**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve continue up a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators, the teams meet a total of 24 times this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Altoona's pitching staff combined on a 2-hitter and **Andres Alvarez** smacked his 11th home run of the season in a 6-0 win. The Curve used 4 hits to plate 4 key insurance runs in the 7th inning to secure the victory.

**TOUGH 2 HIT:** Curve pitchers **Aaron Shortridge**, **Dillon Peters**, **Duane Underwood Jr.** and **Tyler Samaniego** combined on a 2-hitter on Friday, July 1 in a 6-0 win over Harrisburg. It was the fewest hits allowed by the Curve in a 9-inning game this season, Curve pitching held Reading to 1 hit in a 4-0 win in the first game of the doubleheader on June 8.

**TRIPLE REHABBERS:** The Curve welcomed UTL **Tucupita Marcano**, RHP **Duane Underwood Jr.** and LHP **Dillon Peters** on rehab on Tuesday, June 28 against Harrisburg. It marked the first time in franchise history that Altoona has hosted 3 rehabbing Pittsburgh Pirates in the same game. Marcano is recovering from a stint on the COVID IL (6/17), while Underwood is also recovering from a stint on COVID IL (6/13) and Peters is recovering from a back injury (6/3).

All three played in 2 games with Altoona, Peters combined on 3.0 scoreless innings across his two outings (1 H, 0 BB, 3 K), while Underwood fired 3.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 0 BB, 3 K) and Marcano went 1-for-6 with 3 walks in his two games on rehab.

**ONE HALF DOWN:** With the first half of the season coming to an end on Sunday, June 26, the Curve finished the first half with a 33-36 record in 4th place in the Southwest Division. They rank 1st in Team BA (.252), R (340), 2B (129), and 2nd in OBP% (.335). In the month of June, Altoona leads the Eastern League with 93 BB.

**HAMMERING HANK:** Curve C **Henry Davis** began his Curve career 3-for-35 in his first 10 games before stringing together 3 straight multi-hit games to finish the series at New Hampshire (6/24-26). Over his last 6 games he's batting: .348/.444/.652 (8-for-23) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI and 3 BB.

**BIG LEAGUE CURVE:** With 2019-21 Curve OF Bligh Madris became the 194th alumni head to the majors after their time in Curve, PA with his major league debut on Monday, June 20 against the Chicago Cubs. Madris became the 11th alumni to debut this season, joining **Diego Castillo**, **Beau Sulser**, **Jack Suwinski**, **Cam Alldred**, **Cal Mitchell**, **Yerry De Los Santos**, **Canaan Smith-Njigba**, **Jason Delay**, **Liover Peguero** and **Cam Vieaux**. In 2016 and 2018 the Curve had 14 players make their debut, a figure that could easily fall by the time the 2022 season wraps up.

Curve INF **Liover Peguero** became the third player to be recalled directly to the major league roster on Friday, June 17 when INF **Tucupita Marcano** went on the COVID IL on short notice. Peguero arrived in Pittsburgh in time for first pitch and made his major league debut on Saturday against San Francisco going 1-for-3 with a walk. He became the first Pirate born in the 21st century to suit up for Pittsburgh.

**LET'S HIT:** The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 16-of-their-41 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 23 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.250) and total hits (606); they hold a 11-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

**NO LEAD IS SAFE:** Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 37 of 73 games played this season and hold an 26-11 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 15-2 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Altoona pitchers have surrendered 76 home runs on the season, tied for 27th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (95). The Curve have allowed a home run in 45 of 72 games.

**THE MEN FROM THE SENATE:** Managed by Tripp Keister, Harrisburg finished the first half at 30-39 and continue to feature a veteran core. LHP Brian Gonzalez (Bowie, Hartford), Ronald Herrera (Trenton), Franklin Kilome (Reading), Edgar Garcia (Reading), Wilson Garcia (Akron) and Dakody Clemmer (Akron) all feature previous EL experience. Additionally, the Senators recently added 1B John Nogowski who had a cup of coffee with the Pittsburgh Pirates last season and provided quite a jolt.

**THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER:** Righty Franklin Kilome takes the ball today for Harrisburg. A former Philadelphia Phillies farmhand, Kilome signed with the Nationals in April and has gone 1-3 with a 4.91 ERA in 7 appearances, 6 starts for the Senators. On May 27, he threw 4.0 scoreless innings in relief against Altoona. Kilome just turned 27 and was a top-15 prospect for the Phillies before he was swapped to the New York Mets in exchange for INF Asdrubal Cabrera leading up to the trade deadline in 2018. Kilome made 4 appearances with the Mets in the pandemic-affected 2020 season totaling 11.1 IP he allowed 14 runs and struck out 13.

**CAREER NOTES**

**2022:** Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 right-handed pitching prospect in all of minor league baseball entering the season... Suffered an oblique injury at the end of spring training and missed all of April and May before returning for a rehab assignment beginning on Thursday, June 9 with Bradenton vs. Clearwater in which the Marauders threw a combined no-hitter (Priester 3.0 IP, Anthony Solometo 4.0 IP, Jake Sullivan 1.0 IP, Yunion Thaibo 1.0 IP), game was caught by rehabbing Curve C Henry Davis... Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...

**2021:** Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system... Was also ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by *Baseball America* entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... Spent the entire season in Greensboro's rotation, went 7-4 with a 3.04 ERA in 20 starts... His 3.04 ERA was the second-best mark among Pirates minor leaguers (minimum 90.0 IP) behind Bradenton's Adrian Florencio (2.46)... Picked up his first two wins of the season in back-to-back starts on May 18 and May 25 by throwing 5.0 scoreless innings... Completed 5.0 innings in each of his four starts in the month of July, going 1-0 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER / 24.0 IP)... **Was selected to appear in the Sirius/XM Futures Game at Coors Field, worked 0.2 of an inning and struck out one batter...** Finished a career-best 7.0 innings for the second time on August 13 against Winston-Salem, struck out a career-high 10 and did not allow a run... Was named the High-A East Pitcher of the Week for the week ending August 29 after he delivered 6.0 scoreless innings on August 27 and allowed just one hit and no walks, struck out a career-best 13 - began the game with nine consecutive strikeouts and 11-of the first 12 batters he faced, combined with Colin Selby on a one-hitter... Finished the regular season as the High-A East's Pitcher-of-the-Year and was named a Post-Season All-Star after finishing as the league leader in ERA (3.04), batting average against (.225), home runs allowed per nine innings (0.74), WHIP (1.24) and Winning Percentage (.636)... Also was second in games started (20), third in innings pitched (97.2) and tied for eighth in wins (7)... Also had the lowest batting average on balls in play (.285), ranked third in K/9 (9.03), strikeout percentage (24.1) and Fielding Independent Pitching (4.08)... Started Game Two of the High-A East Championship Series and picked up the win, went 5.0 innings and allowed just one run on three hits and two walks, also struck out seven to even the series at one game apiece...

**2020:** Entered season ranked by *Baseball America* as Pittsburgh's sixth-best prospect... Was a member of the alternate training site roster in Altoona... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system at the conclusion of the season...

**2019:** Allowed two earned runs or fewer in six of his seven starts in with the GCL Pirates... Made his professional debut as a starter on 7/2/19 (2.1ip/3h/1r/1bb/2so) against the Gulf Coast League Braves... Picked up his first professional win on 7/29/19 against the GCL Braves after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings of work... **CAREER TRANSACTIONS:** Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove High School in Cary, Illinois...Signed on June 10, 2019

**CURVE CUTS:** Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholarship from Northwestern University to play football and baseball for the Wildcats... Was named a 2019 Rawlings Perfect Game pre-season All-American... Was also ranked as the 19th-best prospect by MLB Pipeline in the 2019 draft... Became the first high school player from the state of Illinois to be selected in the first round since Houston's Mike Foltyniewicz in 2010... Was listed by *Baseball America* as the No. 1 draft prospect in the state of Illinois... Was a Fox Valley All-Conference selection during his senior year of baseball...
