THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve brought patience to the plate on Saturday night, matching a season-high eight walks and recording 10 hits in a 9-2 victory over Binghamton at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Cal Mitchell would knock his 12th double of the season off the left field wall in the second inning to score Daniel Amaral and kick off the scoring for Altoona. The Curve followed with three runs in the third inning off Binghamton starter RHP Cole Gibson. Ji-Hwan Bae led off the inning with a triple, and later scored on a Canaan Smith-Njigba groundout. Four of the next five batters would draw walks, plating two more to give Altoona a 4-0 lead. In the fourth, the Curve came back with five more runs off RHP Ryley Gilliam. With the bases loaded, Amaral scored two on an RBI single. Mitchell would then score a runner on a groundout and Jonah Davis followed with an RBI single. Davis then scored on a double from Connor Kaiser. Gilliam allowed these five runs over 1.1 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look for their first series victory since taking 4-of-6 from Akron from June 8-13. After taking series victories in 4-of-5 weeks to start the year, Altoona has split or lost their six-game series in four straight weeks. A victory on Sunday night would put them back in the driver's seat as they make a push to the postseason.

NOT JOSHING AROUND: Josh Bissonette has stepped into the number two spot in the batting order and it's coincided with his best stretch of the season at the plate. Over his last five games, Bissonette is batting 9-for-17 with 5 walks and 4 runs batted in. Bissonette had three multi-hit games across his first 31 games this season before recording three straight games with multiple hits.

WE'VE GOT THREE: Cal Mitchell became the third player to hit 10 home runs on the season when he smashed a solo homer in Wednesday night's 10-3 win over Binghamton. Mitchell joined Rodolfo Castro (11) and Mason Martin (17) in double digits. The Curve are the second team in the league to have three players hit ten homers on the season, joining the Somerset Patriots who have five players that have hit at least ten home runs.

GRAND OPENING: Connor Kaiser slammed the 47th grand slam in franchise history to cap off a six-run first inning on Tuesday night. Kaiser's first home run at Double-A gave the Curve a commanding lead they would not relinquish. Coincidentally, Kaiser's grand slam was the first since Chris Sharpe hit one on June 30, 2019 against Binghamton.

THE BABE: Mason Martin continued his torrid campaign at the plate with another home run on Wednesday night. Martin's 17th home run of the season moved him into the league lead, he ranks second in slugging percentage (.613), first in extra base hits (35) and is tied for first in the league in runs batted in (50).

GRANDE CASTRO: The Pirates recalled INF Rodolfo Castro from Altoona prior to Tuesday's game against Akron and Castro promptly made an impact, drawing a walk in a pinch-hit appearance in the ninth inning and scoring the winning run as the Pirates defeated Atlanta 2-1. RHP Nick Kingham in 2018 was the most recent player to be recalled to Pittsburgh directly from the Altoona roster. Castro recorded his first major league hit on Friday night with a solo homer off Nick Tropeano of the New York Mets and hit two more home runs in Pittsburgh's 6-5 comeback win at Citi Field on Sunday afternoon to finish off the first half of the season.

THE NEWS IS GOOD: Pirates Director of Sports Medicine Dr. Tom Tomczyk gave an update on Curve RHP Roansy Contreras and INF Oneil Cruz on Wednesday July 7 and stated that both players have "forearm muscle strains" and the team is hopeful that they will be able to resume throwing in 2-4 weeks. Both players were placed on the IL on July 6 (retroactive to July 5).

LET'S PLAYOFF: Major League Baseball announced last Wednesday that all leagues at Double-A, High-A and Low-A will play postseason baseball. The top two teams in each league as determined by win percentage, regardless of division, will play a best-of-five series beginning on Tuesday, September 21 playing two games at the #2 seed with an off-day slated for Thursday, September 23 then the series finishing at the #1 seed.

THAT'S A FIRST! This season the Curve have featured seven players that were born after the team played the first game in franchise history on April 10, 1999. Ji-Hwan Bae (7/26/99), Rodolfo Castro (5/21/99), Roansy Contreras (11/7/99), Claudio Finol (4/13/00), Mason Martin (6/2/99), Canaan Smith-Njigba (4/30/99), and Noe Toribio (8/25/99) were each born after Altoona played the first game in franchise history.

THE RUMBLETOWNERS: Binghamton makes their only trip of the season to PNG Field this week. INF Brett Baty, New York's first round selection in 2019 (12th overall) out of Lake Travis HS in Austin, TX was promoted following his appearance in the Futures Game. With High-A Brooklyn, Baty hit .309/.397/.514/.911 with 14 doubles, seven home runs, 27 runs scored, and 34 RBI in 51 games. The Ponies roster features several of the top-30 prospects in the Mets system according to MLB.com: INF Brett Baty (#3), INF Mark Vientos (#8), OF Carlos Cortes (#18), RHP Ryley Gilliam (#21), RHP Oscar De La Cruz (#26), and RHP Tony Dabrell (#27).

FOR ALTOONA: LHP Cam Vieaux makes his second start for the Curve in the series against Binghamton...*For more on Vieaux, see page two.*

FOR BINGHAMTON: RHP Oscar De La Cruz makes his sixth start and ninth overall appearance for Binghamton. A former Chicago Cubs farmhand, De La Cruz signed with the Mets in November of 2020 after reaching Double-A Tennessee in 2019. A native of La Romana in the Dominican Republic, De La Cruz allowed 14 runs in 6.2 IP to begin the season with Triple-A Syracuse.
