SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 12-2, capping a three-gam sweep. Richmond set a new season high for runs scored and tied their season high with 14 hits. In the top of the third inning, Diego Velasquez and Carter Howell singled in runs before a double by Victor Bericoto opened a 3-0 lead. In the fifth, Aeverson Arteaga and Vaun Brown both hit two-run homers to extend the lead to 7-0. Sabin Ceballos scored on a wild pitch, Arteaga hit an RBI double, a run scored on a double-play groundout and a four scored on a wild pitch for an 11-0 lead. The Baysox scored their two runs in the sixth. In the eighth, Velasquez brought in Richmond's 12th run with a sacrifice fly. Jack Choate pitched into the sixth and allowed one run. Michael Stryffeler and Ian Villers combined for three scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This is Richmond's final trip to Akron this year. The RubberDucks swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season from April 4-6 and took five-of-six at Canal Park from April 22-27. The Flying Squirrels host the RubberDucks from August 26-31. The Flying Squirrels are 2-10 on Tuesdays this season.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,622 fans per home game, which ranks sixth among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS swept the weekend three-game series in Bowie and went 4-2 against the Baysox between the home-and-home sets last week. Their current three-game win streak is tied for their longest this season, even with three wins against the Patriots at The Diamond from May 1-3. Of Richmond's 52 losses this season, 29 of them have been by two runs or less (19 by one, 10 by two). Their 19 one-run losses are the most in the EL, one ahead of Reading (18). The Richmond offense is 11th in the Eastern League in runs scored (268). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.48 ERA.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have lost three straight games after winning their previous five straight. Over the weekend, they dropped all three games at home against the SeaWolves. They swept their three games in Erie to begin last week. The RubberDucks finished the first half in second place in the Southwest Division, two games behind Erie. Akron's roster features three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including SS Angel Genao (No. 2), C Cooper Ingle (No. 8) and OF Kahlil Watson (No. 22). There are three Akron players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects, including Genao (No. 2). Ingle (No. 8) and Watson (No. 20). 2), Ingle (No. 8) and Watson (No. 29).

STRONG ARMS: Since June 17, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 3.04 ERA (49 ER/145.0 IP) in 17 games, which is third-best in the Eastern League. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.46 ERA (11 ER/68.0 IP) in that stretch. In their last eight road games since June 17, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 1.91 ERA (14 ER/66.0 IP).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Seth Lonsway makes his 15th start of the season and the third of his career against the Rubber-Ducks. He last pitched last Wednesday against the Baysox and allowed three runs over five innings with seven strikeouts in a loss. Lonsway has faced the RubberDucks twice in his career, both at Canal Park. On Jul 21, 2024, he allowed one unearned run over 4.1 innings. Earlier this year on April 26, he threw 5.1 scoreless innings and allowed one hit. For the season, Lonsway ranks sixth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (75.1), ninth in ERA (3.58) and 10th in strikeouts (71). In his first eight starts this season through May 20, Lonsway went 2-2 with a 2.40 ERA (11 ER/4.11 IP). Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. He joined the Flying Squirrels last June and went 2-1 with a 1.38 ERA in six outings before his season ended in August. For more on Lonsway, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tommy Mace makes his 16th start of the season and the ninth of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Wednesday at Erie and allowed two runs over five innings in a win. For the year, Mace leads the Eastern league in wins (9) and ranks third in BAA (.201), seventh in ERA (3.50) and eighth in innings pitched (74.2). For his career, Mace is 4-1 with a 1.93 ERA (9 ER/44.1 IP) in eight starts against Richmond dating back to 2023. He spent all of 2024 with Akron, going 8-7 with a 3.71 ERA. He finished the year ranked fifth in the Eastern League in ERA, tied for first in games started (27), fourth in innings pitched (145.2), seventh in BAA (.236) and fourth in WHIP (1.22). Mace was selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the second round (69th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey, Zach Morgan and Onil Perez have combined to catch 43 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 30 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has the third-most runners caught stealing by a catcher in a single season in franchise history, trailing Jackson Williams (35 - 2013) and Andrew Susac (31 - 2013). For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 43 runners caught stealing for his career is tied with Johnny Monell (2011-12) for fourth most in franchise history, six behind Brandon Martorano (49 - 2021-24).

SUGEY SHOW: At the plate. **Adrián Sugastey** is batting .367 (11-for-30) with two homers, a double, six RBIs, five walks and three runs scored over his last nine games since June 21. He has posted a 1.057 OPS in that stretch. In his current five-game hitting streak dating back to June 28, he is batting .444 (8-for-18). He has picked up two hits in each of his last three games, totaling five RBIs. For the season, Sugastey is second on the team with 29 RBIs and is tied for the team lead with eight homers, which is a new career high.

ARTY PARTY: Aeverson Arteaga has three multi-hit games in his last six games since July 1, batting .389 (7-for-18) with a homer, a double, five RBIs, three walks and five runs scored. Last Tuesday, he had his fourth three-hit game of the season. He picked up two singles in Friday night's win at Chesapeake and closed the weekend with a 2-for-3 game on Sunday, adding a homer and a double with three RBIs.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?: Vaun Brown is batting .421 (8-for-19) over his last games since June 27, raising his season average from .192 to .254. In that stretch, he has two doubles, four walks, three stolen bases and three runs scored. On Sunday afternoon in the finale in Bowie, he went 3-for-3 with a double and a walk, scoring twice.

SAVING THE DAY: Tyler Myrick recorded his fifth save of the season on Wednesday night in the completion of Tuesday's rain-suspended game against the Baysox. It was the 17th save of his Richmond career, tying home for seventh on the Flying Squirrels career saves list with **Heath Hembree**. He is three saves behind **Cody Hall** for sixth on the all-time list.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is ranked tied for fifth in hits (73), sixth in OBP (.365) and seventh in walks (42). Turner Hill is tied for second in triples (5). Seth Lonsway is sixth in innings pitched (75.1), ninth in ERA (3.58) and 10th in strikeouts (71). John Michael Bertrand is second in innings pitched (83.2) and eighth in ERA (3.55). Jack Choate is sixth in strikeouts (77) and 10th in BAA (.236). Joe Whitman is ninth in strikeouts (72).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager Dennis Pelfrey has led the team to 231 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Diego Velasquez (No. 7), Joe Whitman (No. 8), Jack Choate (No. 24) and Sabin Ceballos (No. 29). John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. Adrian Sugastey is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Aeverson Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

SHUFFLING THE RANKINGS: Baseball America announced its updated top-30 Giants prospects list this week. Diego Velasquez climbed from 10th to seventh. Joe Whitman dropped from fifth to eighth. Jack Choate climbed from 26th to 24th. Sabin Ceballos dropped from 21st to 29th.
