### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays affiliate) are set for game two of six-game series on Wednesday night at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Round Rock fell to Durham on Tuesday night, 7-6, in walk-off fashion. The Bulls took a 2-0 lead in the fifth via a RF Brock Jones two-run homer. Round Rock plated a run in the sixth on 2B Diego Castillo's RBI single. DH Dom Keegan answered with an RBI single in the bottom of the sixth for a 3-1 advantage. In the top of the ninth, the Express rallied with five runs on six hits for a 6-4 lead. The Bulls had the last word, plating three runs in the final frame. 2B Gavin Lux tallied an RBI single, C Tatem Levins drew a bases-loaded walk and Keegan delivered the winner with his third RBI single of the night. Durham walked it off for a 7-6 win in the series opener.

### WHERE WE STAND

The Express are now a season-high 8 games below .500...are on a 5-game losing streak...have lost 7 of their last 8...are now 1-17 when scoring fewer than 5 runs and 4-13 when allowing 5 or more...is the first time in club history the Express have started 0-4 in the month of May.

### INTER(NATIONAL)-LEAGUE PLAY

This week's 6-game series in Durham marks the first time the 2 clubs have met...the Express faced 3 International League opponents in 2025, hosting Toledo and visiting Charlotte and St. Paul...went 13-5 and 2-0-1 in those series...this season, went 1-5 against Gwinnett at Dell Diamond (4/1-4/5).

### WALK IT OUT

Round Rock's 13.7% walk rate is the third-highest in the PCL and fifth in Triple-A. Saturday's 13 walks are tied for the second-most in a game in the Express Triple-A era (2005-2026). They walked 10+ times in a game only three times all of last season and have done it four times this year.

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE

LHP Thomas Ireland owns a 1.86 ERA (2 ER/9.2 IP) with four walks to 13 strikeouts after 3.1 innings of one-run baseball with two hits, no walks and six strikeouts on Saturday... among 42 pitchers age 24 or younger with at least 7.0 Triple-A innings this season, Ireland (23 years, 310 days) has the fifth-lowest ERA—and the lowest in the Pacific Coast League (18 qualifiers). His fastball has a 40.0% whiff rate which is 4th among PCL pitchers (min. 100 pitches).

### LOOKING FOR THE LONG BALL

Round Rock is 30th in Triple-A in home runs (22) and 29th in slugging percentage (.350). They have and have hit four home runs in their last 12 games. They are averaging 4.5 runs per game.

### HEY STEPHAN

Round Rock RHP Josh Stephan made his 7th start on Tuesday night and struck out a career-high 11 batters without issuing a walk...since 2005, when the Express became a Triple-A club, 13 Round Rock pitchers have struck out 11+ batters in a game, Stephan is 1 of 3 that did not issue a walk.

### THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SUNDAY, MAY 6, 1984

It was 19-year-old rookie Dwight Gooden versus 37-year-old Nolan Ryan on a Sunday afternoon at Shea Stadium in front of 39,294 fans as Astros took on the Mets and Houston won, 10-1. Gooden couldn't escape the third inning, allowing eight earned runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Ryan tossed a complete game, surrendering just one earned run on a George Foster double in the first frame. He allowed six hits, walked two and struck out seven. 22-year-old right fielder Darryl Strawberry went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts. In the third inning, Gooden faced nine batters and allowed eight to reach base. All eight eventually scored. Billy Doran walked twice in the inning, while Craig Reynolds and Enos Cabell each delivered RBI singles. Jerry Mumphy added a bases-loaded walk, Phil Garner lined a two-run single, a wild pitch brought home another run and Mark Bailey capped the inning with a sacrifice fly to score the eighth run. Gooden entered the outing with a 2.63 ERA through his first five major league starts. After the game, Ryan said he was impressed with Gooden's stuff and recognized the control issues the young right-hander was battling. Ryan also understood the pressure of pitching in New York. "Your first year in New York is always tough for a player. But part of the game is the fan buildup, the media attention. I had to get accustomed to it. He has to get accustomed to it," Ryan said.

### MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

### PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

### BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

### BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

### HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP from 2014-21. ### DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and as a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.
