Today: It's the third game of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, and the host West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Tigers. This is the 458th all-time meeting, coming in the Nuts' 3800th all-time game, so 12% of all of the regular season games the Lugnuts have ever played have come against West Michigan.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 7, Whitecaps 6. Danny Bautista, Jr. singled in Jose Escorche with two outs in the ninth inning, completing a Lugnuts comeback from 6-2 down in the eighth inning and sending the Nuts to a second straight win in the series, a third straight win overall, and a sixth consecutive road victory.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jakska and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, enjoy an off day on July 29, and then welcome in the Dayton Dragons for a six-game series running from July 30 - August 4. Only three more homestands remain in the Nuts' 28th season.

There's No Place Like Away From Home: The Nuts have won six consecutive road games, two shy of matching the franchise record, achieved twice previously.

Brisk Ball: Game times for the Nuts/Whitecaps' matchups this year: 2:24 (yesterday), 2:23, 2:49, 2:02, 1:44, 2:26, 2:53, 2:31.

KOOOOOUZ: Happy 43rd birthday to Lugnuts hitting coach **Kevin Kouzmanoff!** The big man was drafted by Cleveland in the 6th round in 2033 from the University of Nevada and played seven years in the Majors, moving from Cleveland to San Diego to Oakland to Colorado to Texas and hitting 87 homers while batting .257 in 685 games.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in triples and ranks 2nd in runs, hits and total bases, and 3rd in batting average, doubles, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history. Miller unfortunately landed on the Injured List today with a fractured left pinkie finger.

Prospecting: The Nuts have four Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 15), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), and pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27), as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

The Future is Here: 21-year-old **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Holy moly, what a game. The Lugnuts blew an 8-2 lead when Bowling Green scored three in the 5th, two in the 6th, and one in the 7th. The Lugnuts took a 9-8 lead in the bottom of the 8th on a throwing error by 3B Juniel Querecuto, but the Hot Rods tallied four runs in the top of the 9th against Kramer Champlin, keyed by a Josh Sale two-run triple (followed by a run-scoring wild pitch). In the bottom of the 9th, K.C. Hobson singled, Michael Crouse singled, and Kevin Patterson hit the first pitch he received over the right field wall, tying the game at 12-12. In the 11th inning, Bowling Green took a 13-12 lead on a missed catch error by 1B Hobson, but Juniel Querecuto's two-out throwing error on a Chris Peters grounder kept the Nuts alive and Shane Opitz followed with a game-tying RBI triple. In the 13th inning, LF Peters threw out Drew Vetteson at home to keep the game tied momentarily – but Ryan Brett's two-run double proved the winning blow in an epic 15-13 Hot Rods victory lasting four hours and 11 minutes. The Lugnuts collected 22 hits (four apiece from Peters, Michael Crouse and Chris Hawkins).

No-Hit History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
