

LAST TIME OUT: Aberdeen defeated Brooklyn in walk-off fashion for the 2nd-straight day, 3-2, on Friday night at Leidos Field...**Dylan Beavers** delivered a game-ending 2-run single with 1 out in the bottom of the 9th...The Cyclones grabbed a 2-1 lead in the top of the inning on a DH **Chase Estep** sacrifice fly...C **Kevin Parada**, 3B **William Lugo**, and RF **Scott Ota** each tallied multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHP **Tyler Stuart** hoisted 6.0 innings of 1-run ball, striking out 6 for the 'Clones...IronBirds RHP **Ryan Long** punched out 5 and allowed 1 run over 5.0 frames of work.

TY-NAMIC: RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run ball on Friday night and is as imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May... Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.47)...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (88.2%) and FIP (2.90), 5th in xFIP (3.38), 6th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.96), 7th in batting average against (.218) and strikeout rate (30.0%), 8th in WHIP (1.15), 9th in innings pitched (55.0), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (67).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 5 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 2011P) with just 10 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 20 and struck out 33 (14.61 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 36.7% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .143 batting average (10-20) arainst him rate is 36.7% during (10-70) against him.

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has picked up steam at the plate in June...The 23-year-old tallied a season-high-tying 3 hits in Wednesday's win over the IronBirds and added 2 more knocks on Thursday...Omar is 7-for-15 (.467) in the series with 2 extra-base hits and 3 RBI...Since the beginning of the month, De Los Santos is batting .321 (18-56) with 8 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and 6 stolen bases...The right-handed swinger is tied for 3rd in the SAL in hits (18), tied for 4th in stolen bases (6), tied for 7th in total bases (26), and tied for 8th in batting average (.321) during June...Additionally, De Los Santos has added 24 stolen bases in 2022 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 94 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 5th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (103), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (99), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (96) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 54 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time... Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 8 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has found his stride at the dish dating back to the series finale at Jersey Shore on June 4...In his last 11 games, the 21-year-old is slashing .286/.333/.500 with a .833 OPS and 126 wRC+...Lugo is 12-for-42 (.286) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 3 home runs, and 6 RBI...He has also added a walk, 2 hit-by-pitches, and a pair of stolen bases...Lugo had 3 multi-hit contests in his first 29 games, but has accrued 5 in his last 11 outings.

HAIL CÉSAR: INF César Berbesi enters Saturday's contest on a roll offensively...The 23-year-old has picked up a base-hit in 4-straight ballgames (6-for-12) and is slashing .389/.476/.667 in his last 6 games dating back to last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Greenville...In 11 contests during the month of June, Berbesi is 11-for-33 (.333) with the bat, tallying 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 4 RBI, 4 walks, and 4 stolen bases 4 stolen bases

D'ANDRE DELIVERS: 2B **D'Andre Smith** set a career-high with 4 hits in Brooklyn's victory over Aberdeen on Wednesday...The 22-year-old also added 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases in the win...Since being reinstated from the injured list before last week's series vs. Greenville, Smith is 10-for-25 (.400) at the plate in 7 games...The former USC Trojan has added 3 RBI, a walk, and 3 stolen bases...Smith has also registered at least 1 hit in 6-of-his-7 games played.

MATEO MASH: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 19 of his last 22 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .257/.337/.541 and he has registered an impressive .878 OPS, 135 wRC+, .390 wOBA, and .284 ISO in that time...Gil is 19-for-74 at the plate (.257) with 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 5 home runs, and 16 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for the league lead in home runs (5) with several others...He is also 6th in slugging (.571), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (11), tied for 8th in RBI (16), and 9th in OPS (.878)...Gil leads the Cyclones in home runs (6) despite having 24 fewer plate appearances than OF Stanley Consuegra and 110 fewer than OF Alex Ramírez who have each clubbed 5.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 32 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .288/.339/.441 with a .780 OPS...Estep has accumulated 18 runs scored, 7 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 16 RBI in 121 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 113 wRC+...In his first 12 outlings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 174 points in that time (.047 to .221). vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road to begin a 6-game road trip against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds posses 7 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball Amer-ica*: SS Jackson Holliday (1), OF Jud Fabian (13), 3B Max Wagner (14), OF Dylan Beavers (19), C Creed Willems (21), RHP Trace Bright (27), and RHP Jean Pinto (28)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium for the first time since the 2022 SAL Postseason...Aberdeen won both postseason contests at home to defeat Brooklyn, 2-1, in a Best-of-3 series from September 13-16...In 2023, the IronBirds and Cyclones have split the first 6 games of the season series...Both teams won 3 contests in their matchup at Maimonides Park from May 2-7.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Green-ville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Open-ing Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramirez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after Friday's loss at Aberdeen...23.3% (14-of-60) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion and 40.0% (24-of-60) have been determined by just 1 run, including each of the team's last 6 affairs.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.28) in the entire South Atlan-tic League and 2nd-best among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids leads (3.07) the classification...Hudson Valley (3.38) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 4th best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia and Cedar Rapids lead MiLB (3.07).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville and added another 2 more scoreless frames out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday and Thursday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.35)...Only Rome's RHP Luis Vargas (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.84 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 3.9% strikeout rate holds a 33.9% strikeout rate.

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...The 22-year-old tossed 3.2 innings of spotless work on Thursday night at Aberdeen...Over his last 2 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 6.2 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 1 walk, striking out 7...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.58 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.2% strikeout rate with a 10.0% walk rate.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 8 relief appearances...Tebrake has allowed 2 earned runs (3 total) on 4 hits and 6 walks over 12.2 innings, registering 21 strikeouts (14.92 K/9)...That equates to a 42.9 K% (21/49).

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (194), at-bats (636), plate appearances (761), runs scored (98), walks (105), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauri-cio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón did not receive a decision after permitting 1 earned run (2 total) over 4.1 innings on Thursday at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 5 appearances (4 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER in 23.0 IP), allowing 17 hits and 10 walks, striking out 24...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.


