TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) kick off their first six-game series of the season this evening as they travel to Maryland to take on the Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A, Baltimore Orioles). Having started the season at home for just the second time in their six-year history, this is their first road game of the 2025 campaign. This is the first of 24 contests against their new North Division foe and the first of two series the teams will play in the Old Line State. Tonight, the Woodpeckers hand the ball to RHP Ramsey David for his season debut while RHP Evan Yates twirls the pill for the Shorebirds.

ABOUT THE SHOREBIRDS: The Delmarva Shorebirds, founded in 1991, begin their 35th season of operation in 2025. Having joined the Carolina League in 2021 following the post-COVID-19 pandemic alongside the Augusta GreenJackets, Charleston RiverDogs, Columbia Fireflies, and Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, they are in the midst of their fifth season in the league. Collin Woody returns to manage the club for his second season after serving as the Fundamentals Coach for the FCL Orioles in 2022 and 2023. Although the Shorebirds have never won a Carolina League title, they were twice crowned champions of the Class A South Atlantic League in 1997 and 2000. Before moving to Salisbury to become the Shorebirds, they were established as the Sumter (S.C.) Flyers in 1991 as an Atlanta Braves affiliate before moving to Albany (Ga.) and being re-branded as the Albany (Ga.) Polecats, affiliating with the Orioles (1993-1994) and Montreal Expos (1992, 1995). They kept their affiliation with the Expos upon moving to Maryland in 1996, but they re-affiliated with the Orioles in 1997 and have stayed in the organization ever since.

(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES: This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the start of the 2025 season. In May of 2024, it was announced that the Down East Wood Ducks would re-locate to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers decided to swap them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Mudcats, Hillcats, Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A, Baltimore Orioles), Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, Washington Nationals), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

ON THE ROAD TO H-TOWN: At the start of the 2025 season, the Woodpeckers feature three players listed in the top 30 of the Houston Prospect Rankings according to MLB.com. Cole Hertzler is the highest ranked of the trio at No. 27 overall (No. 13 pitcher), Jancel Villarreal is the lone position player in the group at No. 29 overall (No. 2 catcher), and Bryce Mayer rounds out the list at No. 30 overall (No. 15 pitcher).

THE NEW MAN IN THE DUGOUT: The Woodpeckers feature a brand new coaching staff from top to bottom in 2025. With former manager Ricky Rivera earning a promotion to Double-A to lead the Corpus Christi Hooks, Carlos Lugo takes over for his first season in full-season baseball. However, Lugo is no stranger to the Houston Astros organization. This season marks his 12th with the club having started as a catching specialist in the Dominican Summer League in 2014. Most recently, he spent four seasons managing in the Florida Complex League, the first of which with Rivera, helping develop some of the Astros' youngest professional players. As he gets his first taste of Single-A, he teams up with three members of his staff from last year in Palm Beach including James Wiseman (Pitching Coach), Kyle Brennan (Hitting Coach), and Alfredo Granier (Development Coach).

2019 MEMORIES: The Woodpeckers franchise enters the 2025 season hunting for its first winning season since the inaugural year in 2019. During the first summer at SEGRA Stadium, the Woodpeckers finished the regular season with a 72-67 record, one win short of a Carolina League crown. Since that point, Fayetteville has drudged through four straight losing seasons, the most recent being a 55-75 finish a year ago.

BIG LEAGUE WOODPECKERS: Before the season kicked off, one more player added his name to the list of Fayetteville Woodpeckers to reach the Major Leagues. 2022 Woodpeckers RHP Ryan Gusto made the Houston Astros Opening Day roster and officially made is MLB debut in their series opener against the San Francisco Giants on March 31st, tossing two scoreless frames. The former Florida SouthWestern State College standout and 2019 11th round draft pick became the first former Woodpecker to reach the majors in 2025 and 28th overall.

THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY: April 8, 2019 - In their first season in Fayetteville, the Woodpeckers scored five runs in extra innings, including four in the 12th, to down the Frederick Keys 8-5. All four runs in the final frame came with two outs, and current Astro Jake Meyers drew the game-winning walk.


