TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for the final game of a six-game series, as your Quakes complete a six-game home stand against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Today is IEHP "Kids Eat Free" Sunday. Kids will also "Run the Bases" after the game, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 18th of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the last of 12 at home in 2024. The Quakes are currently 11-6 against the 66ers in 2024 (6-5 at home), with the first six games taking place at San Manuel. Last year, the Quakes went 6-9 at home, 14-13 overall against the 66ers.

LAST GAME: Kendall George's fourth hit of the night was the game-winner, as the Quakes rallied for a 6-5 walk-off win in ten innings over the Inland Empire 66ers on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. George singled home Oswaldo Osorio in the last of the tenth against Inland Empire reliever Alex Martinez (2-4), helping Rancho earn their second straight win overall and their first extra-innings win of the year (1-5) in six tries. Josue De Paula had three hits and three RBIs to help with Rancho's 13-hit attack. Rancho reliever Callum Wallace (1-2) got the win with a scoreless tenth. Inland Empire cranked out 15 hits, with former Quake Imanol Vargas leading the way with three hits and an RBI.

TIP OF THE CAP TO THE STORM: The Lake Elsinore Storm defeated the Visalia Rawhide on Tuesday night by a final of 5-3, making the result of Rancho's game against Inland Empire a moot point. To start the week, the Quakes needed to go 3-0 over the final three games of the first half, while also needing the Storm to lose all three in Visalia. The Storm will return to the playoffs for the first time since 2022, when they last won the Cal League Title. Modesto clinched the First Half North Division on Sunday, also with a win in Visalia.

UNDEFEATED SECOND HALF!: The second half of the Cal League season kicked off Friday night with a Quakes win, strangely enough, in the midst of their respective six-game series. Thanks to back-to-back wins, Rancho is now 2-0 in the second half. If Lake Elsinore wins the second half like they did the first half, then the team with the next best record in the second half would go to the South Division Finals to meet the Storm. This rule changed two years ago from the team with the next best overall record to the next best second half record.

ROSTER MOVE: The Quakes added LHP Luke Fox to the roster today from the Arizona Complex League. That brings the Rancho roster to 29 active players, with one spot still open.

WAGNER IS PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Logan Wagner had a career-week in Fresno, going 11-for-21 (.524 avg) with four homers and seven RBIs in six games, in being named Cal League Player of the Week. He also walked four times for an OBP of .600 and had an incredible OPS of 1.838.

LUKE FOX: Left-hander Luke Fox makes his Cal League debut today, as he's slated to start for Rancho Cucamonga. Fox was added to the Rancho roster earlier today from the Arizona Complex League, where he was 0-0 with an ERA of 0.00 over four games (two starts). He allowed just one unearned run on six hits with one walk and seven strikeouts over seven innings of work. Fox was a 17th-round selection out of Duke in the 2023 draft.

BARRETT KENT: Right-hander Barrett Kent makes his 14th start of the year and his fifth against the Quakes. In his last start, he got a no-decision on Tuesday in game one of this series, allowing five runs on two hits with six walks over just 3.1 innings. In four games against Rancho, he's 0-2 with an ERA of 11.93, allowing 19 runs on 20 hits over 14.1 innings, with 18 strikeouts and 12 walks. Kent was drafted by the Angels in the eighth round of the 2023 draft out of Pottsboro High School in Pottsboro, Texas.
