TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 6-game set at Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: Mason Martin smacked a solo homer in a 5-1 loss to Harrisburg. Omar Cruz was charged with the loss after allowing three runs in the 5th inning of a bullpen day.

JUNE SWOON: Altoona finished off the month of June with an 11-15 record, a month in which they were 9th in team batting average and 10th in team ERA. **Liover Peguero** led the Curve with 7 home runs in 24 games during June with a .969 OPS and a .308 average. On the mound, **Nick Dombkowsk**i turned in his finest month of the campaign with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER/17.2 IP) in 6 games, 2 starts.

PEGGY'S POP: Infielder Liover Pequero picked up his second multi-homer game of the season on Wednesday, June 28 at Harrisburg with a pair of solo shots. Peguero became the 28th player in Altoona's franchise history to hit two homers in a game more than once in their Curve career. Since 2021, **Henry Davis, Aaron Śhackelford** and **Mason Martin** have each had multiple two-homer games in

OUR NEW LEADERS: Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH) announced its intent to acquire the Curve from long-time owners Joan and Bob Lozinak on Wednesday, June 28. Mr. Bob and Joan who brought the team in Altoona to begin play in 1999 owned the team for 18 of their 25 years as a franchise.

ONE HALF DOWN: Altoona finished the First Half with an even 34-34 record, good for second place in the Southwest Division behind Erie. The Curve stumbled down the stretch of the first half, setting a franchise record for most consecutive home runs allowed in a game (13) a stretch in which they went 4-9. Henry Davis, Kyle Nicolas, Jared Jones, Travis MacGregor, Josh Palacios and Juan Minaya were key first half contributors who were promoted to Triple-A and to the Pirates active roster. Altoona finished the first half T-5th with a .235 team batting average and a team ERA of 4.46, good for 4th in the Eastern League.

A LOPSIDED DEFEAT: Bowie pounded Altoona into a 15-1 defeat on Saturday, June 24 at PNG Field. The 14-run margin of defeat was the largest since August 21, 2021 when the Curve fell by the same score in the first of a doubleheader at Erie.

THE BIG LEFTY: Altoona welcomed lefty Anthony Solometo to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in the Eastern League behind Somerset's Jasson Dominguez (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17. Solometo struck out six in 5.0 innings in his PNG Field debut on June 23 against Bowie. He has a 1.80 ERA in two starts for the Curve.

NEED A CLUTCH KNOCK: The Curve are last among Double-A teams when batting with a runner in scoring position at two outs, hitting just .191.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 15-of-18 games played including 4 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI, including a game-tying 2-run homer on Sunday, June 11 to aid Altoona to a 5-4 comeback win in 10 innings. Gutierrez was acquired from the Phillies in exchange for LHP Braeden Ogle in July of 2021 and the two worked as the battery on Friday, June 9.

Altoona catchers have a .806 OPS this season, good for 4th-best among Double-A teams this season.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Saturday, July 1, Altoona has struck out 578 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Managed by former Expos star Delino DeShields, the Senators went 31-37 in the First Half and have several top Nationals prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 1 OF James Wood, No. 5 OF Robert Hassell III, No. 12 RHP Cole Henry, No. 17 RHP Zach Brzykcy, No. 18 INF Trey Lipscomb, No. 22 LHP Mitchell Parker, and No. 26 RHP Gerardo Carrillo.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Michael Cuevas takes the ball tonight for Harrisburg. A 22-year-old selected in the 23rd round by the Nationals in 2019 out of Brennan HS in San Antonio, Texas, Cuevas makes his 14th start of the season tonight. Cuevas works with a low-90's fastball and a good slider and changeup to keep hitters off-balance, though he's experienced some bad luck this year with a 342 batting average on balls in play (BABIP).

2015 - Steven Brault earns his first AA win in a 2-0 victory at Trenton after he pitched a one-hit, seven-inning masterpiece. He sat down his first 12 hitters, allowed a double to Gary Sanchez before he retired his last nine hitters.

2021 - Picking up a suspended game from the night before at Hartford, the Curve smash 4 home runs in a 15-7 win. Altoona matched a franchise record with 3 home runs in the 5th inning from Cal Mitchell, Oneil Cruz and Rodolfo Castro. Mitchell recorded his first career multi-homer game in the win.
