LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones erased a 2-1 deficit entering the 8th inning en route to a 10-2 win at Aberdeen on Tuesday...C Chris Suero led the charge with 4 hits, including a go-ahead 2-run single in the 8th and another RBI single in the 9th...Brooklyn scored 4 in the 8th, sending 9 to the plate, and 5 more in the 9th, with 1 hitters coming to bat...DH Boston Baro collected a pair of hits, including an RBI double in the 8th and a run-scoring single in the 9th...RF Carson Benge and LF Eli Serrano III posted multi-hit games, as well...All 9 Brooklyn batters reached base safely, while 8-of-9 accrued at least 1 hit...LHP Jonathan Santucci tied a career best with 6 strikeouts over 5.0 innings of 2-run ball...RHP Noah Hall earned the win, posting 4.0 hitless and shutout relief innings.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are in a 2-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds a 0.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division with 2 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn can clinch the division on Wednesday with a win and a Greensboro loss at Greenville.

'CLONES IN THE CLUTCH: Brooklyn has dominated the latter stages of games in 2025...Despite trailing 2-1 through 7 innings on Tuesday, the Cyclones scored 4 in the 8th and 5th in the 9th en route to a 10-2 win...ln 2025, Brooklyn has outscored opponents 67-22 (+45) from the 8th inning on..The Cyclones have outdueled their foes, 33-9, in the 8th, 30-11, in the 9th, and 4-2, in the 10th inning and beyond.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer has had a fabulous start to the 2025 season...Entering pla Wednesday, Reimer leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (49)...The Yucaipa, Calif. n is 2nd in slugging percentage (.519) and doubles (17), tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (29) and bles (17), 3rd in total bases (111) and hits (61), tied for 3rd in triples (4), 4th in OPS (.909) and (39), 8th in batting average (.290), and 10th in on-base percentage (.390)...Reimer was limit just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate...The 2024 first-round pick enters Wednesday leading the South Atlantic League in doubles (18) and is tied for the league lead in triples (5)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (46) and hits (64), 3rd in slugging percentage (.498) and OPS (.916). 4th in batting average (.306) and extra-base hits (27), 5th in on-base percentage (.418) and total bases (104), tied for 5th in walks (37), and tied for 7th in RBI (37)...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Wednesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (45), tied for 3rd in triples (7), 6th in on-base percentage (.449), and 10th in batting average (.335)... Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (31), registering 7 more than anyone else...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.423), 3rd in walks (29), tied for 3rd in triples (3), 4th in batting average (.307) and hits (46), and 10th in OPS (.836)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (31), 3rd in batting average (.307) and on-base percentage (.423), and 9th in OPS (.836)...The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9ro-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 5 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 score-less inning performance in a no-decision on June 4 at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has a 4-0 record with a 1.20 ERA (4 ER in 30.0 IP) with 17 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 32 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in May 10's win vs. Asheville...The southpaw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs on May 10...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.20) and is tied for 1st in wins (4)...He is also 3rd in batting average against (.160), 5th in WHIP (0.90), 6th in innings pitched (30.0), and tied for 7th in strikeouts (32).

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on June 5 at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Wednesday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.39), tied for 6th in innings pitched (60.1), and 7th in batting average against (.200).

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (30)...He is also 3rd in on-base percentage (.405), 5th in OPS (.873), and 10th in batting average (.294) and slugging percentage (.468)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit. 447 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Wednesday with 143 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (158)...The 143 steals are tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (185)...Brooklyn already has 6 players with 10-or-more steals on the season and 9 players with 5-plus...The 143 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 64 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 47 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 96...The Cyclones are 38 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

GIRT 'ER DONE: After tossing 5.0 perfect innings in Saturday's 1-0 win vs. Asheville, RHP Brendan Girton was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for Week 12 (June 10-15)...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to receive a weekly honor this year and the first to win Pitcher of the Week since LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home the award for May 20-26, 2024... Girton is the first Cyclones' right-hander to earn the honor since RHP Luis Moreno won for July 25-31, 2022. Girton did not receive a decision on Saturday, but retired all 15 batters feaced, striking out 6...He, RHP Joel Diaz (3.0 IP), and RHP Raimon Gómez (1.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout...Since May 1, the Gage, Okla., native leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.169) and is 4th in ERA (2.36) and WHIP (0.96)...Among pitchers with 45.0 or more innings, Girton is tied for 8th in the SAL in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.68) and 9th in ERA (2.91).

