LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones outslugged Jersey Shore en route to a 10-6 victory on Sunday afternoon at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn scored 6 times in the 2nd inning on 2-run doubles by 3B Mateo Gil and CF Alex Ramírez, as well as a 2-run between the SS William Luga Participal and CF Alex Ramírez, as well as a 2-run doubles by 3B Mateo Gil and CF Alex Ramírez, as well as a 2-run doubles by 3B Mateo Gil and CF Alex Ramírez, as well as a 2-run double so the base of the control of the c home run by SS **William Lugo**...Ramírez added a solo home run in the 6th as part of a 3-hit, 3-RBI day...Lugo collected 2 hits, 2 runs scored, and 2 RBI...2B **Chase Estep** picked up a career-high 4 hits and drove in a run in the 9th...RF **Omar De Los Santos** tallied a run-scoring knock in the 3rd and garnered his 20th stolen bag of the year...7 of the Cyclones' 9 batters picked up at least 1 hit and 8 of the 9 reached base at

NOT SO STUART LITTLE: At 6-foot-9. RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May... Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified pitchers in Minor League Baseball — in ERA (1.43)...Stuart is also 10th in the circuit in innings pitched (44.0) and WHIP (1.20)...The Kankakee, Ill. native is also 2nd in LOB% (87.2%), 2nd in FIP (2.87), 4th in xFIP (3.48), 7th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 8th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him average (6-55) against him.

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 19 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 40 earned runs (54 total) on 123 hits through the last 160.0 innings...That is good for a 2.25 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia is 2nd in MiLB (2.52)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 72 (10.8 BB%) and struck out 192 in that span (28.8 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 85-54, over the 19-game stretch...Brooklyn is 11-8 during that span.

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.16) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.58) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.38) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...San Francisco's Double-A Richmond leads MiLB (3.14).

1-2, E-STEP: After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 24 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .317/.385/.512 with a .897 OPS...Estep has accumulated 14 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 14 RBI in 91 plate appearances... The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 142 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 177 points in that time (.047 to .224).

GOING, GOING, GIL: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .265/368/.592 and he has registered an impressive .960 OPS, 152 wRC+, and .422 wOBA in that time...Gil is 13-for-49 at the plate (.265) with 10 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (4) and extra-base hits (8)...The former 3rd-round pick is also tied for 3rd in the league in RBI (13), 4th in slugging (.592), and 6th in OPS (.960)

UP TO PAR-ADA: C Kevin Parada extended his on-base streak to 9 games with a walk on Sunday...The 21-year-old is 11-for-his-last-37 (.297) with a run scored, 3 doubles, 2 RBI, and 3 walks...Parada holds a 102 wRC+ and .340 wOBA in that span...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (14)...Since the start of May, Parada is tied for 4th in the circuit in two-baggers (10) and tied for 6th in the league in extra-base hits (13).

ALL GAS, NO TE-BRAKE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 6 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 3 walks over 9.1 innings, registering 15 strikeouts...That equates to a 42.9 K% (15/35).

**OH YEAH, OMAR:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** is 11-for-his-last-37 (297) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, 4 stolen bases, and a 107 wRC+...In addition to his 20 stolen bases in 2023, he remains among the best base stalers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 90 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (97), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), , Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (94), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (91) have swiped more...De

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 5 of Boston's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: SS/3B Eddinson Paulino (11), RHP Wikelman González (12), 1B/3B Blaze Jordan (14), IF Brainer Bonaci (16), and LHP Dalton Rogers (29)...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League.

Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 38...Omar is already 12 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Cyclones were swept in Saturday's twinbill and dropped to 1-7 in doubleheader games in 2023...All 4 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...The 'Clones are 21-21 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games this year.

**DÉJÀ VU:** Brooklyn was handed a walk-off defeat for the 6th time this season in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader...3 of those 6 have come at the hands of the BlueClaws at ShoreTown Ballpark...This is in addition to the Cyclones' 4 walk-off victories in 2023... The first of which came vs. Jersey Shore on a bases-loaded walk to **Chase Estep** in the 11th on Opening Day...20.0% (10-of-50) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón tossed another gem on Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts last Friday vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore... In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

AT HIS BECK-ON CALL: RHP Jace Beck has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 AT HIS BECK-ON CALL: KHIP Jace Beck has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strikeout rate of 44.4% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is tied for 3rd in strikeout rate (44.4%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is the best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cincinnati's LHP **Jacob Heatherly** (19.89) is 2nd at Single-A Daytona.

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore last Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occured in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21... Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP Keyshawn Askew (6.0 IP) and RHP Jeffrey Colón (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that day. CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Tuesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (184), at-bats (607), plate appearances (726), runs scored (95), walks (99), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (190), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (112).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)... INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists... OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.
