LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (32-24, 68-56) defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks (27-29, 58-67), 9-8, in 10 innings on Saturday night at HODGETOWN. Amarillo trailed big early as Corpus Christi plated six runs in the first two innings, though the Soddiess had scratched one in the first on **Angel Ortiz's** RBI double. **Avery Owusu-Asiedu** added a sac fly in the third before Ortiz drove in another in the third. **Wellington Aracena** limited further damage to get through five innings. Alejandro Nunez homered for the Hooks in the sixth to make it 7-3. Down four in the ninth, **Gavin Logan** and **Junior Franco** hit back-to-back jacks to lead off the frame and later with two outs Ortiz hit a game-tying two-run home to send it to extras. The Hooks scored one in the 10th, but the Soddiess rallied with a bases-loaded walk and **Cristofer Torin's** walk-off single for the 9-8 victory.

NEVER A DOUBT: Prior to last night since 2005, there had only been three instances across Double-A where a team was trailing by four or more runs headed into the ninth inning and used at least three home runs to erase the deficit...only two of those instances resulted in the team winning the game in that inning or in extras...Amarillo is the first team in that timeframe to win such a game at home...furthermore, the Soddiess had only successfully come back from a four-run ninth inning deficit once in their history, doing so on July 10 last season at home against Frisco, ultimately winning 13-12 in 11 innings.

GRAN TORIN-O: Coming through with the walk-off single in the 10th inning last night was **Cristofer Torin** while the shortstop extended his hitting streak to eight games with the three-hit effort...it was Torin's fourth career walk-off RBI and his first walk-off knock since July 27, 2025 with High-A Hillsboro...over 21 August games, the shortstop is batting .400 (36x90) with 27 runs, six doubles, five home runs, and a 1.076 OPS...he leads the Texas League in runs and hits this month while ranking tied for 3rd in batting...the Soddiess record for most hits in a single calendar month is 39 (Ivan Castillo, June 2019) while the record for most runs in a single calendar month is 28 (Ryan Waldschmidt, August 2025).

ANGEL EYES: A big night at the plate for **Angel Ortiz** has extended his hot stretch at the plate as the outfielder is batting .444 (12x27) with seven runs, five XBH, 11 RBI and a 1.368 OPS over his most recent seven games...last night, he became the seventh Sod Poodle all-time to hit a game-tying or go-ahead home run with Amarillo down to their final out.

AOA-OK: Since joining Amarillo on August 11, **Avery Owusu-Asiedu** is batting .439 (29x66) with a .513 OBP, 18 runs, five doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 29 RBI and a 1.558 OPS while leading Double-A baseball in hits, total bases (69), home runs, RBI and OPS over that span...his 11 home runs in August matches Manuel Pena's May this season for the most homers in a single calendar month in club history...between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he has now reached base in 23 straight contests (8/1-c)...across MiLB since July 22, he ranks 1st in total bases (106), 1st in OPS (1.306, min. 89 PA), 1st in RBI (41), tied for 3rd in hits (49), and 2nd in home runs (16) over 33 games played.

FOREVER YOUNGBLOOD: **Trent Youngblood** has reached base in 17 straight games (8/11-c)...he ties **Drew Jones** (6/9-7/1) for the 2nd-longest on-base streak among Soddiess this year and is batting .258 (17x66) over this span.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Across 120 MiLB squads, only Triple-A Memphis has played more extra innings games this season (23) than Amarillo (20)...the Soddiess still lead MiLB in extra innings wins this year with 13...last night was their 10th walk-off of 2026, the most any Soddiess team has had in a season in club history.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Gavin Conticello led the charge in Triple-A Reno's 12-2 thumping of Sacramento last night, going 4-for-5 with two runs, a double, and three RBI...he is batting .305 with a .917 OPS as an Ace this year.

SUMMARY

- Currently ranked the No. 4 D-backs prospect by MLB Pipeline.
- Acquired by the Diamondbacks via trade with the Rangers on July 31, 2025 in a deal that sent Merrill Kelly to Texas in exchange for LHP Kohl Drake, LHP Mitch Bratt and Hagaman.
- Selected by the Texas Rangers in the fourth round (133rd ovr.) of the 2024 MLB Draft...agreed to a \$515,000 signing bonus.
- Did not play in 2024 after signing with the Rangers as he was placed on the full-season injured list...underwent internal brace surgery late in May 2024.
- Graduated from Holy Spirit High School in Absecon, New Jersey...was a Cape Atlantic League National Conference All-Star and Perfect Game/Rawlings Preseason All-America High Honorable Mention in 2021...previously played at Cedar Creek High School.

LAST TIME OUT

- A pair of Hooks singled in the opening frame to put Hagaman in an early bind, but the top-ranked pitching prospect in the Diamondbacks organization was able to record back-to-back strikeouts to strand the runners and eliminate the scoring chance.
- Hagaman caught Walker Janek looking at strike three to open the fourth inning to pick up his fifth strikeout of the night, but Jason Schiavone got a pitch he liked from the righty and hit a solo home run to right field to put the Hooks on the board...despite the long ball, Hagaman picked up strikeouts number six and seven to retire the side.
- Hagaman tossed a perfect fifth inning and exited the game in the sixth with two outs...responsible for the runner on second base, reliever Dawson Brown allowed a two-run homer to Schiavone on the last play of the game to charge Hagaman with a second earned run...the game was called due to inclement weather in the top of the sixth inning.

