Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 9-1 in the series opener on Tuesday at Mirabito Stadium. Jose Peroza hit a solo homer in the sixth inning to account for Binghamton's only run. Daniel Juarez threw a careerhigh four innings out of the bullpen and tied his season high with five strikeouts.

Double Trouble: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have found success in doubleheaders this season. The Ponies have swept two doubleheaders, against Hartford and last week at Reading, while splitting their other two DHs.

Happy Birthday, Jose: Infielder Jose Peroza has homered in three of his past five games, including Tuesday night's blast to the train tracks over the left field wall. The 22-year-old is now tied with Matt Rudick for the current team lead with nine homers. Peroza ranks top 10 in the Eastern League in five offensive categories: 4th in SLG (.568), T-4th in XBH (24), T-4th in 2B (14), 6th in OPS (.953), and 7th in AVG (.302).

Happy Birthday, Christian Scott: RHP Christian Scott, the Mets' No. 27 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, will make his Double-A debut tonight on his 24th birthday. Scott is coming off one of the best starts of his career for High-A Brooklyn, as he tied a career high with five innings and totaled a career-high nine strikeouts on Friday against High-A Greenville. He will make back-to-back starts against Boston Red Sox affiliates in High-A and Double-A.

Rudick Rules: Outfielder Matt Rudick reached base four times in the series opener against Portland on Tuesday, extending his league-leading on base percentage. He ranks in top 10 in the Eastern League in six offensive categories: 1st in OBP (.449) T-1st in R (43), 3rd in OPS (.966), T-4th in BB (41), 6th in AVG (.303), 10th in SLG (.517).

Southern Tier Shortcakes: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies will play as the Southern Tier Shortcakes in the second game of the doubleheader through Saturday to coincide with the 41st anniversary of the Owego Strawberry Festival. The team will wear special Shortcakes-themed jerseys and New York Mets legend Darryl Strawberry will make a guest appearance on Friday. The Ponies will give out a Darry Strawberry "Southern Tier Shortcakes" bobblehead to fans on Thursday and on Saturday fans will receive a Southern Tier Shortcakes R.E.D. T-Shirt.

Last Start: Moreno had his best performance of the season in his last start on Friday at Reading. He twirled a season-high and Double-A career-high seven innings and tied a season high with seven punch outs. He allowed just one run and tossed a season-high 102 pitches in the outing.

2022: Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and went 4-0 with a 2.68 ERA in nine appearances and three starts. Was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on June 1, 2022, where he went 4-7 with a 2.92 ERA. He tallied 70 strikeouts in 77.0 innings for Brooklyn and totaled 107 strikeouts across the two levels in 2022.

BACKGROUND: Signed with the Mets as an international free agent on June 8, 2019. He is entering his fourth season and fifth year with the Mets' organization in 2023. Coming into 2023, he has appeared with the DSL Mets, St. Lucie, and Brooklyn.

Last Start: Scott tied his career high with five innings pitched and struck out a career-high nine batters on Friday against the Greenville Drive for the Brooklyn Cyclones in Coney Island. He allowed just two hits and one walk in five shutout innings. Scott will make his Double-A debut today.

2022: Scott made 18 appearances and nine starts across two levels at Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. He held a 3.80 ERA in his five starts and six appearances for the Cyclones last season. Across the two levels, Scott held a 77-to-22 K-to-BB ratio.

BACKGROUND: Scott was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Florida. Scott made four starts for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League this past fall, alongside Rumble Ponies outfielder Brandon McIlwain and pitcher Mike Vasil. He currently ranks as the Mets' No. 27 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He totaled a 12-5 career record in 55 appearances and five starts with a 3.72 ERA, three saves, and 111 strikeouts across 121 innings pitched for the Gators across three seasons from 2019-2021. As a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Scott went made 26 appearances and one start going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 54 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in appearances in 2021, leading the Gators. Led Calvary Christian Academy to the 2018 4A State Title in Floriday and was a First Team All-American selection by MaxPreps. Was a member of the USA Baseball 2016 17U National Team Development Program.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
