Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third game in a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Yesterday: Lugnuts 4, Loons 3. Lansing was held to one hit through seven innings, a Jonny Butler double leading off the game, before rallying for two runs in the top of the eighth inning to beat Great Lakes on Wednesday night at Dow Diamond. Southpaw Will Johnston fanned eight batters in three scoreless and hitless innings to earn the victory. The Loons threatened till the very end, but left the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Loons through Sunday and then return home on Tuesday, May 14th, for a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

That's the Formula...: In the Lugnuts' three wins over the Loons, Lansing has outscored Great Lakes 20-8. But in the Loons' five wins over the Lugnuts. Lansing has been outscored 38-11.

But That was Unexpected: The Lugnuts won their first game of the season when trailing after the sixth and seventh innings. Lansing additionally improved to 2-13 when getting outhit by the opposition.

Will the Thrill: 2023 13th-rounder Will Johnston opened the season with the Stockton Ports, dominated the California League, and has continued his pitching mastery two appearances into his tenure with the Lugnuts. Including yesterday's 3 IP, 8-K performance, the former Texas A&M Aggie has fanned 40 batters in 22 innings this season, allowing only nine walks, seven hits and three runs.

Major League Nuts: 2021-22 Lansing Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris notched his first two Major League hits on May 4, his second career MLB game – both home runs in a 20-3 Oakland A's victory over the Miami Marlins. Harris, the 186th Lugnut all-time to reach the Majors, joined Max Schuemann as Lugs to make their MLB debut in 2024; Schuemann also homered for his first big league hit.

Patience: OF Henry Bolte went 0-for-3 with a walk and has now drawn 14 walks in his last 15 games. He is 1-for-22 (.045) to open May with a .323 OBP.

Tops on the Team: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 0-for-3 with a walk yesterday; he has now reached base in 25 of 27 games and ranks 8th in the Midwest League in batting average (.330), tied for 1st in triples (3), 3rd in walks (26), 4th in OBP (.475), 9th in slugging (.527), 5th in OPS (1.002), tied for 5th in RBIs (22) and tied for 10th in hits (30).

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 23 walks place him 4th in the league; Brayan Buelvas is tied for 4th in runs scored (22); and Henry Bolte is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (12), right ahead of Buelvas, who is tied for 5th in steals (11). Reliever Colton Johnson, meanwhile, leads the league with 11 appearances and is tied for 5th with 3 saves.

The Upward Path: Though Lansing's overall team ERA is 5.13, 10th in the MWL, the Nuts' ERA this month is 3.63, the 4th best in the Midwest League.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and **Will Johnston** at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization, writing "Morales is a wild card given his age and lack of experience, yet those also make it easy to dream on the package of stuff and tools, and he offers as much upside as anyone in this system."

Today in Lugnuts History

2015: Fort Wayne had scheduled Saturday night postgame fireworks, and so the TinCaps shot them off as soon as the game ended... which came after a one-hour, 38-minute rain delay before first pitch and then a three-hour, 48-minute game that concluded after midnight. Edwin Moreno's suicide squeeze in the bottom of the 10th inning (against a five-infielder infield, as directed by manager Ken Huckaby, bringing right fielder J.D. Davis into the infield) brought Nick Torres in with the winning run for a 5-4 Fort Wayne victory. Anthony Alford reached base five times in the loss, with two hits and three walks.

2019: Nick Podkul stole home to end a 22-inning scoring drought, but the Lugnuts lost at Kane County, 3-1. The Nuts entered the series having been shut out 6-0 and 6-0 by Quad Cities in the final two games of a three-game sweep – and things would get worse, as this series-opening loss set the tone for a three-game sweep at Kane County, concluding an 0-6 road trip.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.

In a Nutshell: One of four undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3... 45-pitch limit today.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With lowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
