ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians dropped their second straight game to the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Wednesday night, as the C's failed to keep up with the high-powered 'Sox offense in a 7-3 loss.

After the AquaSox - considered by many as one of the most talented rosters in all of Minor League Baseball - started the scoring with a run in the first, Vancouver scored two in the second to lead 2-1. Tanner Morris worked a lead-off walk before Luis De Los Santos singled to put two men aboard. Sebastian Espino singled home Morris then a free pass to Eric Rivera loaded the bases. Everett induced a double play that forced home a run to give the C's a one-run advantage.

The 'Sox used a three-run third to take a lead they wouldn't relinquish. Four consecutive hits scored two runs to start the inning before a sacrifice fly plated the third run of the stanza to put the Mariners affiliate up 4-2 as they led the rest of the way.

Right-hander CJ Van Eyk (L, 0-1) battled through four innings in his fourth professional start. The #10 Blue Jays prospect faced 20 batters and gave up four runs on seven hits with two walks and two strikeouts, though he showed flashes of brilliance with two perfect stanzas.

Davis Schneider hit his second home run of the season in the fourth to bring the Canadians within one, but a run in the top of the sixth and two in the seventh for the AquaSox put the game away. Cobi Johnson was the only C's hurler to not allow a run. The right-hander tossed two shutout innings of relief in the eighth and ninth that included three strikeouts.

FEELING SOXY: The Everett AquaSox (Mariners) hop into town this week for the first of 6 series between these two clubs, for a total of 36 head-to-head matchups. Everett will be a tall task for the C's; entering today, the Sox lead or are among leaders in all of Advanced-A in AVG (.256, T-1st), R (137, 1st), H (175, 1st), TB (403, 2nd), 2B (49, T-1st), HR (23, T-5th), RBI (123, 1st), BB (113, 2nd), OBP (.369, 1st), SLG (.449, 2nd) & OPS (.818, 2nd).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

TICK TOCK: In the last seven games, Vancouver is playing at a 2:55 pace. Only 8 of 20 games the C's have played in have gone three hours or longer.

REMEMBER ME?: 20 Canadians baserunners have been stranded on base in the first two games of this series and the team is 1-20 with runners in scoring position.

TURF TALK: The C's are batting .241 in 14 games on turf this season, juxtaposed with a .226 mark in 6 tries on natural fields.

GOOD LUCK, ESPECIALLY LATE: Vancouver hurlers have limited right-handed batters to a .191 average this year, and all hitters have only mustered a .183 average against the C's staff in innings seven through nine.

DO YOUR JOB: Four different spots in the Canadians batting order are hitting north of .270 this year. Vancouver hits .273 in the lead-off slot, .315 in the three-hole, .288 batting clean-up and .289 hitting sixth.

ATTACK MODE: Vancouver has found a lot of success at the plate swinging early in the count. They've amassed a .421 average when going after the first pitch, .368 in 1-0 counts, .342 when ahead 2-0 and .382 when it's 2-1.

HOR-WIZ: Spencer Horwitz continues to find ways to get on base. His 22 walks are tied for the third-most in Minor League Baseball and his .519 on-base percentage is the fifth highest in the country among players with 10 or more games under their belt this season.

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Luis Quinones returns from an 80-game suspension to make his Advanced-A debut tonight for Vancouver. The 23-year-old tested positive for Nandrolone, a performance-enhancing substance in violation of the Minor League Drug Prevention and Treatment Program, in September of 2019. Coincidentally, his last outing came on September 1 of that year against Everett at Funko Field, when he took the loss after surrendering six runs on five hits in 2.1 innings pitched. All told in 2019, Quinones went 2-2 with a 2.95 ERA in 12 games (four starts) across Rookie-level Bluefield and Short-Season Vancouver. While with the C's in '19, he struck out 47, walked 17 and held opponents to a .155 batting average. A native of Arecibo, Puerto Rico, Quinones was drafted by Toronto in the 34th round of the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto Junior College in San Jacinto, TX. He spent part of his prep career at Wabash High School in Wabash, IN after moving from his native Puerto Rico.

Right-hander Evan Johnson will make a spot start for Everett tonight after scheduled starter and #3 Mariners prospect Emerson Hancock was scratched due to "workload management." Johnson has appeared in four games out of the AquaSox 'pen this season; he last took the hill on May 20 in Spokane, when he earned the win with 2.1 innings in which he allowed one run on two hits (including a solo home run) walked one and struck out two. His finest outing was on May 13 against Tri-City, when he went a season-high three innings and allowed no runs on one hit with no walks and five strikeouts. Johnson, 24, was signed as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2019 after playing collegiately at Creighton. He's from Ames, IA, the home of Iowa State.
