TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open their first series of the season with the Portland Sea Dogs, the team's will meet again August 6-11 at Hadlock Field.

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped the series finale at Erie, 11-5, after holding a 3-1 lead after 4 innings.

A WINNING STREAK: Altoona earned their first four-game winning streak of the season in Erie from May 22-25 and their first sixgame series win of the season (4-2) against the SeaWolves.

A 'CRAFT FIT TO CARRY THE CURVE: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft turned in the team's best performance in recent memory with a career-best 7.0 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts against the Akron RubberDucks on May 14. Ashcraft set career-high's in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (10), his 10 K's were the most by a Curve pitcher since May 2, 2023 when Kyle Nicolas struck out 10 Richmond Flying Squirrels. Ashcraft had 14.2 consecutive scoreless inning streak end in his last outing. In the month of May he's recorded a 2.05 ERA, good for 5th-best in the Eastern League and his 32 strikeouts rank 3rd in the circuit.

Entering play on Tuesday, May 28, Ashcraft's 4.2% walk-rate was the 8th-lowest among Double-A pitchers that have thrown at least 30.0 IP, he also ranks 14th in swinging strike% (number of whiffs divided by total pitches) with a 15.3% mark, and 13th in K-BB% (22.0%) among Double-A pitchers.

POWER UP!: After hitting just 22 home runs hit through 41 games (T-24th among 30 Double-A teams), Altoona swatted 7 homers across 2 games on May 23 and 24 at Erie. Altoona's 9 total homers over the last 6 games are the 4th-most among Double-A teams in the last 7 days.

SULLY DOMINATES: Righty Sean Sullivan has picked up right where he left off in 2023 in the Curve rotation. Sullivan has tossed 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings (5/7 - Present) after firing six scoreless frames at Erie on May 22. In his time with Altoona he has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 19-of-29 starts and his 2.66 ERA ranks 8th in the Eastern League, he also ranks 8th in WHIP (1.11).

BEER'S ALL AROUND: Infielder Seth Beer has been one of the Curve's most consistent hitters this season. Beer's reached in 16-of-1 games since May 3, during which he's hitting .319/.373/.478 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, and 4 RBI. His .303 batting average this season ranks 5th in the Eastern League entering play on Tuesday, May 28.

WHAT A FELLOW: Righty Drake Fellows has become one of Altoona's most reliable arms since arriving from Greensboro. He's recorded a 1.69 ERA (3 ER / 16.0 IP) in his 4 outings, 2 starts with 16 strikeouts.

NOWHERE TO GO BUT UP: Entering play on Tuesday, May 28, Altoona has the 2nd-worst record among professional baseball teams with an 14-31 record. The Curve were the last team in the affiliated minors to win 10 games. The Chattanooga Lookouts (Reds, Southern League) hold the worst record in professional baseball at 12-32.

Altoona's 14-31 start is the worst record for the club through 44 games in franchise history, matching the 2009 Curve who started the season 14-31. The 5 wins in the month of April were the fewest for the team in a calendar month in which they played at least 15 games.

THE 'DOGS OF THE SEA: Chad Epperson leads the Sea Dogs for his third season as Manager, he previously served as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Portland has many of the Red Sox top prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 1 INF Marcelo Mayer, No. 2 OF Roman Anthony, No. 3 C Kyle Teel, No. 5 RHP Wikelman Gonzalez, No. 6 INF Nick Yorke, No. 9 RHP Luis Perales, No. 19 INF Blaze Jordan, No. 22 INF Eddinson Paulino, No. 25 RHP Hunter Dobbins, No. 26 RHP Angel Bastardo.

THE FIRST TO PANT: Wikelman Gonzalez, the No.5 prospect in the Red Sox system according to MLB Pipeline, takes the ball in the series opener. Gonzalez, a 22-year-old from Maracay, Venezuela, has gone 3-1 with a 6.51 ERA in 8 games, 7 starts this season for Portland. Gonzalez first reached Double-A for 10 starts in 2023 and went 3-1 with a 2.42 ERA. Gonzalez was added to the Red Sox 40 man roster this past off-season to protect him from the Rule V draft, he works with a lively fastball, curveball, slider and change-up. Gonzalez was the Red Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2023 and projects to have 3 plus offerings in his fastball, change-up and curveball in his arsenal when he matures.
