THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

On August 18, 2019, Northwest Arkansas Naturals third baseman Emmanuel Rivera hit a walk-off single in the 10th inning, scoring Gabriel Cancel from second base in a 9-8 win over the Tulsa Drillers ... the Naturals batted around in the first inning, sending 10 hitters to the plate and Blake Perkins hit a two-run inside-the-park home run in the 3rd inning, going 3-for-4 with four runs batted in over the night.

Shutout Saturday... The Naturals played a close game Saturday night, going for a series split in their final game against the Springfield Cardinals this season. Springfield put up three quick runs in the opening frame against starter Drew Beam, who managed to work 5.0 innings despite the rocky start. Jorge Alfaro got NWA on the board with a homer in the second while Beam threw up a pair of zeroes in the second and third. In the top of the fourth, Alfaro and Sam Kulasingam singled. Daniel Vazquez tried to get a sacrifice bunt down, but ended up reaching with a hit to load the bases. Justin Johnson unloaded on a 3-2 pitch, blasting it into the left-center field berm to give the Nats a 5-3 lead. Springfield scored again in the bottom of the inning to make it a one-run game but Kulasingam drove in a run on a sac fly to give NWA a two-run edge. The bullpen held the Cardinals offense at bay and, despite allowing a run in the eighth, locked down a 6-5 victory with Dennis Collieran Jr. picking up the save.

Hunter Owen: POTW... LHP Hunter Owen dominated in his lone start last week against Springfield on Saturday, setting a career mark with 12 strikeouts over his 7.0 innings of work. The southpaw flirted with perfection into the fifth before he walked Ryan Campos to allow the first baserunner of his night. Owen tied his career-high in innings pitched while blowing passed his high in strikeouts (9) en route to his second win of the year and first since May 12 against the Arkansas Travelers. The 12 strikeouts are also a season-high for an NWA pitcher and tied for the second-most in club history behind Danny Duffy's 13 in 2013. The last pitcher to K a dozen hitters in an outing was RHP Steven Zobac who accomplished the feat on August 7, 2024 in Amarillo, TX. His efforts led to MiLB announcing Owen had won the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week award, the first POTW award of his professional career.

Makin' Moves... The Naturals experienced some roster turnover ahead of the six-game series with San Antonio. INF Maikel Garcia was returned from his rehab assignment while RHP Beck Way joins the Nats on rehab. OF Carson Roccaforte and LHP Hunter Patteson earned promotions to AAA Omaha. The Naturals added RHP Shane Panzini from AAA Omaha while INF Angel Acosta joins the Naturals from A+ Quad Cities.

This is the Way... RHP Beck Way joins the Naturals on rehab following low back spasms and tightness from July 28. Beck is no stranger to wearing a Naturals jersey. The righty arrived in NWA in 2023 and spent parts of 2024 and 2025 with the club. Way transitioned from a starter to a bullpen role in 2023 and collected 12 saves during his first full season as a reliever in 2024 where he owned a 6-3 record with a 3.88 ERA. Way is a hard-throwing righty from Harrisburg, PA, with a wipe-out slider whose appeared in 19 games with the Royals this year after making his MLB debut on June 5. In his first season of MLB action, Beck i 1-1 with a hold over 19 games and one start, owning a 3.86 ERA.

30 Roc... Carson Roccaforte leaves the Naturals with the second-most homers in a single season in NWA history prior to his promotion to AAA Omaha on Tuesday. Roccaforte became the second player in Naturals history to reach at least 30 long balls in a season, the other being Matt Fields when he hit 31 in the 2013 season. He hit 35 blasts in his Northwest Arkansas career, which ranks fourth on the franchise leaderboard. Roccaforte is one shy of Alex Liddi on the all-time homer list, who hit 36 jacks over his Naturals tenure. Over his last 17 games with the Nats, Roccaforte hit 11 home runs – tied for the most for any MiLB player in that span. He's also the first player in club history with 20+ homers and 20+ steals in a season.

