May 14-June 26, 2011). Portland won seven in-a-row earlier this year, and once won 14 straight games against New Hampshire (July 11-August 28, 2005).

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: On the Fourth- The Fisher Cats are 9-6 all-time on the Fourth of July, including Kyle Drabek's nine-inning no-hitter of the New Britain Rock Cats on 7/4/10. This is the 12th time in the last 13 seasons New Hampshire has been scheduled at home on July 4. Portland won the last July 4 meeting between the teams in 2019, taking a 6-3 decision. On July 4, 2012, New Hampshire won 11-10 in 11 innings. MLB rehabbers Jacoby Ellsbury and Carl Crawford hit in the top two spots in the Sea Dogs line-up, going a combined 3-9 before being replaced. The Fisher Cats scored three in the bottom of the ninth and three in the 11th, winning on Kevin Howard's walk-off homer.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays took game two of their series with Tampa, winning 6-3. George Springer homered and Ross Stripling turned in another strong start to lead the Jays to victory. Lehigh Valley swept Buffalo in a doubleheader, 4-0 and 5-4, despite a home run from Alejandro Kirk in game one. Everett beat Vancouver 11-5, and Palm Beach beat Dunedin 7-6 courtesy of a walk-off sacrifice fly. The FCL Blue Jays saw their game with the FCL Phillies get postponed.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will spend two weeks on the road after this series. It will be the first 12-game road stretch of the season The Fisher Cats will head to Mirabito Stadium to take on the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets) next week before a week at Hartford July 13-18. The only other home series this month begins July 20 against Reading (Phillies).

STARTERS: Simeon Woods Richardson will get the nod in the opener today. Last time out, Woods Richardson had a difficult outing against the Baysox, taking his first loss at the Double-A level. On the season, Woods Richardson has limited opponents to an average of .212 and a WHIP of 1.32. In game two, Reilly Hovis will get the start. Hovis made his debut last week after being signed from the Gastonia Honey Hunters (Atlantic League).

For Portland, Kutter Crawford and Frank German will be the starters. Crawford will make his third start against the Fisher Cats this season; he holds a record of 0-1 in the two previous appearances with five runs allowed (all earned) in 6.1 innings. German, who was acquired in the Adam Ottavino trade, will make his fourth start against New Hampshire this year. He has yet to pick up a decision against the Fisher Cats.

NAMED TO US OLYMPIC TEAM TO COMPETE IN TOKYO

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered first defeat of the season last Saturday night at Bowie in New Hampshire's 10-0 loss. Lifted in third inning after allowing four hits and walking seven. Charged with six earned runs, a career-high.

v. PORTLAND: This is his fourth start against the Sea Dogs, and has had three no decisions. Last time, on June 9, allowed just one earned run in five innings at Hadlock and left with a 3-1 lead. Sea Dogs rallied for a 5-4 win.

2021: Matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in Double-A debut 5/6 G1 at Portland. Allowed 3 runs (1 earned) in 4.0 IP. Followed that up with another eight strikeouts in home opener vs. Somerset. Allowed only one hit (a HR) in his five innings vs. Patriots. Also struck out eight Sea Dogs on May 22. Set a new personal best with nine strikeouts against Hartford June 20.

2019: Didn't miss a start while splitting time with Adv. A Columbia in the Mets system and with the Dunedin Blue Jays after the trade. Went 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in his six starts with Dunedin, with 29 strikeouts in 28.1 IP. Held FSL hitters to a .182 average. Finished the season with a combined 126 strikeouts in 106.2 IP.

2018: In Mets system, made a couple starts for the GCL Mets and Kingsport Mets (Appy League). Did not allow a run in first six outings as a pro.

Career/Personal Notes: On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time, and is the youngest on the roster.

Obtained: Selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2018 draft (Kempner HS, Sugar Land, TX). He was part of the trade on 7/28/19 when the Blue Jays sent RHP Marcus Stroman and cash to the NY Mets for LHP Anthony Kay and Richardson. Pitched only at the Adv. A level in 2019 with Columbia (Mets) and Dunedin (Blue Jays).
