**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, make up a Tuesday postponement with a doubleheader against the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. Today is also Day 9 and Games 8 and 9 of a 12-game, 13-day homestand, that began with Lansing winning four of six against Quad Cities. Today is also a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday with \$2 domestic and \$5 craft drafts.

**Quality Starters:** The Nuts are expected to start right-handers **Christian Fernandez** and **Mitch Myers** in today's twinbill, with each coming off a six-inning quality start last week against Quad Cities, the Lugnuts' first two quality starts of the year. Dayton counters with right-handers **Carson Rudd**, a Stanford undrafted free agent, and **Javi Rivera**, drafted out of Florida Atlantic.

**Last Night: Dragons 2, Lugnuts 0.** For the first time in 688 days, **Brady Basso** appeared in a game for the Nuts, tossing 1 2/3 hitless, scoreless innings with three strikeouts. But **Ruben Ibarra** delivered an RBI groundout in the fourth inning and a sacrifice fly in the sixth inning, and **Hunter Parks** combined with three relievers on a four-hit shutout to lift Dayton to the series-opening win.

**Double Your Fun:** Today is Lansing's fourth doubleheader of the season, with the club getting swept at Lake County on April 20, splitting a second twinbill at the Captains on April 23, and splitting with the Quad Cities River Bandits on April 30. One more doubleheader remains to be played, with the Lugnuts making up a postponement against Lake County in two weeks.

**Streiking:** OF **Caeden Trenkle** singled in his first at-bat yesterday, finishing 1-for-4, to extend his on-base streak to 18 games.

**Nuts Among the MWL Leaders:** OF **Lazaro Armenteros**, promoted to Double-A Midland on Tuesday, continues to lead the circuit with six home runs and a .723 slugging percentage. OF **Jonny Butler** ranks first in triples (4), INF **Jack Winkler** is tied for second in doubles (7) and OF **Caeden Trenkle** is tied for fourth in runs scored (14).

**Heating Up:** C **Daniel Susac** tripled yesterday in four at-bats, his second triple of the year, and is hitting 9-for-23 (.391) with two walks during the current homestand. In the process, he has raised his slashline from .180/.226/.340 to .247/.295/.452. Also playing well: INF **Jack Winkler**, who was slashing .193/.270/.281 entering April 26, but is 6-for-15 (.400) with two doubles, five walks and four stolen bases in five games since, raising his line to .236/.337/.333.

**Due for a Knock:** OF **Junior Pérez** has not collected a base hit since April 15 and is hitless in his last 27 at-bats.

**Miller's Time:** 2022 Lansing right-hander **Mason Miller**, who worked three hitless innings with seven strikeouts against the Dayton Dragons last September 10, fired seven hitless innings with six strikeouts for the Oakland Athletics on Tuesday night against Seattle, walking four and departing due to pitch count (100 pitches).

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Trailing 5-2 to South Bend, Ryan Goins singled and scored in the bottom of the 8th and then capped a two-run game-tying rally in the 9th with an RBI single. It went for naught, though, as the Silver Hawks scored two runs in the 11th for a 7-5 win. South Bend DH Matt Davidson went 4-for-5 with a single, a double, and two homers off starter Ryan Shopshire, scoring three runs and driving in four.

**2015:** The Lugnuts appeared on the verge of blowing a 7-2 lead, but second baseman Tim Locastro made a ridiculous diving stop on a Franklin Navarro potential RBI single sizzler that hopped off the pitcher's mound with a headlong lunge, popped to his feet, raced to second for a force, and whipped a throw to first base to end the game. The Nuts beat the Whitecaps 7-6 at Cooley Law School Stadium.

**Life as a Lugnut in 2022:** Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

**Path Through the Pros:** Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

**2022 Dominance in the Rays' System:** Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.

**In a Nutshell:** Opened season as the Lugnuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year in last outing, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Lugnuts was also the only other Panther ever to play for the Nuts: T.J.
