Tonight's Games: The Nashville Sounds return to the diamond as they start their 2023 season at First Horizon Park with a Saturday doubleheader following yesterday's postponement of Opening Day. Game one will feature a couple of right-handers with Caleb Boushley starting for Nashville and Levi Stoudt starting for Louisville. Game two will follow with Colin Rea on the bump for the Sounds and Brandon Williamson pitching for the Bats.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley will be the Sounds starter for game one. It is his first career opening game start at any level in his professional career. He finished tied for the International League lead in wins with Memphis' Thomas Parsons. The Wisconsinite was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. He was originally selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Levi Stoudt: 25-year-old Levi Stoudt starts for the Bats in game one. Like his counterpart on the mound, this is Stoudt's first opening game start at any level. The right-hander pitched for two organizations (Seattle and Cincinnati) and three teams last year. He is ranked as the No. 15 prospect in the Reds organization by MLB Pipeline and the No. 16 prospect by *Baseball America*. Stoudt was originally selected in the third round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Mariners out of Lehigh University.

Colin Rea: 32-year-old Colin Rea gets the nod for the Sounds for game two. The right-hander from Cascade, Iowa, went 5-6 with a 3.96 ERA in 23 games with the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks of the Japanese Pacific League in 2022. The Brewers signed Rea as a free agent on January 28 and invited him to spring training. He has pitched in the Majors with San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021). Rea went 4-2 with a 2.27 ERA (35.2 IP/9 ER) across seven starts for Nashville in 2021.

Brandon Williamson: 24-year-old Brandon Williamson goes for Louisville in game two. The left-hander enters the year as the No. 10 prospect in the Reds organization by both MLB Pipeline and *Baseball America*. The Texas Christian product combined to go 6-7 with a 4.11 ERA (122.2 IP/56 ER) across 27 starts between Chattanooga and Louisville a season ago. Cincinnati acquired Williamson in the trade that sent LF Jesse Winker and 3B Eugenio Suarez to the Mariners on March 14, 2022. He was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star with Seattle in 2019 and 2021.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 0, Fourth: 0, Fifth: 0, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

Running It Back: The Sounds look to defend their division title after winning the International League West by 4.5 games over the Toledo Mud Hens in 2022. The club's 91 wins led Minor League Baseball and marked their first 90+ win season since 1980. Their .611 winning percentage (91-58) ranked fourth in the full-season minor leagues (Single-A and higher). The Sounds first took sole possession of first place on April 24, then resecured control of the division on May 5 and never looked back. The Sounds fell to the East Division champion Durham Bulls in the International League Championship Game in Las Vegas, Nev.

Opening Day History: Heading into their 45th season, the Sounds are 20-24 all-time on Opening Day. In season openers in Nashville, the Sounds are 14-10 all-time. Nashville hosted Opening Day last season, winning 5-4 in a 10th-inning walk-off over the Durham Bulls.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 10 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 14 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 16 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 600-518 record during an eight-season span.

Young Guns: Sal Frelick is the youngest member of Nashville's Opening Day roster at 22 years old. After being taken as the 15th pick in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by Milwaukee, the phenom out of Boston College has climbed from Rookie ball to Triple-A in just two seasons. Cam Robinson is Nashville's next-youngest player at 23 years old after playing in 11 games with the Sounds last season and leading the minor leagues with 25 saves.

LAST OUTING: Boushley started the International League Championship on October 1, 2022 vs. Durham. He tossed 2.0 innings and allowed five runs (all earned) on five hits, three walks and one strikeout. Boushley took the loss as the Sounds fell to Durham 13-0.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is facing Louisville for the third time in his career, all coming in 2022. His most recent start came on 9/23/22 in Louisville, when he struck out eight over 6.0 one-run innings. Boushley is 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (6 ER/17.0 IP) and 14 strikeouts in his career against the Bats.

LAST OUTING: Rea's last outing in affiliated baseball came with Milwaukee on October 2, 2021 against the Los Angeles Dodgers. Rea entered the game in the third inning and finished the contest. He tossed 6.0 innings and allowed five runs (all earned) on seven hits, including two home runs. Rea struck out five but did not factor into the decision as Milwaukee fell 8-3.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Rea has two career appearances, both starts, against Louisville. He is 1-1 with a 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP/4 ER) and five strikeouts facing the Bats.
