Today is Teacher Appreciation Night, the fifth game in a seven-game, six-day series between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Dayton Dragons, and part of a larger 18-game season series. The Nuts are 3-3 against Dayton this year and 240-195 all-time vs. the Dragons dating back to 2000.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 9, Dragons 8 (10 innings). Dylan Fien was hit by a Jonah Hurney pitch with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th inning, handing the Nuts their first walkoff victory of the season. Dayton had forced extra innings on an Alfredo Duno two-run homer in the ninth. The game was an epic, lasting three hours and 20 minutes.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has No. 8 (Devin Taylor), No. 16 (Steven Echavarria), No. 19 (Zane Taylor), No. 26 (Nate Nankil) and No. 30 (Bobby Boser) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

All Aboard: Shortstop Bobby Boser went 2-for-6 yesterday to extend his on-base streak to 22 games, every game that he has played this year. The longest on-base streaks to open a season for a Lugnut in recent memory belong to Kevin Smith in 2018 (27 games) and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. in 2017 (29 games).

Home Cooking: Outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. is hitting .395 in 11 home games (15-for-38, 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR); Bobby Boser is batting .364 in 11 home games (16-for-44, 1 2B, 1 HR); and Devin Taylor is hitting .359 in 12 home games (14-for-39, 3 2B, 2 HR, 12 BB) with a .500 OBP and .590 SLG.

Getting On in Bunches: INF Justin Riemer went 2-for-3 with two walks, a single, a home run and three runs scored last night. It was his fourth game this year with at least two hits, his fourth game with at least two runs, and his ninth game with at least two walks. Riemer has walked 15 times in his last eight starts, reaching base 22 times in 37 plate appearances in those games (.595 OBP).

Powering On: When Riemer homered yesterday, it was his second home run since April 21 – after he had homered a grand total of one time in his first 130 professional games. Teammate Casey Yamauchi had two career home runs in his first 230 games – but has slugged four home runs this season.

Cincinnati's Own: Devin Taylor, born in the Queen City, is slashing .394/.488/.621 in his last 19 games, going 26-for-66 with six doubles, three home runs, three steals, and 14 walks. Taylor's personal hitting coach, coincidentally, is 2011 Lugnut Lance Durham.

Dragon Slayers: The Nuts' top hitters this year vs. Dayton: Rodney Green, Jr. (.588/.632/1.235, 10-for-17, 9 R, 5 2B, 2 HR in five games); Bobby Boser (.375, 9-for-24); and, for patience alone, Devin Taylor (nine walks in six games, .278 avg., 5-for-18, .519 OBP). On the other side of the coin, Davis Diaz is 1-for-13 and C.J. Pittaro is 1-for-12 against Dayton pitching.

Milestone Watch: Lansing is seven wins away from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history, plus 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lansing Lugnut in the Majors is Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller. Of his 38 appearances since joining the Padres, 36 have been scoreless – not including his four scoreless innings in the WBC for Team USA.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher Daniel Susac, opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles and a triple through 11 games with the Giants before landing on the 10-day Injured List on April 21. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft in December by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

MAY 1 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: In front of a Saturday night home crowd of 8,212, Chris Hopkins lined a one-out RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, driving in Oliver Dominguez, to defeat the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 3-2, and capture the Lugnuts' 1,000th all-time victory. The win came 5,138 days after the Lugnuts' first victory as a franchise.

2014: Aroldis Chapman made a rehab start for Dayton, striking out D.J. Davis and Jason Leblebajian and retiring Mitch Nay on a flyout to left before departing. The game turned into a pitcher's duel before L.B. Dantzler's grand slam highlighted a six-run seventh inning, and the Lugnuts won, 9-6, at Fifth Third Field.

In a Nutshell: Rated the A's No. 19 prospect by MLB Pipeline... earned his first pro win in his Lansing debut, April 3 vs. Dayton, with five scoreless innings in a 5-1 victory over the Dragons... member of the A's Spring Breakout roster, but did not pitch in the game... made three Cactus League appearances (3 2/3 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 3 HR, 1 BB, 3 K).

Last Time Out: allowed four runs (two earned) in four innings at QC, April 24: 78 pitches, 50 strikes... gave up two runs in 1st and one apiece in 3rd and 4th... five hits allowed were all singles... Nuts scored six runs in the 9th for a shocking 7-6 win at Modern Woodmen Park.

Scouting Report: Pipeline's grades - 55 fastball, 50 curveball, 50 slider, 55 changeup, 50 cutter, 55 control... "A mainstay in UNC Wilmington's rotation over his four years there, Taylor produced one of the best seasons in school history as a senior in 2025 by leading NCAA Division I in K/BB ratio (9.6) and WHIP (0.76), while also ranking second in walk rate (1.0 per nine innings) and fourth in ERA (1.98). Entering the 2025 Draft as one of the top senior arms in the class, he was selected in the fifth round by the A's and signed at a full-slot bonus of \$513,900, becoming the highest-drafted pitcher out of UNCW since supplemental first-rounder Bradley Holt in 2008. With Triple-A Las Vegas in need of a starter at the end of the season, Taylor was called upon for his pro debut with a start for a playoff-bound Aviators squad."

Personal: Spent three years at Pro 5 Academy before graduating from Crossroads Flex; WWBA National Championship All-Tournament 2017-2020; PG High School Showdown All-Tournament 2019... 2025 CAA Pitcher of the Year... 2025 College Baseball Foundation Pitcher of the Year Finalist... tied for UNW record for career starts (57), tied for second for career wins (27)... his college catcher, Bryan Arendt, was also drafted by the A's (13th round).