OFF DAY

vs. ABERDEEN: After taking 4-of-6 at home against Asheville, Brooklyn hits the road for the final 3 games of the first half and the opening 3 games of the second half... Aberdeen dropping 3-of-5 from Jersey Shore... Sunday's series finale was canceled due to unplayable field conditions... The IronBirds are 10-18 at Ripken Stadium this season... Brooklyn took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in Maryland from April 15-20 and lead the season series, 11-2... The IronBirds boast 8 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Vance Honeycutt (4), INF Griff O'Ferrall (6), RHP Michael Forret (7), LHP Luis De León (13), INF Aron Estrada (16), C Ethan Anderson (17), INF Leandro Arias (21), and OF Austin Overn (30)... Anderson is currently on the injured list... In 276 meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 148-128 (.536)... Brooklyn is 70-57 (.551) against the IronBirds in 127 games at Ripken Stadium.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn's pitching staff collected its 7th shutout of the season with a 1-0 win vs. Asheville on Saturday...The 1-0 triumph was the Cyclones' 2nd since last Thursday, doing the same on June 5 at Wilmington...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in shutouts with New York-AL's Hudson Valley...The 7 shutouts are tied for 2nd most at High-A and tied for 8th most in Minor League Baseball...Kansas City's High-A Quad Cities (9) leads the level, and Milwaukee's Triple-A Nashville (11) leads MiLB... Brooklyn's single-season record for shutouts is 14, set in 2024.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn has been a model of consistency at Maimonides Park this year... Last Thursday's defeat vs. Asheville marked the end of the Cyclones' 15-game home winning streak...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 26-7 (.788)...Greenville is second best (21-14)...The 26 home wins are the 3rd most home wins in all of Mil.B...The Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas leads the minors (28)...Brooklyn's .788 home winning percentage is the best in Mil.B...Pittsburgh's Triple-A Indianapolis (.750) is 2nd.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Saúl García has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering Wednesday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP Jack Snyder for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 17.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.41)...That total is also the best mark in all of High-A...It is also the 6th-best in Minor League Baseball...Los Angels-NL's High-A Great Lakes RHP Alex Makarewich (18.45) is 1st...Following that same qualifier, García is also 2nd in the SAL in hits-per-9-innings (3.18) and batting average against (.111), and is tied for 10th in ERA (1.59).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 64 games of the 2025 season with Sunday's walk-off win vs. Asheville, earning the series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 11 series of the year, the Cyclones hold an 8-0-3 record... In home series, Brooklyn is 5-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 10-0-3 in a series of any length... Additionally, the Cyclones' 44-20 record is the franchise's best record through 64 games since their inaugural season in 2001...The 44 wins are the most by a South Atlantic League team in the first half since Mills Te-organized before the 2021 season...Brooklyn's 44 wins are also tied for the 3rd most in Minor League Baseball and are 2 behind Philadelphia's Triple-A Lehigh Valley (46) for 1st.

THRICE IS NICE: The Cyclones completed the 2nd triple play in franchise history in the top of the 9th inning in Sunday's comeback win vs. Asheville...Tourists SS Drew Vogel hit into a 4-3-5 triple play...2B Marco Vargas fielded the ball behind second, stepped on the bag, and threw to 1B Jacob Reimer for a double play...Reimer then threw across the diamond where 3B Jesús Báez tagged out CF Lucas Spence, who over slid the bag, for the triple play...lt marked Brooklyn's first triple-killing since July 10, 2016, on a 2-6-4 triple play from C Dan Rizzie, to SS Colby Woodmansee, to 2B Nick Sergakis...1B Pete Alonso was on the field for the 1st triple play in franchise history...Brooklyn then turned a double play to start the 10th inning, as 18 Diliver Carrillo filed out to left and Vogel was tagged out trying to advance to 3rd...RHP Ben Simon recorded 6 outs by facing only 3 batters...It is the only known occurrence of a pitcher recording at least 6 outs and facing 3 or fewer batters since at least 1910.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: SS Boston Baro delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off win of the season with a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in a 5-4 win vs. Asheville on Sunday...It marked the 3rd straight Sunday home game that ended with a walk-off win...C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in a 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen on June 1...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On May 18, DH Ronald Hernandez came through with an RBI fielder's choice to walk-off Winston-Sa-

