**NEW BEGINNINGS:** After winning the final two games of the first half over the Down East Wood Ducks, the FredNats begin the second half of the 132-game 2024 season against Down East on Firework Friday. The Carolina Mudcats are the first half champions in the North and have secured their spot in the Carolina League playoff come September, so now, the other five teams in the division will battle for the second playoff spot in the final 66 games of the year. Tonight, Jarlin Susana makes his third start of the year against Down East, and his start in Kinston against the Wood Ducks three weeks ago started the best stretch of his professional career. Susana faces Down East righty Jose Gonzalez, who has been dominant this season for the Wood Ducks.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: It was another pitcher's duel, with Down East's Kohl Drake pitching six scoreless innings and Travis Sykora allowing just one run and one hit in five innings with a career-high eight strikeouts. The FredNats got the game tied in the 7th on a throwing error by Down East and then appeared to take the lead on a Marcus Brown RBI triple, but the umpires said Roismar Quintana missed third base so the run was erased. FXBG scored three in the 8th to take the lead back, and Sammy Vasquez closed it out for this third save of the year.

**UNBEATEN AFTER 7**: The FredNats remain a perfect 27-0 when leading after seven this year, and also a perfect 29-0 when leading after eight innings, including last night's win over Down East. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

**POLANCO STRONG**: Bryan Polanco's last four starts have given the FredNats a great chance to win each time. Over his last four starts covering 20 1/3 IP, Polanco has allowed just one run each time for an ERA of 1.77. He leads the FredNats in innings pitched this season, and has been a crucial part of this pitching both in long relief in the bullpen and in the starting rotation since mid-May.

**OH SUSANA**: After a very rough month of May, Jarlin Susana has turned his season around big time in his last three starts. In those starts, he's covered 15 innings, allowed just two total runs, and has 24 strikeouts to only seven walks. Susana's strike throwing and overall effectiveness with his plus stuff has vastly improved throughout this season.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 25-5 this season when scoring first, including 22 out of the last 23 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, and had come from behind in its last three wins before yesterday.

**RBI KING**: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 51. This year, Pimentel is hitting .355 with runners in scoring position, and is 12-for-27 (.444) with runners in scoring position and two outs. He's also 5-for-8 with three doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI with the bases loaded this season, being at his very best with the stakes high.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 176-150 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Jarlin Susana is set to make his 12th start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

**EARLY-SEASON HIGHS:** After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Susana continued a strong stretch, with five frames and just a pair of earned runs against the Mudcats last week. They managed three base hits, while Jarlin fanned seven men.