REVERSE SPLITS

- Left-handed hitters in High-A batted just .178 against Hagaman this season...among starting pitchers at the level with at least 15 games played, Hagaman's BAA was second-best and his 1.09 WHIP ranked fourth following his last start on August 1.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won his second NWL Pitcher of the Week award for the week of June 28 following his June 24 performance against Vancouver...over 6.0 scoreless innings, Hagaman allowed just two hits and three walks while striking out eight.
- Turned in the longest outing of his career on June 30 vs. Spokane by tossing in seven shutout innings to extend his then-active scoreless streak to 13.0 innings pitched.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made his professional debut on June 5 with the ACL Rangers...turned in two perfect innings and struck out four as the starting pitcher.
- Made two more starts in the Arizona Complex League before being called up to Single-A Hickory...was the starting pitcher for the Crawdads on June 29, where he shut out the Salem Red Sox over three no-hit frames, walking one and striking out two in his team debut.
- Had one of the best outings of his young career during his third start with High-A Hillsboro on August 20 against Eugene...set career highs with 5.0 innings pitched and eight strikeouts, earning his first win as a pro in the process.
- Followed up that start with four no-hit innings vs. Vancouver on August 27, where he walked one and struck out seven Canadians...his performance led to him being crowned the Northwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 24.
- His 27 strikeouts from August 6 - September 3 were tied for ninth-most in the NWL.
- Pitched 12 innings in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafters...allowed six earned runs while striking out 14 and walking seven batters.

COUNTRY ROADS

- Played collegiately at West Virginia from 2023-2024 after redshirting his true freshman season in 2022...was a NCBWA Freshman All-American and All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2023.

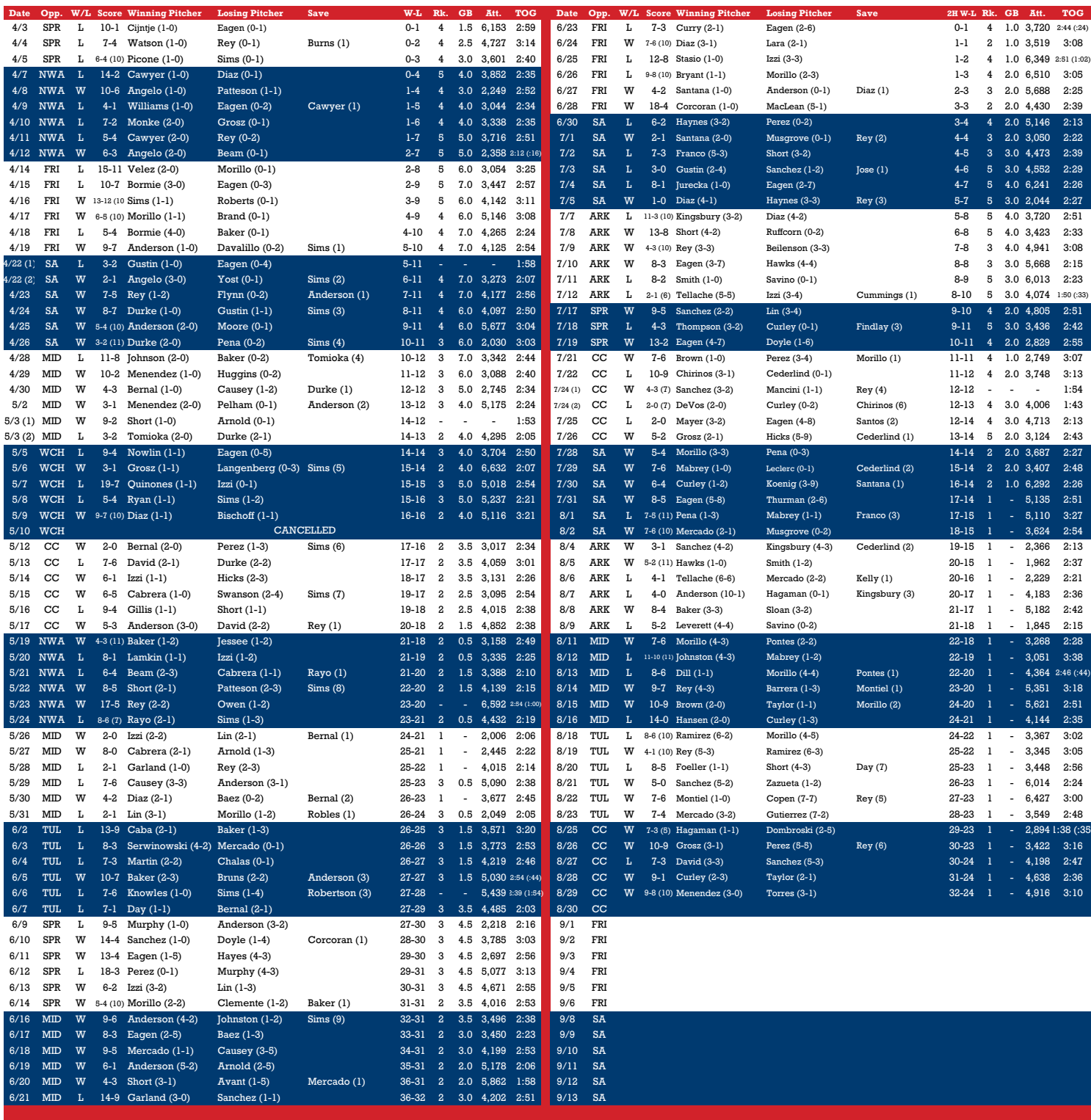