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 18, 2003, OF Seth Pietsch became the 1st player to hit a home run in their first plate appearance with the franchise...He smashed the 1st pitch he saw as a professional after being selected in the draft just days prior...In 2012, a base-loaded walk to LF Stefan Sabol and a sacrifice fly from 18 Cole Frenzel broke a scoreless tie in a 2-0 win vs. Staten Island...RHP Gabriel Ynoa (6.0 IP), RHP Dawrin Frias (2.0), and RHP Tyler Vanderheiden (1.0) combine on a 4-hit shutout in the win...In 2014, 3B Jhoan Ureña leads off the 9th inning with a game-tying home run and DH Tyler Moore provided the goahead sacrifice fly in the 10th in a 4-3 win at Staten Island...In 2016, the Cyclones were no-hit for the 1st time in franchise history as RHP Drew Finley (6.0 IP) and RHP Josh Roeder (4.0) combined on a 10-inning no-hitter in a 2-1 loss at Staten Island...In 2021, Brooklyn scored 5 runs in the top of the 9th to rally and win 7-5 at Wilmington...CF Antoine Duplantis provided the go-ahead 2-run home run.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (11), INF Boston Baro (12), INF Marco Vargas (13), INF Jacob Reimer (17), RHP Nate Dohm (18), C Chris Suero (20), OF Eli Serrano III (21) and C Ronald Hernández (25), OF A.J. Ewing (26), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss with the Cyclones and at High-A last Thursday night vs. Asheville on SNY...Surrendered 4 unearned runs on only 1 hit over 3.2 innings...Plunked a batter, walked a career-high-tying 3, and struck out 4...Tossed a wild pitch...Only hit allowed was a 3-run home run to 1B Garret Guillemette in the top of the 3rd...Relieved by RHP Alfred Vega with a runner at 1st and 2 out in the top of the 4th and Brooklyn trailing 4-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...Threw 68 pitches and 43 strikes (63.24%)...The Tourists went on to defeat the Cyclones, 7-2...The loss snapped Brooklyn's 15-game home winning streak.

2025: Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Suffered the loss as the Opening Day starter on 4/4 vs. JUP (3.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K)...Earned his 1st win of the season on 4/18 vs. TAM (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Struck out a season-high 7 in a no-decision on 4/22 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 7 K)...Earned the victory, tossing a career-high 5.1 innings on 5/3 @JUP (5.1 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...At the time of his promotion, Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12...Took a no-decision in his Cyclones and High-A debut on 5/15 vWS (3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...Tossed 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 5/30 vABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his Cyclones career with 5.0 shutout innings on 6/5 vWIL (5.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 6 K).

PROSPECT RADAR: Dohm is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 24 prospect in 2025 per *Baseball America*...He entered 2025 ranked as the Mets' No. 23 prospect by that publication...He is considered New York's No. 19 farmhand by MLB Pipeline and the organization's No. 20 prospect per SNY's **Joe DeMayo**.

STARKVILLE SUPERSTAR: The 22-year-old had a marvelous final collegiate campaign at Mississippi State in 2024...Dohm composed a perfect 4-0 record with a minuscule 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP), 23 hits allowed, 4 walks, and 37 strikeouts in 8 appearances (6 starts) for the Bulldogs...Served as Mississippi State's Opening Day starter on 2/16/24 vs. Air Force...Struck out a season-high 10 on 3/8/24 vs. Evansville...Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings on 2/29/24 vs. Mount Saint Mary's...Had 8 or more strikeouts in 3 contests...Held opponents to a .217 batting average...Sidelined for most of March and April with an arm injury.

BALL HARD: Dohm started his collegiate career closer to home at Ball State University in Muncie, Ind...The university was located roughly 66 miles southeast of Zionsville (Ind.) High School...About a one-hour and 17-minute drive on I-69...Pitched one season with the Cardinals in 2022...Accrued a 4-3 record with a 5.71 ERA (26 ER in 41.0 IP), 2 saves, 32 hits allowed, 26 walks, and 56 strikeouts in 15 appearances (3 starts).

WHO TO ROOT FOR?: It isn't just New York sports fans who have to decide on which baseball team to root for...It can happen in Chicago, as well...Dohm grew up on both the north and south sides of Chicago before moving to Zionsville, Ind...As a result, Dohm grew rooting for both the Chicago Cubs and Chicago White Sox...However, Dohm became more of a Cubs fan while a student at Zionsville High School.
