### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the second-of-18 games between the teams this season and second-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. New Hampshire returns to Reading from June 10-15 and the Fightin Phils head to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading won the 2024 season-series over the Fisher Cats 11-6, and leads the season-series 1-0.

### Game 31 Recap

It was a stellar day from the Reading bullpen as they defeated New Hampshire 2-1 on Wednesday morning. Moises Chace started and allowed a leadoff home run to Yohendrick Pinango in the first. Chace loaded the bases in the second and then exited the game with an injury. Mitch Neunborn entered in the second and stranded the bases loaded. Neunborn (2.1 IP), Tommy McCollum (2.0), Travis Kuhn (2.0) and Nelson Alvarez (1.0) combined to allowed no runs on just two hits over 7.1 innings of work in relief. Reading trailed 1-0 entering the bottom of the seventh inning. They loaded the bases and Hendry Mendez tied the game with a sac fly and then, three batters later, Cade Fergus was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to give Reading the lead 2-1, which they did not relinquish.

### Relievers Rolling

Reading's bullpen has been a key reason for the Fightin Phils victories over their last two games. Between Sunday's 3-2 win at Binghamton and Wednesday's 2-1 victory, the bullpen has combined to go: 11.1 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 4 BB and 10 SO. Which is good for a 0.79 ERA. Nelson Alvarez has earned saves in back-to-back games and Travis Kuhn has earned a win in each of his last two outings.

### That's Gotta Hurt

Cade Fergus was hit by two pitches in Wednesday's game, which matches a career-high for the third time. Fergus has now been hit by a pitch in back-to-back games and four-of-five games he's played in. Entering play today, Fergus leads Reading in hit by pitches with five and is also tied for the Eastern League lead.

### This is May

Since the calendar turned the May, the Fightin Phils have produced at a much more consistent clip. After going just 5-16 in April, Reading has posted a 5-5 record through the first 10 games of the month. So far in May, the Fightin Phils are hitting .229, which compares to a .219 clip in April. Much of the May success can be accredited to a more consistent effort from the Fightin Phils bullpen.

### Welcome to Baseballtown

On Tuesday, the Philadelphia Phillies announced a variety of roster changes to the R-Phils roster. Elio Prado and Wesley Moore were assigned to High-A Jersey Shore and Jack Dallas was placed on the Temporarily Inactive List. Josh Hedjka was assigned to Reading from Jersey Shore and John McMillon joined the team from Triple-A Lehigh Valley. The Phillies also inked free agent Seth Beer to a contract from the Long Island Ducks in the independent Atlantic League. Beer and McMillon both have big-league service time, as Beer played for Arizona in 2021 and '22, while McMillon appeared in games for Kansas City and Miami the last two seasons. Hejka was acquired from the Mets in a trade over the winter and has played for Binghamton in prior years.

### On the Other Side of History

Saturday's second game was the first perfect game in Binghamton Rumble Ponies history. Jonah Tong went 6.2 innings pitched and struck out 13, then TJ Shook came in and retired the only batter he faced to finish off the perfect game. The perfect game was the first against Reading since August 25, 1990, when Kevin Morton of New Britain tossed a perfect game against Reading in seven innings. It was also the first no-hitter of any kind thrown against the Fightin Phils since Bryan Bello of Portland did it in a seven-inning game on May 5, 2022.

### Double Double

The Fightin Phils turned in seven doubles and eight extra-base hits in Wednesday night's game, both of which are season highs. The eight extra-base hits are Reading's most in a game since having eight on June 28, of last season, against Bowie. It was the first time the R-Phils had seven doubles in a game since hitting eight on June 29, 2018, against Hartford.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 15, 1996: At Reading, Essex "Gas" Burton goes 1-for-4 to extend his hitting streak to 20 games as the R-Phillies beat Norwich, 5-4.

### Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters today with a 14-19 record, sitting tied for fourth place in the Northeast Division. 2024 was a down season for New Hampshire, as they finished with an Eastern League-worse 52-84 record. The Fisher Cats went 3-2 last week against Hartford at home and after this week return back home and welcome Somerset. The Fisher Cats' roster features six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (13), RJ Schreck (20), Ryan Jennings (21), Jace Bohrofen (24), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

### On the Mound for the Cats

Righty Rafael Sanchez makes the start today for New Hampshire. This season, Sanchez is 1-1, with a 2.20 ERA over six starts (28.2 IP, 24 H, 11 BB, 24 SO). Sanchez took the loss on May 7 vs Hartford as he allowed three runs on five hits over two innings of work. Sanchez tossed a complete-game shutout in a short-tended-game on Apr. 25 at Binghamton over 6.0 IP. Sanchez split 2024 between High-A Vancouver and New Hampshire, combining to go 7-3, with a 3.64 ERA over 20 games and 19 starts. The 25-year old signed with the Blue Jays in 2022 out of Cuba.

Cabrera tossed his best outing of the season in his last start at Binghamton. He matched a season-high with six innings and did not allow a run. Cabrera also struck out a season-best eight hitters over the six innings of work. Cabrera was relieved by Tommy McCollum in the bottom of the seventh inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Cabrera to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Named the Fightin Phils Opening Day starter and allowed 1 ER over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on Apr. 4 vs Portland
- Suffered first loss of season over 4.1 IP at Somerset on Apr. 10
- Earned first victory of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton, posting season-highs in IP (5.0) and strikeouts (7)
- Threw season-high in innings (6.0), pitches (89) and runs (4) on Apr. 22 at Portland
- Leads team with 21 walks allowed; matched career-high with five May 1 vs HBG
- Had season-best outing May 8 at BNG, matching season-high with six innings and setting season-best with eight strikeouts in no-decision

### 2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