One the Road Again... After earning a series split with the Springfield Cardinals thanks to wins Saturday and Sunday, NWA finds themselves in San Antonio, Texas, for the back leg of the final two-week road trip of the year. The Naturals return to Nelson-Wolff Stadium for the first time since April of 2025 where they threw the fourth no-hitter in club history. The only player remaining on the roster from the four pitchers who tossed it is RHP Brandon Johnson, who closed out the game. That series, which the Nats split with the Missions, was the second road trip of 2025. This year's edition is the second-to-last road series of 2026.

The Royals Family... The Kansas City Royals are back at home, hosting the Athletics at 6:40 PM CT. LHP Daniel Lynch IV (4-4) gets the ball for the Royals this evening. AAA Omaha is home against the Rochester Red Wings (WSH) with RHP Vince Velasquez (2-1) getting the start for the Storm Chasers at Werner Park at 6:35 PM CT. LHP Jordan Woods (0-2) is on the bump for the Quad Cities River Bandits this evening for their 6:05 PM CT first pitch against the Dayton Dragons (CIN) in Dayton, OH. The Columbia Fireflies have a doubleheader today against the Augusta GreenJackets (ATL). The first game was scheduled to start at 4:35 PM with RHP Shane Van Dam (3-6) on the bump for Columbia. RHP Michael Braswell III is scheduled to start the second game of the twin bill for the Fireflies. The DSL Royals Ventura won 23-4 over the DSL Padres Brown team earlier today. DSL Royals Fortuna lost their game this morning to the DSL Astros Orange team, 9-3.

Grant Gambrell was the recipient of a “tough-luck loss” in his lone start against Springfield last week. The righty held the Cards to one run on three hits over 5.0 innings without issuing a walk, but the Naturals lost the game 3-1. Gambrell is making his third start of the season since joining NWA from the American Association’s Kansas City Monarchs. Gambrell is making his 72nd MiLB appearance and the 65th start of his career.

Reunion... Gambrell returns to the Royals organization after getting drafted in the 2019 MLB Draft by Kansas City. The righty started the 2021 season with High-A Quad Cities and posted a 4.37 ERA over five starts before getting traded to the Boston Red Sox during the campaign. While pitching for Double-A Portland in the 2023 season, Gambrell went 6-3 with a 3.42 ERA with 84 punchouts in 84.1 innings. Gambrell reached Triple-A in 2024, and spent time in the Mexican League and American Association since. Gambrell has reunited with the Royals system and he entered the starting rotation following the All-Star break.

Last Time Out... Gambrell joined the Naturals in July of 2026, and he hasn’t pitched in Minor League Baseball since the 2024 season. The right-hander’s most recent start in MiLB was on July 25, 2024, for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox against the Scranton-Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. Gambrell dealt six scoreless innings, issued one walk and struck out four batters. He exited with a 1-0 lead, but took a no-decision. In July of 2024, Gambrell went 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA over 15 frames. The righty punched out nine batters, owned a 1.00 WHIP and held opponents to a .173 batting average in the three-game span.

Reign of the Monarch: This season, Gambrell made three starts for the Kansas City Monarchs of the American Association. In those three starts, he went 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA over 17 innings. Gambrell walked just two batters and fanned 14 for Kansas City. The right-hander also pitched for the Monarchs during the 2025 season, going 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA in seven appearances. Gambrell’s contract was purchased by the Royals after his stellar start to the season with the Monarchs in 2026.

Beantown... After getting traded to the Red Sox in 2021, Gambrell underwent five surgeries to remove a benign tumor in his heel bone. He missed the entire 2022 season before making his season debut on April 13, 2023, for High-A Greenville. Gambrell was recognized by SoxProspects.com as the Comeback Player of the Year. With three different teams in Boston’s system that season, Gambrell combined to go 9-6 with a 3.63 ERA over 23 starts.

National Champ... In 2018, Gambrell and the Oregon State Beavers won the College World Series. Oregon State became the second team in College World Series history to win a championship after losing its first game of the tournament and the first game of the championship series. As a sophomore, Gambrell went 5-1 with a 4.40 ERA and recorded 57 strikeouts over 57.1 frames during that season. Gambrell posted a 2.83 ERA for the Beavers a season later before getting drafted by the Royals.

PERSONAL: Gambrell sports a 44 Pro custom glove while pitching. He’s one of a handful of MLB and MiLB players who use a 44 Pro, and Gambrell has the company’s Instagram handle promoted on his own IG bio.
