### Shipping Up to Boston's Affiliate Portland

The Fightin Phils finish a three-game series today at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the last-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-nine in Portland. Portland leads the season-series 13-7 over Reading, alreading clinching a victory in the season series.

### Saturday Slug Fest

The Fightin Phils rode four homers and a five-run first to a nail-biting 6-5 win over the Sea Dogs on Saturday. Reading started with five runs in the first inning, as 10 R-Phils came to the plate. Gabriel Rincones Jr. hit a solo homer in his first at-bat off the injured list, then Otto Kemp launched a three-run shot in the first inning. Leandro Pineda followed with his first Double-A home run to make it 5-0 Reading at the end of the first. Portland then added a run in the second, two in the third, one in the fourth and fifth thanks to three home runs off Robinson Pina. Pina allowed five runs over five innings, but did earn his 10th win of the season. Reading's bullpen worked in and out of jams in the game's final three innings, but the Fightin Phils held on for the 6-5 victory to even the series.

### Crawford's Dazzling Debut

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford showcased all of his tools in a stellar debut on Friday night. He had three hits, which included two doubles into the gaps and an infield single, where he showcased his elite speed. He additionally manufactured a run pretty much all by himself. After walking, he moved to second on a passed ball and then stole third, and ultimately came around to score on a ground out. Additionally, Crawford showcased elite defense with two diving catches and multiple other impressive catches in center field.

## **Bombs Away**

Since June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 54. That recent surge has propelled the Fightin Phils to first in the Eastern League in home runs with 97. They currently lead second-place Somersrt by one. That stretch featured a team-best home runs in 13-straight games from June 13-28, which tied a mark set by the 2016 Fightin Phils. Reading also had a 10-game home run streak from July 3-14. It was the R-Phils' second-longest home run streak of the season. Reading's four home runs in the first inning on Saturday night was a season-high for homers in an inning.

### Kemp's Roll

Ever since his call-up from High-A Jersey Shore on June 11, he has eight homers, 23 RBI, a .539 slugging percentage and .908 OPS. His eight home runs have come in just 29 games so far with Reading. Since June 11, Kemp is tied for the Eastern League lead in home runs at eight. He's also tied for fourth in RBI, is sixth in slugging percentage and also sixth in OPS.

### Moves on Moves

The Phillies announced a lot of roster moves to the Reading roster prior to this weekend's series in Portland. Justin Crawford, Leandro Pineda, Erick Brito, Eiberson Castellano and Andrew Walling were all called up from High-A Jersey Shore. Additioanlly, Gabriel Rincones Jr. was activated off the 60-day IL and made his return to the Reading lineup on Saturday night. Walling made his first Double-A appearance on Saturday night and Castellano will make his Double-A debut on the mound today.

## This Day in Baseballtown History

July 22, 2023: At Altoona, Reading wins 4-1 behind one of the best starts in Griff McGarry's career. The Phillies No. 4 Prospect goes seven innings (career high), allows just three hits, issues no walks, and has ten strikeouts (season-high). It's the fourth time in McGarry's career he had 10+ strikeouts and it set a season-high in innings pitched for a Reading arm and matched the team-high in strikeouts by a single pitcher.

## Sea Dogs Synopsis

Portland enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 36-33 record. They are third in the Northeast Division with an 11-7 record in the second half of the season. Portland most recently took three-of-six on the road at Hartford. Following this week, Portland heads to Somerset. Portland's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

### Portland Pitche

Righty, and Red Sox No. 25 overall prospect, Hunter Dobbins makes the start today for Portland. This season, Dobbins is 6-2, with a 3.54 ERA over 15 starts (73.2 IP, 63 H, 30 BB, 68 SO). Dobbins last pitched July 14 at Hartford, going just two innings, allowing one hit, no runs, one walk and two strikeouts in a no-decision. In three starts against Reading this season, Dobbins is 2-0, with a 1.69 ERA (16 IP, 12 H, 6 BB, 15 SO). Dobbins split 2023 between High-A Greenville (7 starts) and Portland (13 games/12 starts), combining to go 9-6, with a 3.67 ERA over 20 games and 19 starts. He made his pro debut in 2022 with Single-A Salem, going 0-5, with a 5.22 ERA over 17 starts. Boston drafted the 24-year old out of Texas Tech in the eighth round of the 2021 draft. Dobbins was with the Red Raiders from 2019-21. He missed 2021 with Tommy John Surgery prior to being drafted by the Red Sox.
