FRES-NOTES

THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THE OFFENSE: Fresno has swung it well against Visalia this season, hitting .300 with a .374 OBP, .468 SLG and .842 OPS through the first six meetings. The Grizzlies have outscored the Rawhide 35-23 in the season series and enter the fourth game of this six-game set with a 4-2 record against Visalia.

RETURN OF THE O'DOWD: Jack O'Dowd has been Fresno's loudest bat in the Highway 99 Rivalry, hitting .455 with a .538 OBP, 1.091 SLG and 1.629 OPS against Visalia. He has five hits in 11 at-bats, including two doubles, a triple and a homer.

BRITO AWAKENS: Roldy Brito continues to do damage in the matchup, hitting .407 with a 1.023 OPS against the Rawhide. He has 11 hits, four doubles, a triple, six RBI and four stolen bases in six games against Visalia.

ATTACK OF THE PITCHING CLONES: Fresno pitching has controlled the series, going 4-2 with a 3.23 ERA against Visalia while holding the Rawhide to a .199 average. Grizzlies arms have struck out 62 hitters in 53 innings, with Ethan Cole, Dylan Crooks, Austin Emener, and Manuel Olivares all posting scoreless work in the matchup.

THE EMPIRE WALKS A LOT: Fresno continues creating offensive pressure by forcing deep counts and getting on base. The Grizzlies rank among the California League leaders with a .370 team OBP and have already drawn 179 walks this season. Cameron Nelson ranks near the top of the league individually with 29 walks, while Clayton Gray owns a .433 OBP through his first 29 games.
