HOMER HAPPY AT HOME: The Omaha Storm Chasers hit four solo home runs against Cincinnati Reds top pitching prospect Hunter Greene in his Triple-A debut, including three first-inning homers from **OF Kyle Isbel**, **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn**, and **INF Ryan McBroom**. to earn a 6-5 win. **INF Emmanuel Rivera** added a solo home run in the third—recording a homer for the third straight game—and **OF Anderson Miller** tacked on a run in the fifth with a solo home run against the Louisville Bats bullpen. The Chasers final run of the game can from **INF Gabriel Cancel**, who singled, stole second, moved to third on a wild pitch, and scored on a sacrifice fly in the seventh.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 27-11 (.711), the Omaha Storm Chasers have the best record in Triple-A and the tied for the second-best record in Minor League Baseball, trailing the Bowie Baysox (27-10, .730), the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, and tied with the Tampa Tarpons (27-11, .711), the Low-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. Omaha currently leads the Triple-A East Midwest Division by 6.0 games, which is the second-largest divisional lead in Minor League Baseball. Fellow Royals affiliate Quad Cities leads the High-A Central West by 6.5 games.

HOME RUN HEROES: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 80 home runs (38 games), including 19 home runs in the last four games. The Chasers have three games with at least five home runs this week, including a seven-homer game on 6/13 @ STP that set a modern franchise record (2011-present). The Chasers' 80 home runs are also more than 15 Major League teams and tied with the Milwaukee Brewers. Omaha has recorded at least one home run in 25 of its last 26 games, including a 13-game homer streak from 5/16-6/1, and has recorded 19 multi-homer games, including three-four homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game. **INF Ryan McBroom** currently leads the league with 13 home runs, **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** is second with 12, **INF Emmanuel Rivera** is third with 11, and **INF Gabriel Cancel** is tied for fourth in the league with 10. Omaha is the only team in Minor League Baseball with four players with 10+ home runs.

OFFENSIVE ONSLAUGHT: The Chasers have 17 games with 10+ hits through 38 games, including one 15-hit game and one 21-hit game. Omaha's .276 average leads Triple-A East and is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball while the team's .519 slugging percentage leads Triple-A East and is third in MiLB. Omaha is also first in Triple-A East and third in MiLB in hits (358).

MEIBRYS MAGIC: **C Meibry Vitoria** leads the team and is tied for fifth in Triple-A East with a .405 on-base percentage. Vitoria is currently in the midst of a 13-game on-base streak after beginning the season with a 14-game on-base streak from 5/4-5/27. Overall, Vitoria has reached base in 27 of the 28 games he's played this season. The only time he was kept off base was on 5/27 vs. IND, when he went 0-for-4. Vitoria also leads the team with 16 walks.

RYAN ON A RAMPAGE: **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn**, who is 6-for-12 (.500) with two home runs, two doubles, and four RBIs in three games against Louisville, was named Triple-A East Player of the Week on Monday after hitting .429 (9-for-21) with five home runs, nine RBIs, a .478 OBP and a 1.190 SLG in five games against St. Paul. O'Hearn recorded back-to-back multi-homer games on June 9 and 10, becoming the first Chasers to do so since **Brett Hayes** on Aug. 21 and 22, 2013, vs. New Orleans. The first of O'Hearn's five home runs came against RHP Kenta Madea, who was making a rehab start, on Wednesday, and the second came in the eighth inning on Wednesday to help lift Omaha to a 5-2 win. He homered in back-to-back at-bats on Thursday to help Omaha to a 10-2 lead through two innings in an eventual 16-9 win, ultimately going 4-for-5 with two home runs and six RBIs. His final home run came in his first at-bat on Friday, giving him four homers in a six at-bat span. Since joining the Chasers on May 28, O'Hearn is batting .391 (25-for-64) with 12 home runs and 25 RBIs, reaching base safely in 15 of 16 games and hitting safely in 14 of 16.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Scott Blewett** turned in a solid start against the St. Paul Saints at CHS Field his last time out, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while striking out six and walking one. Blewett pitched into the sixth inning for the second consecutive start and retired 12 of the next 13 batters he faced after giving up two runs in the second inning. After posting a 7.80 ERA in four May starts, Blewett has a 2.87 ERA in three appearances (two starts) in June, including his last start at Werner Park on June 5 vs. IOW when he threw 6.0 shutout innings.

FOR LOUISVILLE: **RHP Michael Mariot** makes his second start of the season after throwing 5.0 scoreless inning with three strikeouts and two walks in his season debut against Toledo on 6/12. Mariot, an eighth-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2010 out of the University of Nebraska, pitched for Omaha in parts of five seasons from 2012-2015 and 2018. He last pitched for Omaha on 8/7/18 vs. Salt Lake at Werner Park. Mariot recorded the final four outs of the 2013 Pacific Coast League Championship Game for Omaha against Salt Lake on 9/14/2013.

DOPPLER RADAR: **RHP Anthony Swartzak** was selected by Kansas City after striking out 14 in nine games with Omaha
