RIDERS WIN SECOND-STRAIGHT GAME IN FINAL AT-BAT:

The Frisco RoughRiders held on to win another tight game at Dickey-Stephens Park with a 3-2 win over the Arkansas Travelers Wednesday night. Center fielder **J.P. Martinez** threw out the game's tying run from center field in the bottom of the ninth for the final out in the one-run win. Frisco (34-31) designated hitter **Sandro Fabian** broke a scoreless tie in the sixth inning with a shot up the left field line and over the fence for his ninth home run of the season. Left fielder **Dustin Harris** scored on a **Justin Foscue** sacrifice fly in the top of the ninth to give Frisco the 3-2 advantage. Wednesday night's game lasted six innings before a run was plated. Frisco starter **Avery Weems** struck out five batters in three scoreless innings, giving up two walks on four hits. The Travelers stranded two runners on in the first and stranded the bases loaded in the second. Arkansas (34-31) right-hander **Emerson Hancock** lasted 3.2 scoreless innings and finished with a pair of strikeouts. Rob Kaminsky struck out three in 2.1 scoreless out of the Travs bullpen. Frisco entered the seventh inning with one hit offensively but got back-to-back hits from Foscue and Fabian. Foscue singled with one out to set up Fabian's two-run home run off Arkansas reliever Braden Shipley, giving Frisco a 2-0 lead into the stretch. As they did in Tuesday night's game, the Travelers answered late with a two-run double in the bottom of the eighth inning from catcher Jake Anchia, who had the two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh in Tuesday's game. Frisco broke the 2-2 tie in the ninth when Harris reached on a fielding error from Travelers reliever Travis Kuhn (1-2). Harris scored from third on a Foscue sacrifice fly to right field to retake the lead, 3-2. After allowing the game-tying runs in the eighth, Riders reliever **Grant Anderson** (4-0) returned for the ninth to face Arkansas, who produced back-to-back base hits with two outs. With Travelers first baseman Jake Scheiner attempting to score on a Kaden Polcovich single, Martinez fielded the grounded ball in center field and relayed to catcher **David Garcia** in time to apply the tag and finalize the Wednesday 3-2 win.

PLAYOFFS? YOU WANT TO TALK ABOUT PLAYOFFS?

The Riders win on Wednesday, moves Frisco 1.5 games out from first in the South Division with four games remaining in the first half of the season. Frisco does not own the tie-breaker over San Antonio, who has played two fewer games than the Riders this season, so the Riders must jump San Antonio. The Frisco elimination number is now four, meaning that any combination of San Antonio wins and Frisco losses that equal four will clinch a playoff spot for the Missions. Frisco has won five of its last six games.

OFFENSE AND MORE OFFENSE:

A recent power surge has ballooned the Riders team OPS to .809, the 6th-best mark in the minors. Before just three hits on Wednesday, Frisco had five-straight games with double-digit hits and since June 4th, over 16 games, the Riders are hitting .294/.360/.500 as a team with 25 home runs and 5.6 runs per game. Over that stretch, Frisco has had 10 or more hits in 10 games.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonathan Ornelas** has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. Over his last 14 games, Ornelas is hitting .350 (21-for-60)/.388/.550 with a double, a triple, three home runs, 13 RBIs and five runs. This season, he leads the Riders with 26 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is leading all active hitters in Double-A with a .342 batting average while he is second in hits (82). His batting average is the eighth-best in the minors and he is tied for the second-most hits in MiLB.

BEING THE BIGGER(S) MAN:

Since coming back from the Injured List, **Jax Biggers** has been on fire for Frisco. Biggers had a 14-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday, batting .362 (21-for-58)/.403/.466 with three doubles, a home run, four RBIs, eight runs, three walks and two stolen bases. Biggers played 91 games with Frisco in 2021, hitting .224/.287/.321 with 12 doubles, four home runs and 14 steals.

GOT IT BY MORE THAN JUST A HAIR:

Trey Hair has been crushing the baseball in June. He homered in five-straight games in Amarillo, a franchise record for consecutive games with a home run. Hitting home runs in four straight been done five times, most recently by **J.T. Wise** from August 28-31, 2014 prior to Hair. On Monday, Hair won the Texas League Player of the Week award. Over his last 14 games, Hair is batting .273/.333/.709 with three doubles, seven home runs and 14 RBIs. His seven homers in June are tied for the most in the Texas League during the month and tied for sixth in the minors.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 19 games, Strahm is hitting .426 (26-for-61)/.521/.590 with three doubles, two home runs, 12 walks, 13 runs and five RBIs. His .426 average since May 27th is the best in Minor League Baseball among qualifiers. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .268 and his OPS from .528 to .773. In his last 25 games, he is batting .361/.459/.482/.941. Among those with at least 180 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is sixth in walk rate (16.6 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-19 when scoring three runs or fewer and 17-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 65 games, Frisco has hit 91 long balls (1.3 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and 10th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 193 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 65 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 46 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 19 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 8-11. **Blaine Crim**, **Dustin Harris** and **Trey Hair** are tied for the team lead while being tied for seventh in the league with 12 home runs.

ABOUT CODY

-Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-5A MVP Pitcher award.

-Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

-At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.

-After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.

-Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

2022 SEASON

-Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.

-Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

-Allowed career-highs in runs (10) and walks (4) in start on April 22nd against Northwest Arkansas. Gave up a grand slam to former Baylor teammate Nick Loftin in loss.

-Start at Wichita on 5/31 was cut short due to rain that suspended the game with one out in the top of the second inning. Started and went 4.0 IP on Sunday of the series.

2021 SEASON

-The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.

-Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).

-Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.

-On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Asheville in a win.

-Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.

-Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.

-Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.

-Struck out 25 batters over 16.1 innings in the Fall Developmental League, tying him for the most in the Rangers system with Zak Kent.
